

steps to care

taking care of your comforters



When not in use, store your comforter folded in a cool, dry place.



Professional cleaning recommended from time to time.



In case of stains, spot clean with damp cloth or sponge; blot to remove excess water; use hairdryer right after to avoid leaving any residual moisture behind.



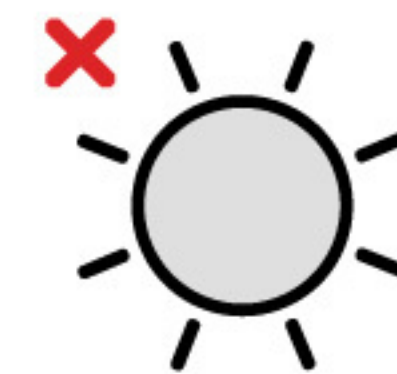
Treat spills such as food and other substances by scooping away the spill with the help of a spoon. Begin at the edges and move towards the centre to avoid the spread. Brush the remains with a soft, dry brush.



If a yarn is loose, clip it. Do not pull.



Remove spilled liquids as quickly as possible by blotting. Do not rub.



Avoid direct sunlight and moisture.



Do not iron and machine wash.



Do not use abrasive or harsh chemicals to clean as this may damage the finish.



Do not place heavy objects on your comforter to maintain its plushness.
