











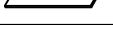



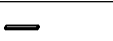

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

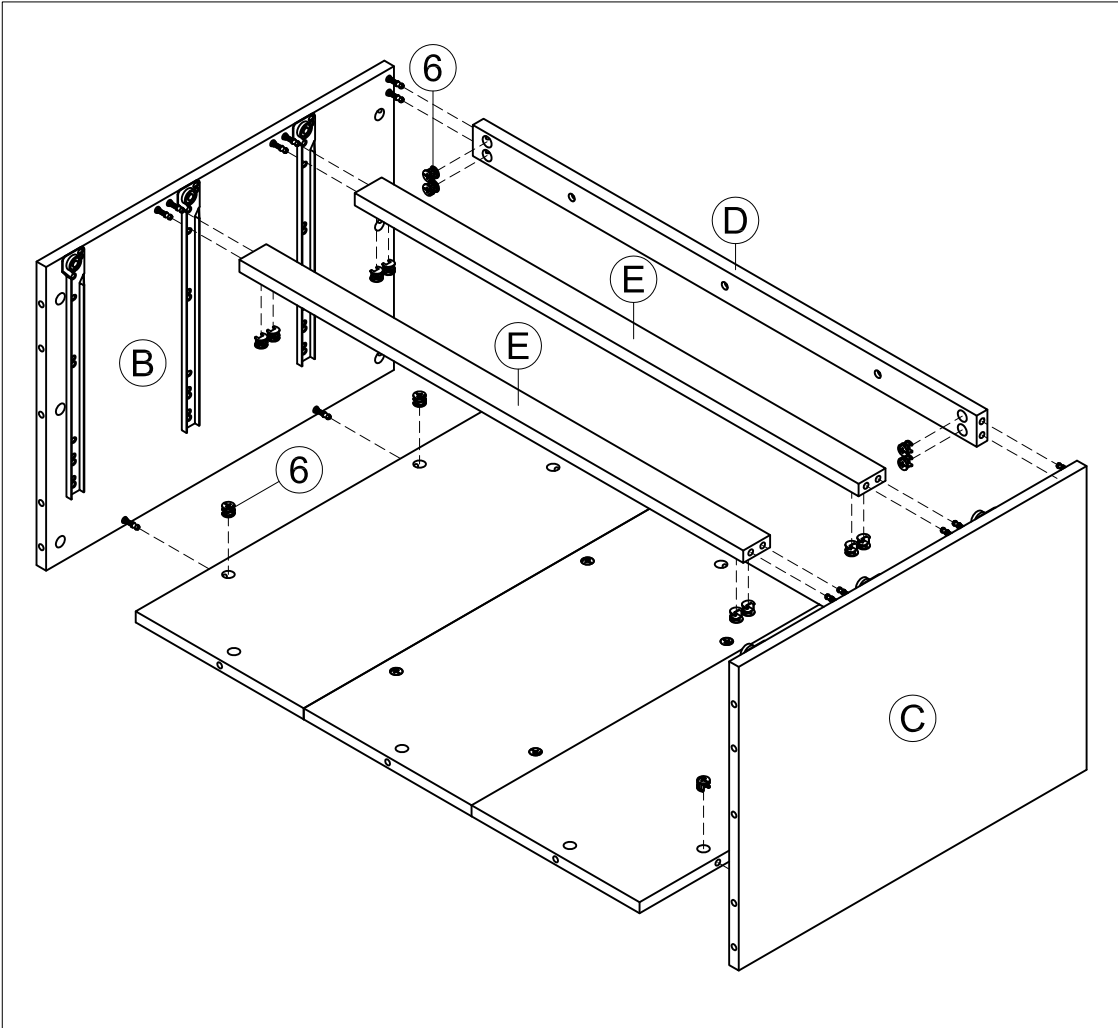

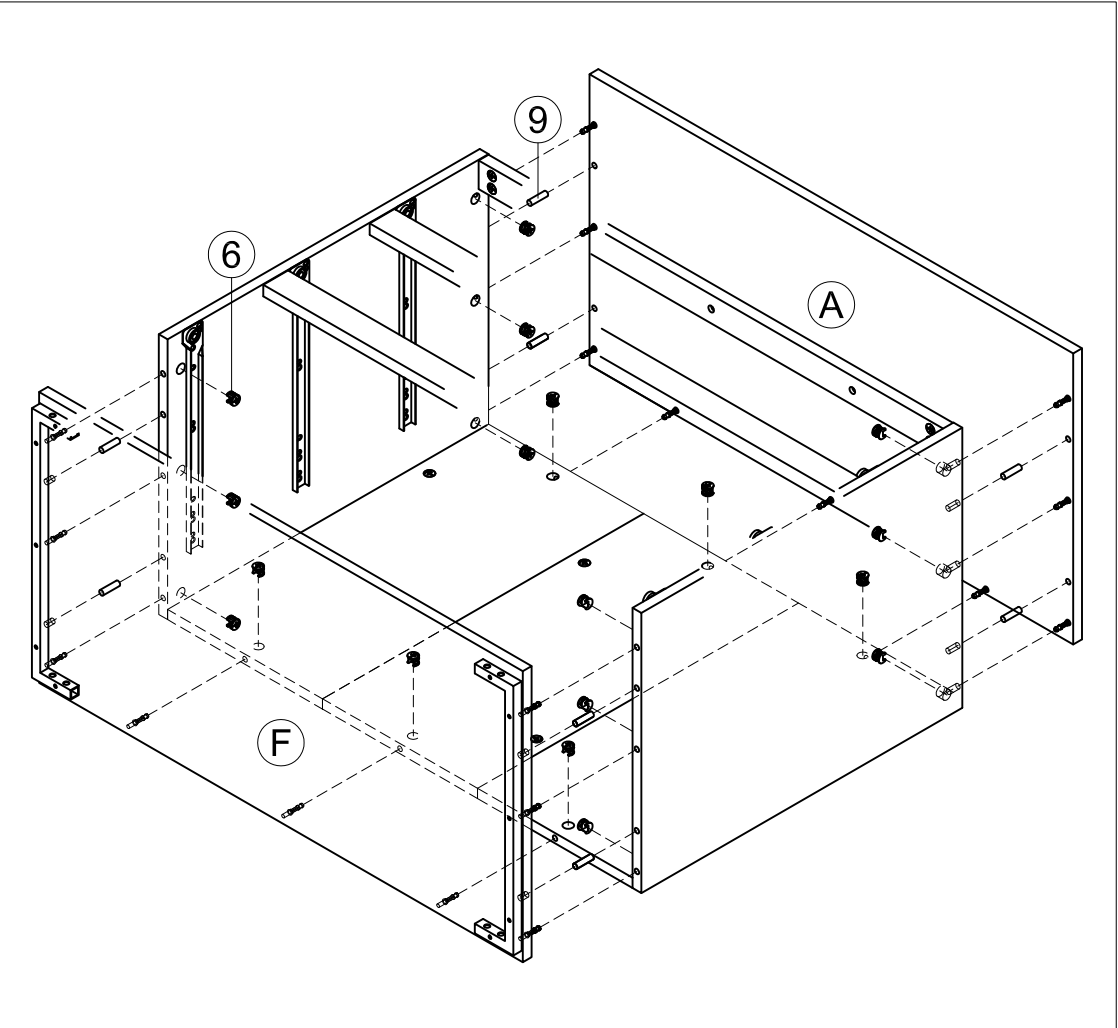
STEP 2 ATTACH SIDE BACK PANELS TO MIDDLE BACK PANEL USING CAMLOCKS.

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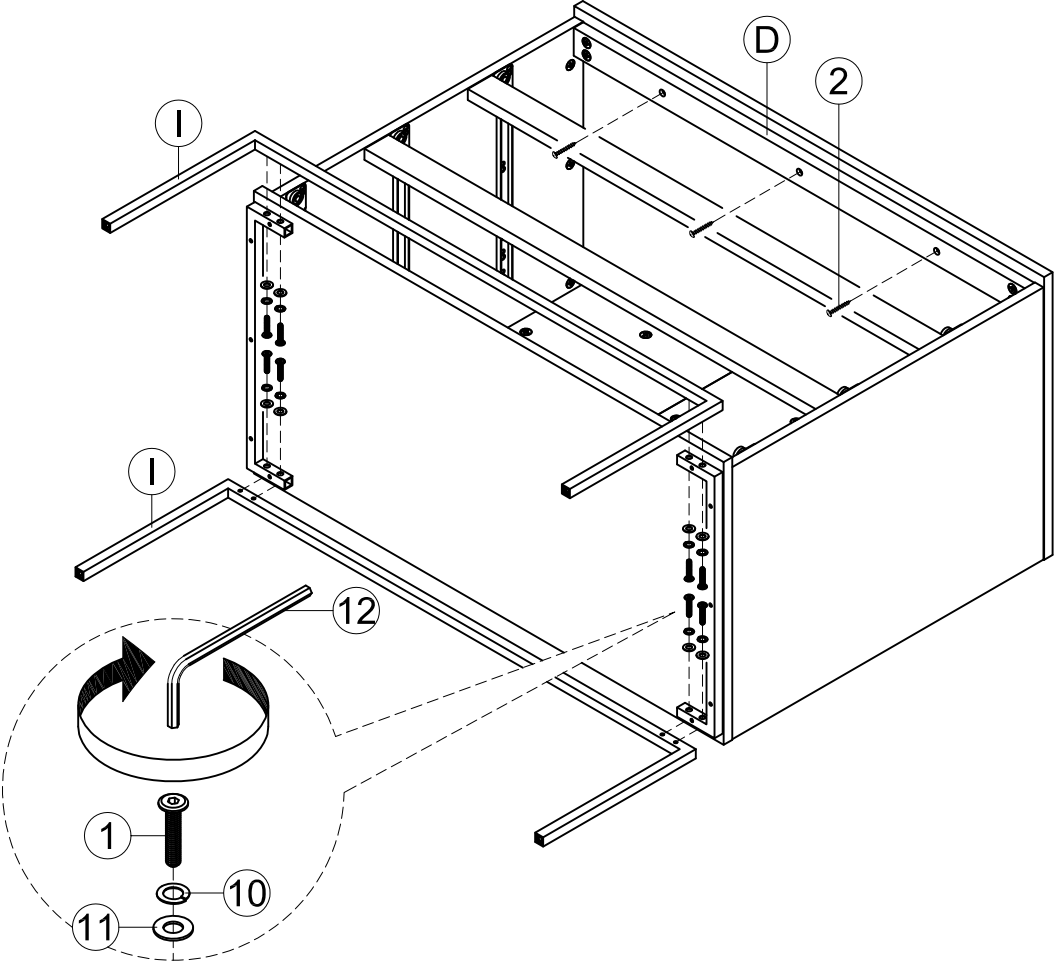
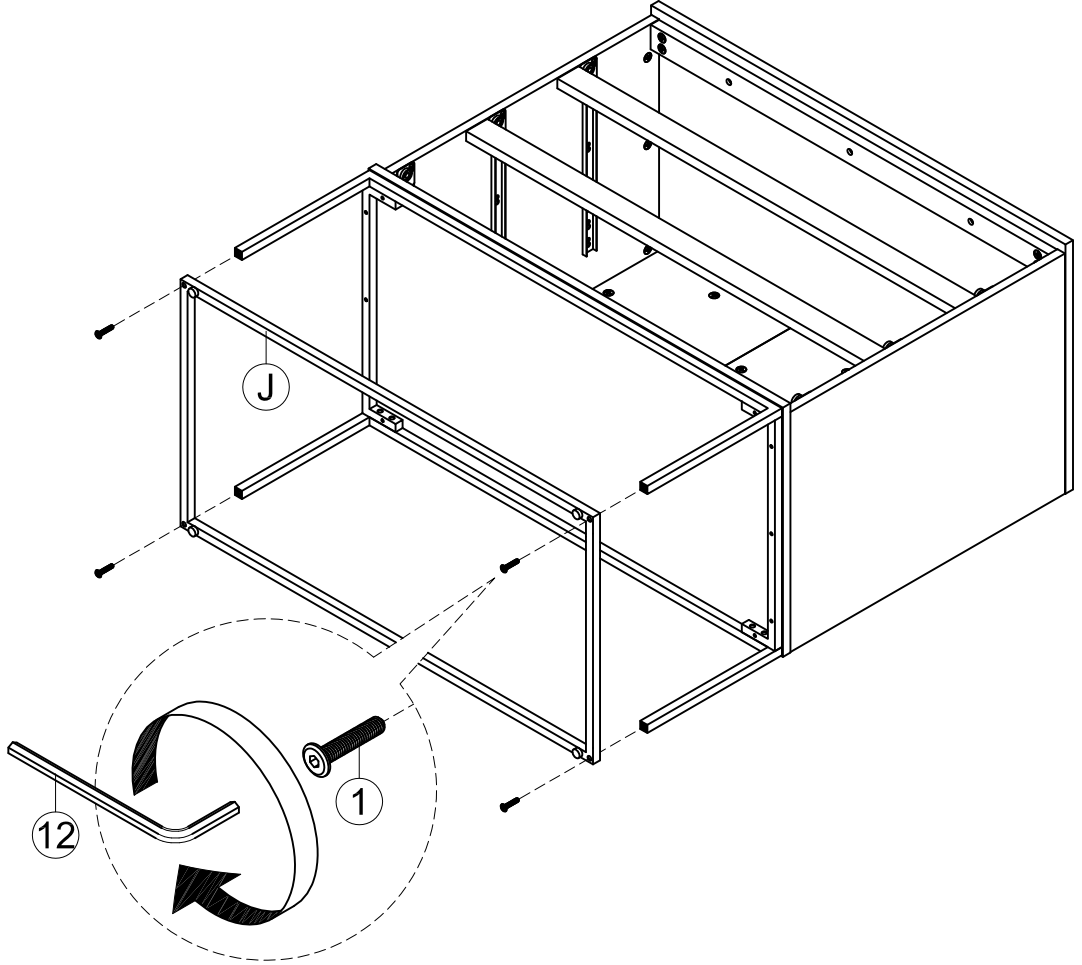
STEP 3 ATTACH LEFT AND RIGHT ASSEMBLIES TO UNIT, TOP AND FRONT RAILS USING CAM LOCKS.



STEP 4 ATTACH TOP AND BOTTOM PANELS TO UNIT USING CAMLOCKS AND WOODEN DOWELS.

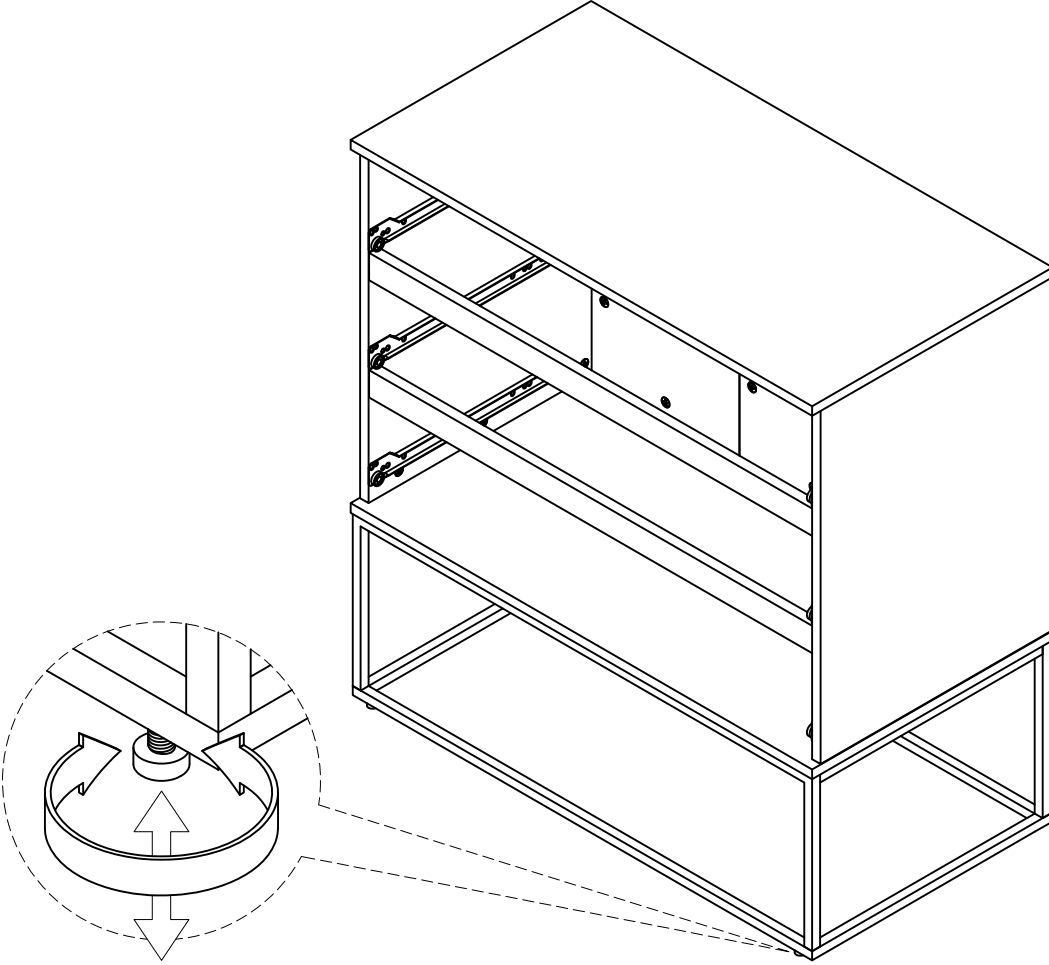
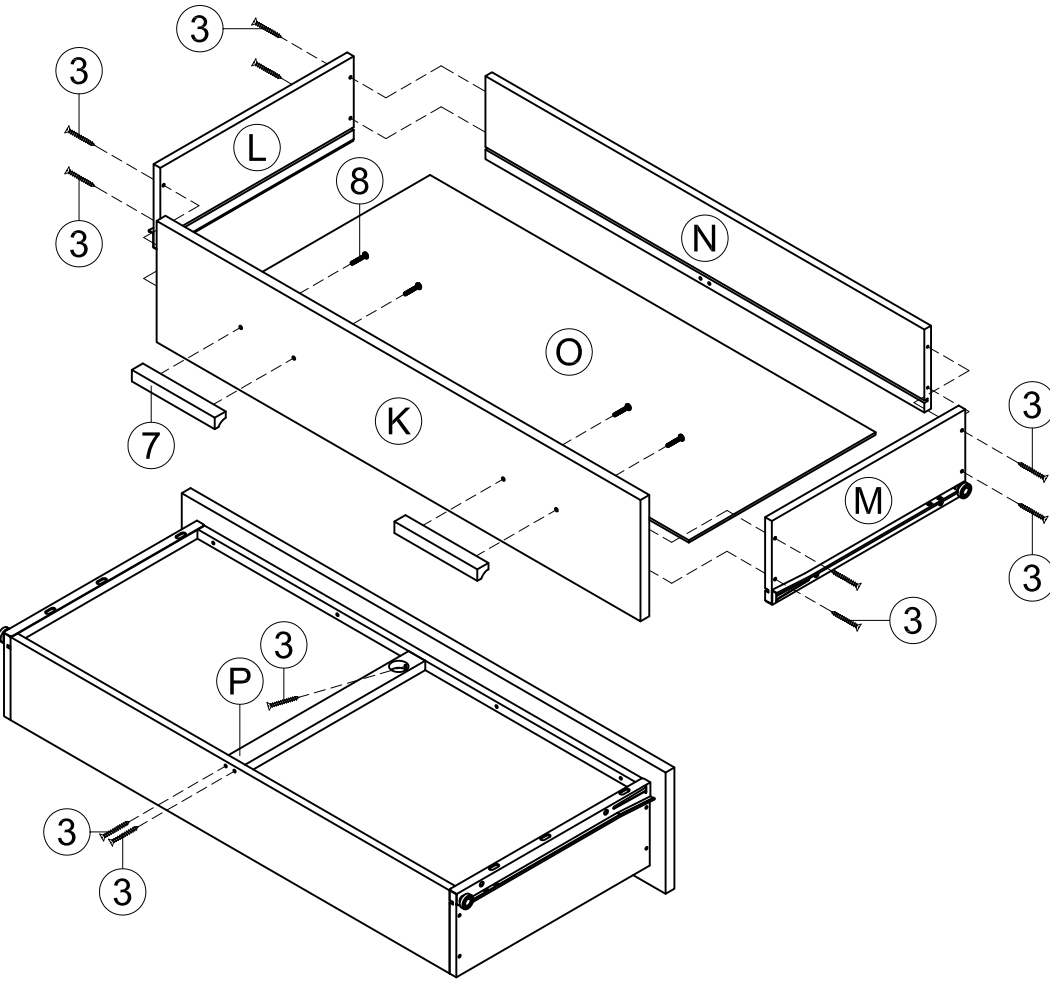
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<p>STEP 5 ATTACH 1"ROUND HEAD SCREWS THROUGH TOP RAIL TO STRENGTHEN ITS CONSTRUCTION. ATTACH LEG FRAMES TO UNIT USING 30 MM BOLTS, SPRING WASHERS AND FLAT WASHERS. ATTACH BOLTS USING ALLEN KEY. NOTE: DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN THE BOLTS.</p>	<p>STEP 6 ATTACH BASE FRAME TO UNIT USING 30 MM BOLTS. TIGHTEN BOLTS USING ALLEN KEY. NOTE: TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS FROM STEP 5.</p>

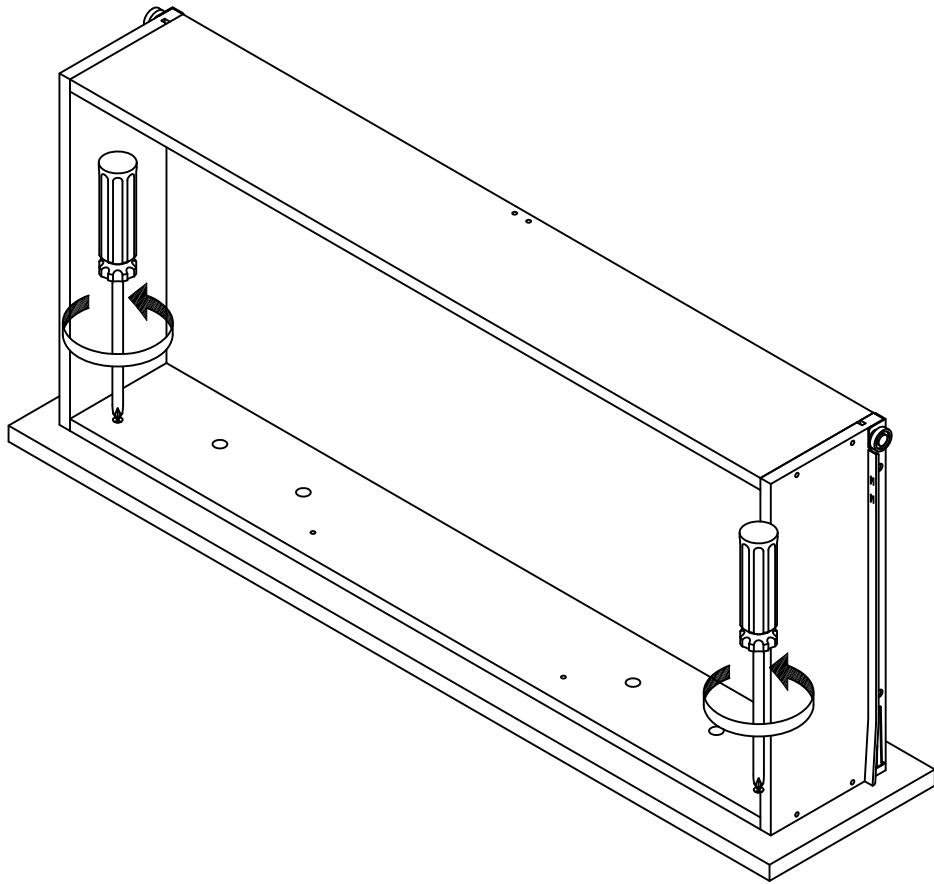
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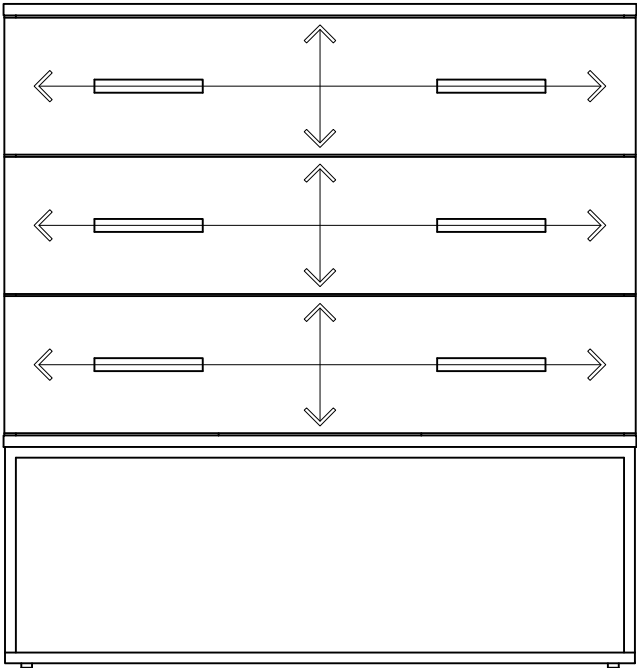

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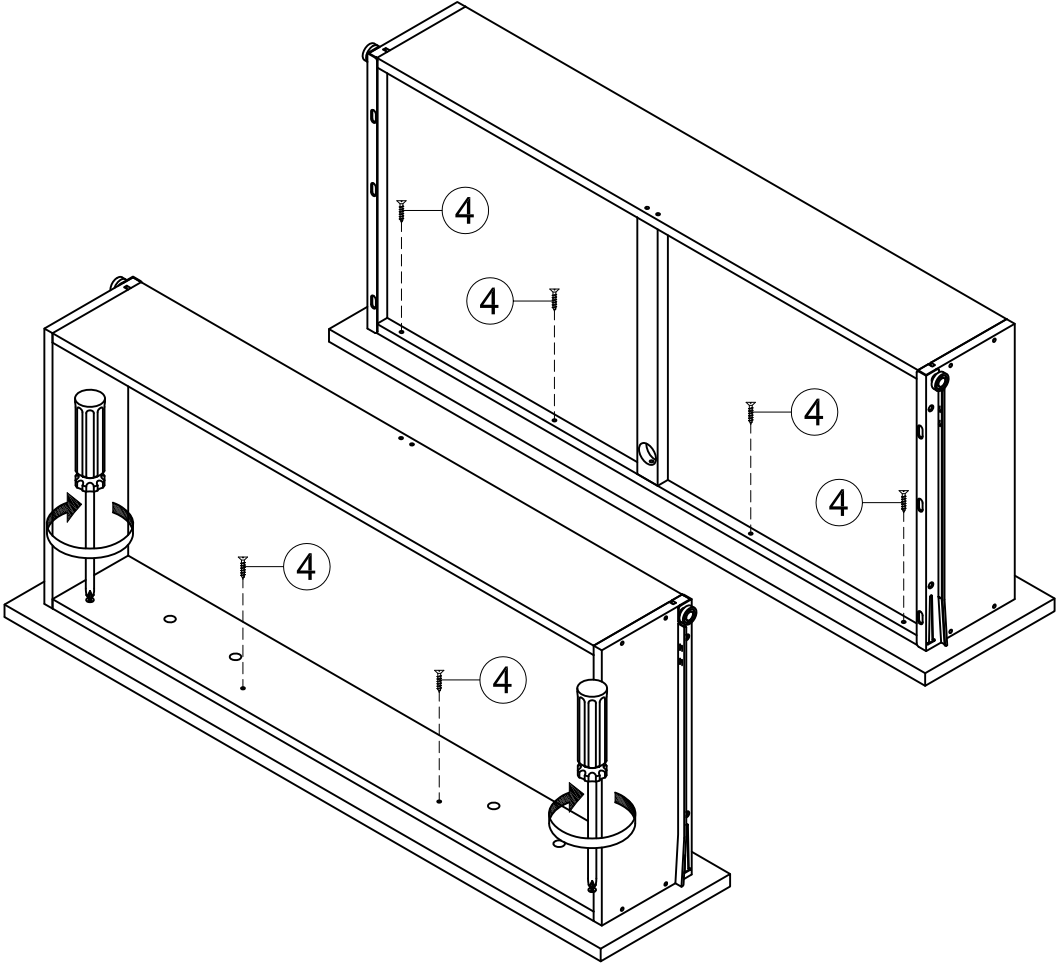
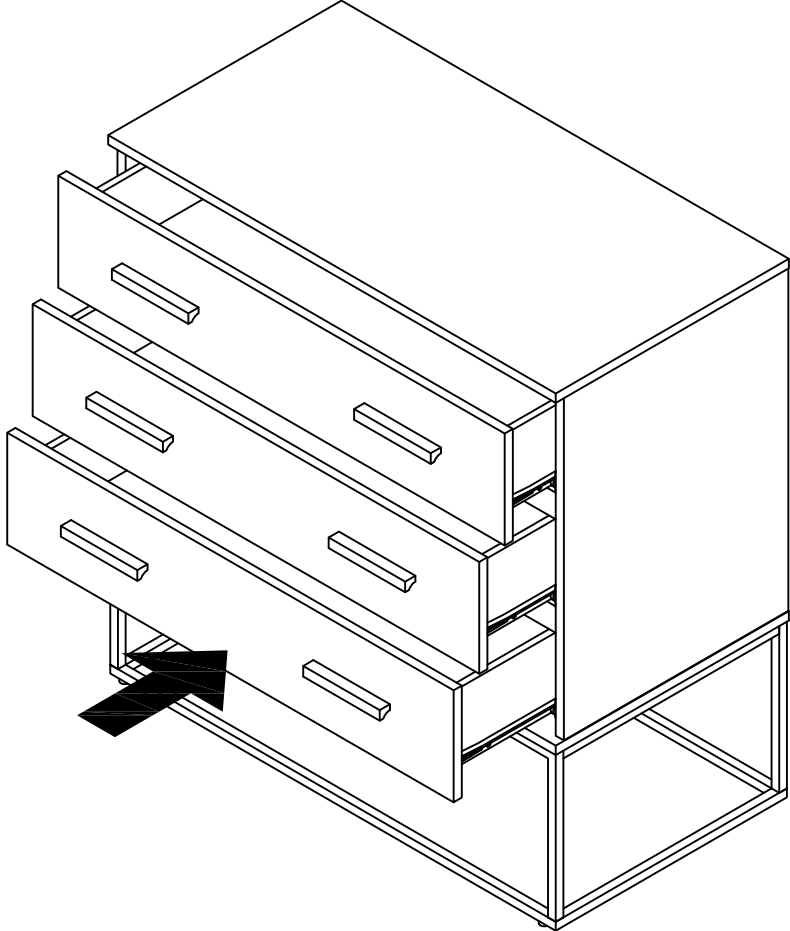
STEP 9 LOOSEN SLIGHTLY THE SCREWS PRE-INSTALLED ON THE BACK OF THE DRAWER FRONTS.



STEP 10 INSERT THE DRAWER INTO THE UNIT, THEN ADJUST THE DRAWER FRONT PANEL LEFT OR RIGHT AND UP OR DOWN UNTIL THE DRAWER GAPS LOOK PROPORTIONAL.
