Note: Wood dowels (Part #3) are for alignment only when assembling your furniture. Additional clearance between the wood dowels and pre-drilled holes is intended for ease of assembly.






STEP 3


Slide back panel G into grooves of Part B & Rail F as shown. Set Rail H into place on back panel G and into rail F using wood dowels as shown. Slide back panel G into grooves of rails H & F.








STEP 4

Attach Rail F to Rail H using wood dowels (Part #3) & Cam Locks (Part #1) as shown.










#### STEP 7

Attach Locking Casters (Part S) & Casters (Part R) to Base I using Round Head Screws (Part #11) as shown.

Note: IF YOU PURCHASED A
KITCHEN ISLAND WITH WOOD
LEGS, DO NOT ATTACH THE
CASTERS. Attach the wood legs
using Hex Socket Head Bolts & Wood
Dowels (as shown in instruction
manual included in carton with the
legs).


Carefully turn cabinet over with legs or casters on the floor.



#### STEP 8

Attach towel bars T to Side Panels A & B using Short Allen Bolts (Part #5) as shown.






#### STEP 11


Assemble drawers by Attaching Drawer Front M to Drawer Sides O & N using Screws (Part # 6) & Phillips Head screw driver as shown. Attach Knob (Part # 9) to Part M with Round Head Bolt (Part # 10) as shown.

NOTE: Be sure that wheels on drawer glides are at the opposite side of the drawer front.



#### STEP 12


Insert Bottom Panel Q into the grooves of Parts O, M & N as shown.

Attach Back Panel P to Parts O & N using Screws (Part # 6) & Phillips Head screw driver as shown.
