Pure Cotton

Pure cotton is a material that is very soft to the touch, comfortable, tearproof and durable. Its long fibres give colours room to shine.



Traditional Mexican style

Mallas is a traditional manufacturing technique that goes back hundreds of years to the Mayas, the natives of Mexico. The Mallas style is known for its countless, small, interwoven cotton threads, which make the hammock extremely airy and exceptionally comfortable at the same time.



Unbleached cotton

Unbleached cotton is exceptionally soft to the skin and thanks to less water and energy consumption during production it is also more environmentally friendly. No dyes are used.



High number of suspension cords

Additional comfort thanks to a multitude of suspension cords that distribute the weight equally to the cloth of the hammock and hence give a unique feeling of agravity.
