



LIFETIME LIMITED WARRANTY For Certain Residential and Agricultural Uses

The warrantor, herein after referring to Viance LLC ("Viance"), extends this Limited Warranty to "Original Consumer-Purchasers" of Ecolife™ Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood preservatives distributed and sold by Viance ("Ecolife" or "EL2"), in the United States. Original Consumer-Purchasers are defined herein to mean the owners of record of the private property first using it for residential and agricultural purposes immediately following installation of the warranted wood. This warranty is good from the date of purchase for as long as you own your property on which your new building code approved residential or approved agricultural use structures are built. This warranty is not transferable.

THIS WARRANTY COVERS:

Ecolife wood preservatives distributed and sold by Viance, including Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood pressure-treated wood products, when properly used in conjunction with a residential and agricultural structure, are warranted for the lifetime of the original Consumer-Purchaser against damage by fungal decay or termite infestation that makes the wood structurally unfit for the application for which it was used. Each piece of Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood treated wood covered by this warranty shall have been pressure treated to the proper AWPA end use retention level solely with EL2 preservative distributed and sold by Viance, and must bear the logo of an inspection agency that is sanctioned by the American Lumber Standards Committee. It must also have an Ecolife or EL2 Lifetime Limited Warranty or similar end tag retained from each piece of wood or shall be stamped with the Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood or similar quality stamp. The warrantor, within 60 days of validation of claim under his warranty, will arrange to exchange the qualifying damaged Ecolife pressure-treated wood for new wood of the same type.

THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER AND VIANCE SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR:

1. This warranty does not cover Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood treated wood used for commercial, industrial or commonly owned property (including condominiums) or multifamily apartment buildings, building poles or building timbers in structural applications, commercial vineyard stakes, lattice, peeler core landscape timbers or specialty items that have been milled after treatment.
2. Wood that was used in the manner that it was not intended. The proper use for each type of wood is identified on the end tag or stamp that is attached to each piece of wood. Ecolife is standardized by the AWPA for Above Ground applications only, and cannot be used in applications where the wood incurs direct contact with the ground.
3. Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood pressure-treated wood used in foundation systems or used in salt water immersion applications
4. Damage resulting from any cause other than fungal decay or termites.
5. Damages caused by natural change in physical appearance of wood beyond the control of the treated wood product, including but not limited to cracking, checking, cupping, and warping of the wood.
6. Costs associated with the delivery, installation, removal or reinstallation of Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood pressure-treated wood products.
7. Any incidental or consequential damages claimed to be a result of failure of Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood pressure treated wood.

The obligation of the warrantor under this warranty is limited to replacement of lumber in accordance with the terms of this warranty. There are no warranties offered by the warrantor other than those described herein. Nothing in this warranty shall create additional implied warranties. Some state and local laws vary with regard to duration of implied warranties and limitations of incidental or consequential damages contained

in such implied warranties. In any event the warrantor will comply with the laws of the state in which a limited warranty is validated. Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood or other EL2 pressure-treated wood are not maintenance-free products. Over time, foot traffic, weathering and the sun's ultra-violet rays will affect the water repellency and the wood's surface in general. To help maximize surface protection and to keep your wood looking better longer, we recommend that a surface-applied water repellent be applied every one to two years.

HOW TO MAKE CLAIMS

Original Consumer-Purchaser must present, to the warrantor, the original invoice or retailer receipt showing date, amount, and item of EL2 pressure-treated wood purchased and end tags of wood claimed to be damaged. When making any warranty claim, you may be required to send photographs and sections of damaged wood. In addition, the warrantor reserves the right to have a representative inspect and test all wood claimed to be damaged. Failure to use this product in accordance with instructions or restrictions printed on the end tag voids this warranty.

To make a claim under this warranty, send your claim along with the original invoice or retailer receipt showing date and list of Ecolife Stabilized Weather-Resistant Wood or other EL2 pressure-treated wood products purchased with an equivalent number of end tags or photo of the quality control stamp (if so stamped) to verify the purchase to:
