SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING

- RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK - Before beginning installation, turn off electricity at the circuit breaker box or the main fuse box.
- RISK OF FIRE - Use bulbs specified by the markings and/or labels on the fixture.

CAUTION

- For your safety, read instructions completely before beginning installation.
- If in doubt about electrical installation, consult a licensed electrician.
- Turn off electricity to fixture before replacing the bulb(s).

PREPARATION

Before beginning assembly of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and hardware contents above. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product.

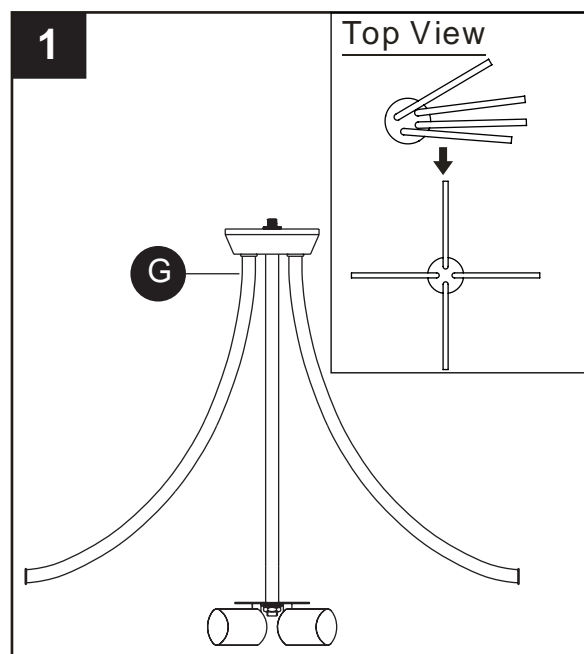
Estimated Assembly Time: 30 - 45 minutes

Tools Required for Assembly (not included): Flathead screwdriver, Phillips screwdriver, Pliers, Wire cutters, Electrical tape, Safety goggles and Ladder.

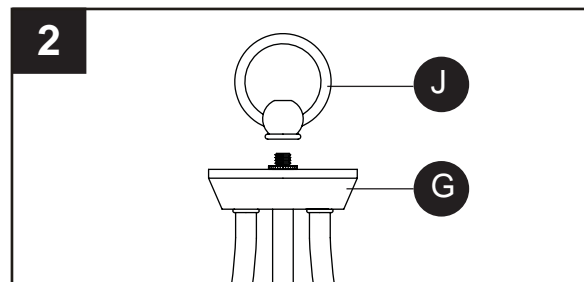
Helpful Tools (not included): Wire strippers

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

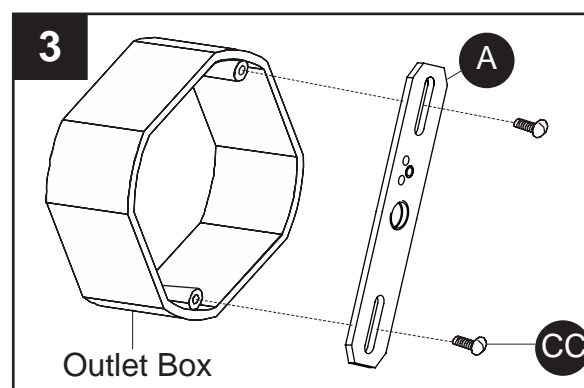
1. Unfold support arms on fixture assembly (G) to proper locations.



2. Thread the fixture loop (J) onto the nipple on the top center of the fixture assembly (G). Hand tighten until snug.



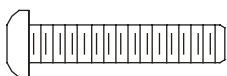
3. Secure the crossbar (A) to the outlet box (not included) with outlet box screws (CC). Tighten until snug.

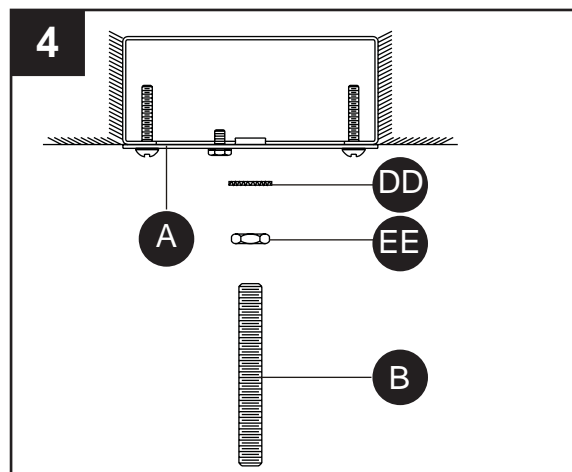

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

4. Thread one hex nut (EE) onto top end of the nipple (B). Place one lock washer (DD) over the top end of the nipple (B) and then thread the nipple (B) into the center lock hole of the crossbar (A). Using pliers (not included), thread the hex nut (EE) against the crossbar (A) and hand tighten until snug.




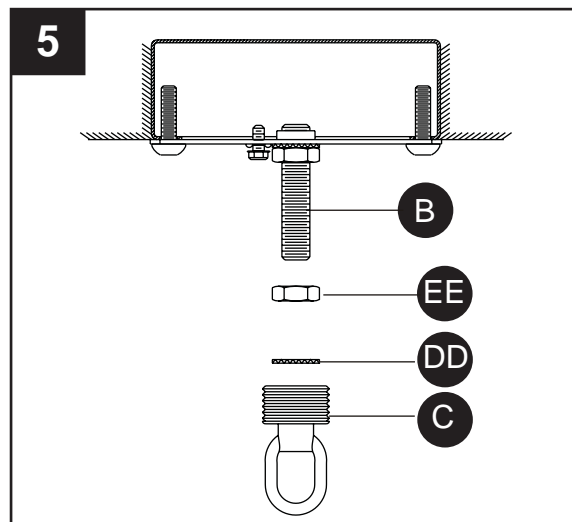

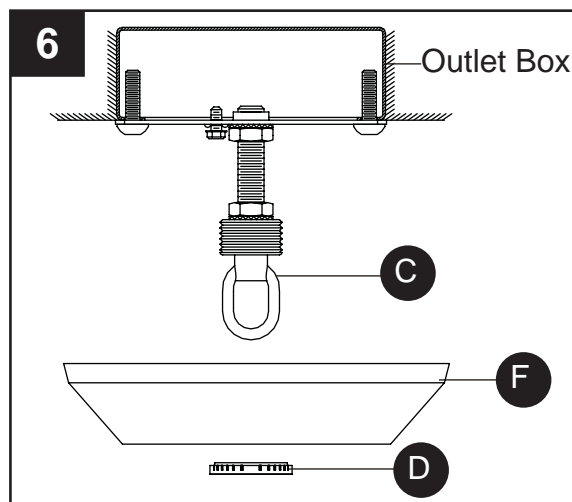
5. Thread another hex nut (EE) onto the end of the nipple (B). Place the lock washer (DD) over the end of the nipple (B) and then thread the canopy chain loop (C) onto the end of the nipple (B). Using pliers, thread the hex nut (EE) against the canopy chain loop (C) and hand tighten until snug.

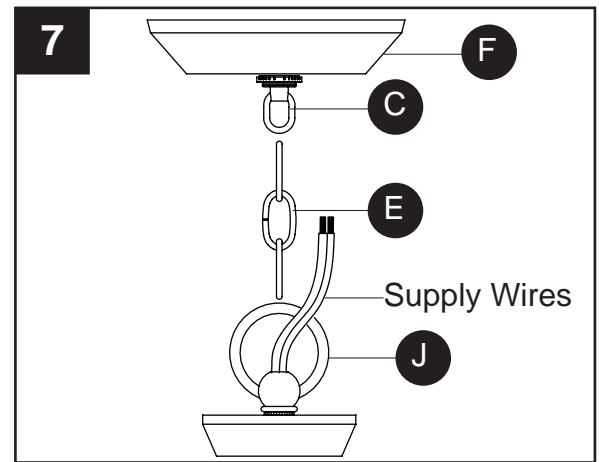
6. Push the ceiling canopy (F) upward over the outlet box. Thread the canopy lock ring (D) onto the canopy chain loop (C) and tighten until snug to secure the ceiling canopy (F).



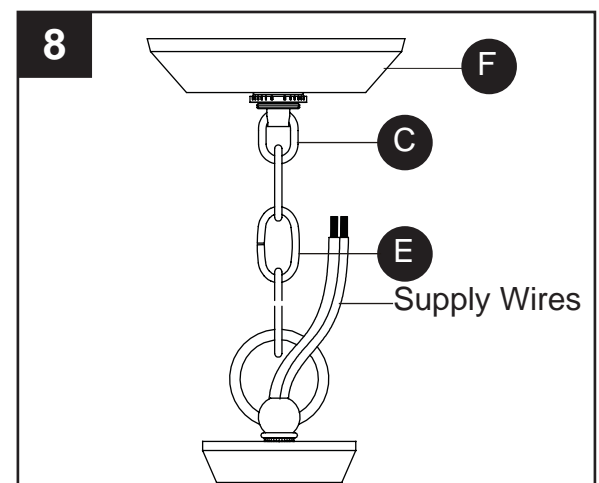

7. Adjust the fixture chain (E) to the desired length, removing links if needed. Attach one end of the fixture chain (E) onto the canopy chain loop (C) and then attach the other end of the fixture chain (F) onto the fixture loop (J) on the top of the fixture.

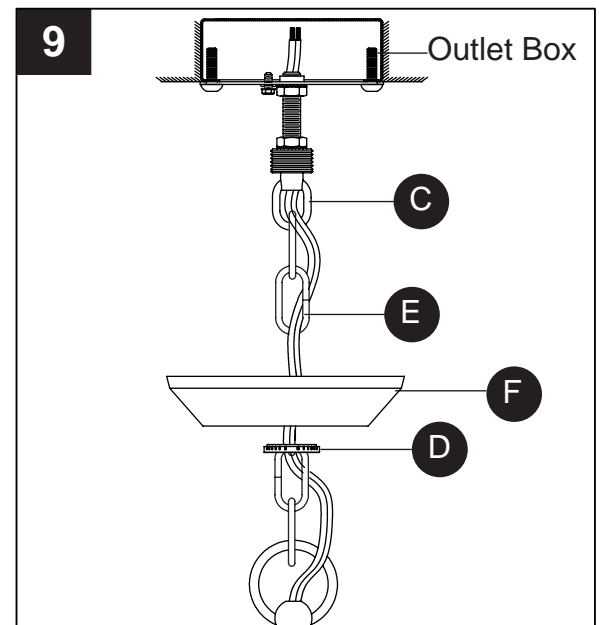
Note: You may need to use pliers to open the chain links. If so, put a cloth over the chain to protect the finish from the pliers.



8. Pull the supply wires up through the fixture chain (F) alternating links. Push the wires up through the canopy chain loop (C) into the outlet box.

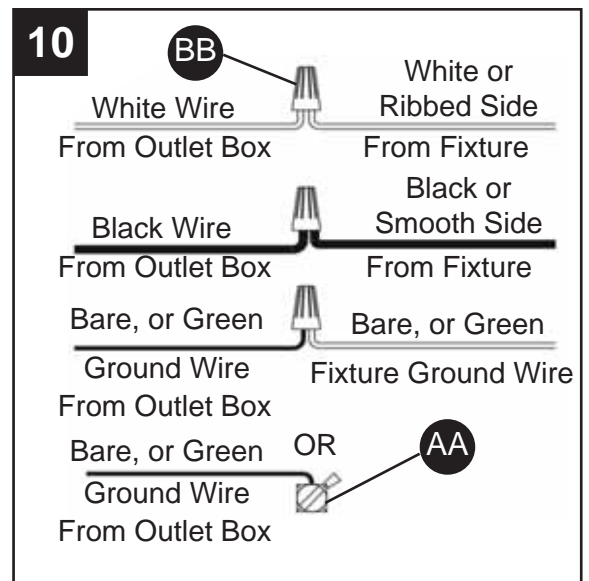


9. Unthread the canopy lock ring (D) and slide canopy lock ring (D) and ceiling canopy (F) down the fixture chain (E). Push all slack fixture wire through canopy chain loop (C) into outlet box. Trim excess fixture wire, leaving a minimum of 6 in. hanging out of the outlet box. Refer to the next step to connect the wires. Then re-attach the ceiling canopy (F) as shown in step 6.





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

10. Attach ground fixture wire to either the green ground screw (AA) on crossbar (A) or to the ground wire in the outlet box (usually GREEN or BARE). If attaching fixture ground wire to the crossbar, it is imperative that the outlet box in your home be properly grounded. Connect the neutral WHITE or RIBBED side fixture wire to the neutral usually WHITE wire from the outlet box. Connect the hot BLACK or SMOOTH side fixture wire to the hot usually BLACK wire from the outlet box. Fasten wires together with a plastic wire connector (BB) and tightly wrap connector with electrical tape (not included).

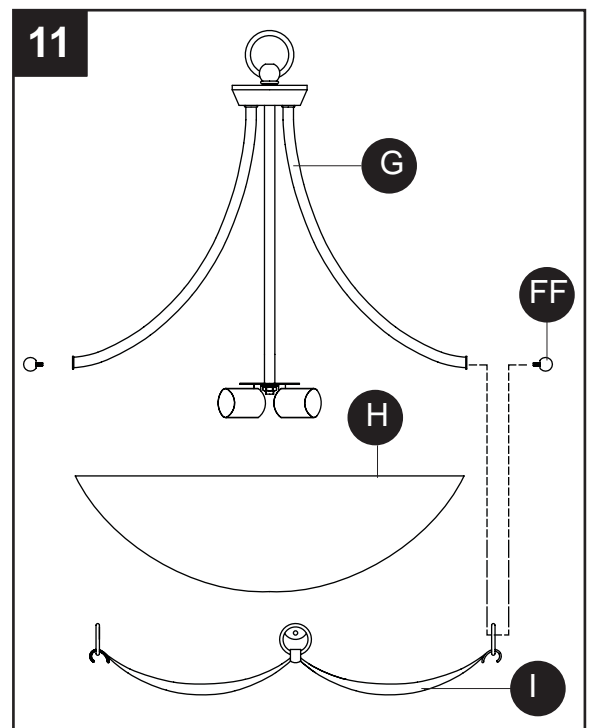

11. Place shade (H) inside shade holder (I). Lift the shade holder (I) with shade (H) upward and align rings of the shade holder (I) with the ends of the side arms of the socket cluster assembly (G). Pass lock screws (FF) through ring of the shade holder (I) and thread into side arm of the socket cluster assembly (G). Tighten until snug. **WARNING:** Two people are recommended for this.

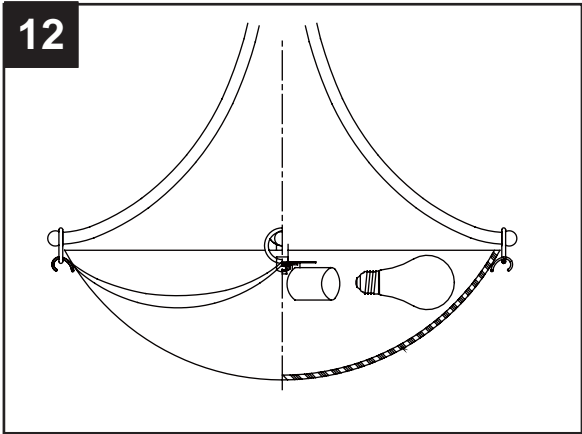

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

12. Install the bulbs (not included). Use three 100-watt max. standard-base bulbs only. Or use (3) 14-watt max. CFL spring self-ballasted standard-base bulbs.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Wipe clean using soft, dry cloth or static duster. Always avoid using harsh chemicals and abrasives to clean fixture as they may damage the finish.

TROUBLESHOOTING

PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	CORRECTIVE ACTION
Bulbs will not light.	1. Bulb is burned out. 2. Power is off. 3. Faulty wire connection. 4. Faulty switch.	1. Replace light bulb. 2. Make sure power supply is on. 3. Check wiring. 4. Test or replace the switch.
Fuse blows or the circuit breaker trips when light is turned on.	Crossed wires or power wire is grounding out.	Check wire connection.

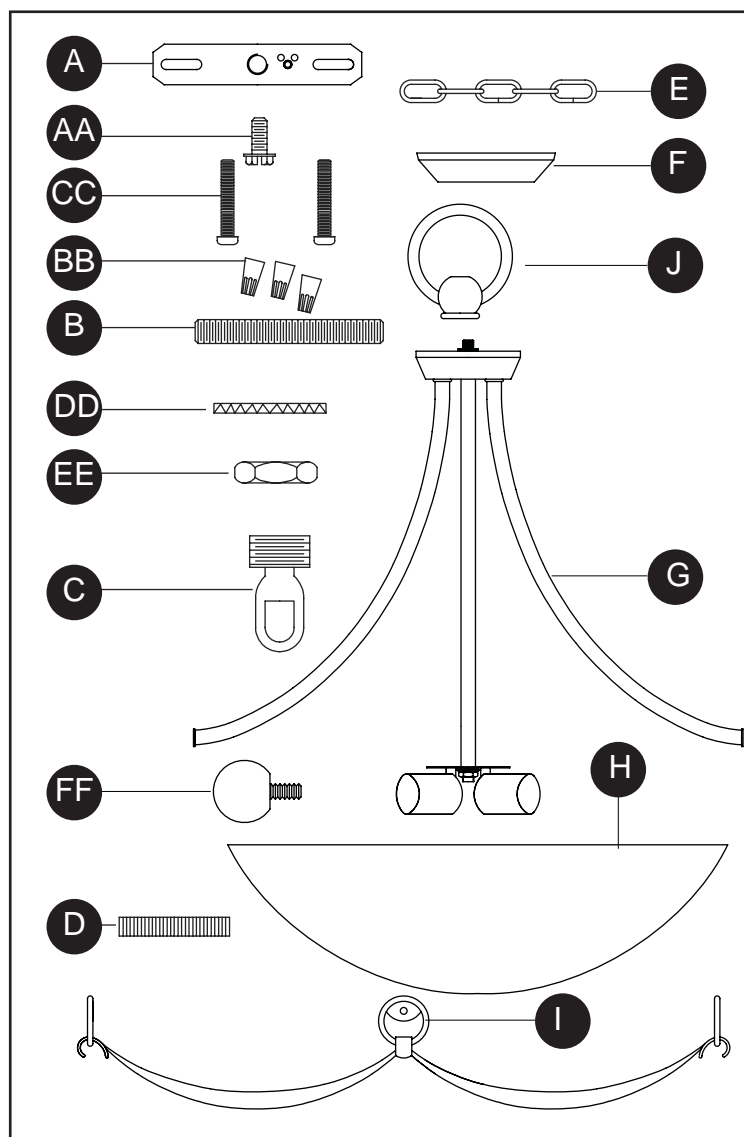
WARRANTY
