







PREPARATION


Before beginning assembly of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and hardware contents above. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product. Contact customer service for replacement parts.



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


1. On the bottom of top housing (A), pull off the isolation strip on the battery compartment.



2. Twist and secure lens (B) to the top housing (A).



3. Attach the mounting pole (C) to the ground spike (D). Push the ground spike (D) firmly into the ground. Note: Do not use a hammer. Attach the light fixture to the mounting pole (C).



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

CHARGING THE BATTERIES

For optimum performance, it is best to install the solar light in full sunlight and charge for 10-12 hours. Allow the light to run at least 8-12 complete charging and discharging cycles to reach batteries' maximum capacity.

REPLACING THE BATTERIES


The included rechargeable batteries will usually last two years. Replace batteries only when you notice the performance of your solar light is weaker than its normal operation in the first year.

To replace the battery, twist and remove the lens (B) from the top housing (A).

Remove the battery compartment cover and replace the old battery with a new AA Ni-Cd or Ni-MH rechargeable battery (not included), minimu 800mAh is required. Replace the battery compartment cover and lens.



WINTER TIPS

Keep debris and snow off the solar panel to allow the batteries to recharge. If lights have been covered by snow for a long time, allow batteries to recharge in full, direct sunlight for at least 10-12 hours so that they maintain maximum capacity.



PROBLEM	POSSIBLE CAUSE	CORRECTIVE ACTION
Solar light does not turn on at night or its nightly run time is shorter.	 Battery is not fully charged. The solar light is installed close to other light sources, which may keep the solar light from turning on at night automatically. The batteries are reaching the end of their useful life. 	 Make sure the solar light is located in an area where it can receive the maximum amount of full, direct sunlight everyday. Keeping the solar panel clean is equally important to ensure the maximum charging performance. Relocate the fixture or eliminate other light sources. Replace old batteries with new AA Ni-Cd or Ni-MH rechargeable batteries.

WARRANTY

The manufacturer warrants this product to be free of defects in material and workmanship for one (1) year from date of original purchase. The manufacturer agrees to repair or replace the defective product, at its own option. This warranty does not include any costs associated with the physical installation, removal or return of the product.

This warranty only extends to the original purchaser and is not transferable or assignable to subsequent purchasers. No warranty work will be provided under this warranty without reasonable proof of purchase.
