Van Zyverden's CANNA TROPICANNA®



Genus name comes from the Greek word Kanna meaning "reed". Cannas are among the most colorful summer bulbs with ruffled spikes tapering to refined buds, boasting immense paddle shaped leaves. Their great reedy canes and palmy foliage make for large, magnificent plants, yielding blooms all summer long for long lasting curb appeal. They are deer resistant and appear most dramatic when grouped in masses. They are fast growers with large flowers.

About This Variety: Canna Tropicanna®, Canna indica 'Phasion', is a popular variety known for its vibrant foliage. The large, tropical-looking leaves are a delightful mix of green, bronze, orange and pink, creating a bold and colorful display. The foliage alone makes it a standout choice for adding a touch of exotic flair to gardens, patios or even as a focal point in containers. Eye-catching flowers emerge atop tall stalks in shades of red, orange and yellow adding even more showstopping appearance. Adds much vertical interest and drama in the garden. Robust growth habit and upright, a favorite among garden enthusiasts and landscape designers alike.

Growing Instructions: Where not hardy, plant outdoors in early summer 2" deep, setting the rhizome in the hole, 'eyes' (shoots) up. Cannas do best with a good supply of water.

Care Tip: As flowers fade, deadhead to promote continued flowering. They like moist conditions.


