

MONO POSTS

InstallationInstructions

Installation Time: Approximately 15 Minutes Tools Required: None

- 1. Choose the correct size and strength Mono-Post for the project based on construction documents (Fig.1)
- 2. Adjust screw to slightly short of the length needed between footer and load carrying beam at installation location
- 3. Place Mono-Post vertically between footer and beam with the adjustment nut and screw on the footer (adjustable end down)
- 4. Adjust screw to wedge the Mono-Post between footer and beam, tighten until Mono-Post is firmly centered directly under the load carrying beam and the footer below (Fig. 2)
- 5. Additional screw adjustments may be made during construction to keep floor level
- 6. Poured concrete basement floor permanently locks Mono-Post adjustment (Fig.3)

TAMPERPROOF ADJUSTMENT: MONO-POST SHOULD BE POSITIONED WITH ADJUSTMENT NUT AND SCREW AT THE FOOTER.
