**STEP 1**

NEW LAWNS

OVERSEEDING

**PREPARE**

**FOR BARE SPOTS/NEW LAWNS:**  
Remove debris, then rake the soil to loosen and smooth the top layer.

**PARA ZONAS CON HUECOS O CÉSPED NUEVO:** Retire los desechos y luego rastrille la tierra para aflojar y suavizar la capa superior.

**FOR OVERSEEDING/THIN AREAS:**  
Start by mowing existing grass as short as possible followed by removing debris. Then rake the soil to loosen and smooth the top layer.

**PARA RESEMBRA O ZONAS DELGADAS:** Corte el césped existente lo mas corto sea posible y elimine los desechos. Luego, rastrille la tierra para aflojar y suavizar la capa superior.

**STEP 2**

**APPLY FERTILIZER**

Apply a starter fertilizer at the manufacturer's recommended rate.

**APLIQUE UN FERTILIZANTE:** Aplique la cantidad de fertilizante recomendada por el fabricante.

**STEP 3**

**APPLY SEED**

Spread the seed evenly using a drop, rotary or hand-held spreader according to the recommended spreader settings listed. Rake gently to work your seed & fertilizer into the soil.

**APLICACIÓN:** Disemine las semillas de manera uniforme con un esparcador de caída, rotativo o manual, de acuerdo con las configuraciones recomendadas y enumeradas del esparcador. Rastrille suavemente para que las semillas y el fertilizante germinen en la tierra.

**STEP 4**

**WATER**

Keep the soil moist by watering daily as needed until grass sprouts and reaches about 3" tall.

**RIEGUE:** Mantenga la tierra húmeda al regar lo que sea necesario por día hasta que el césped brote y alcance alrededor de 3 pulgadas (7,62 cm) de alto.

### ADDITIONAL CARE TIPS

- 1 Mow lawn when grass height reaches 3" tall
- 2 Avoid removing more than 1/3 of the total grass blade length at any single mowing
- 3 Hot summers can be stressful on your lawn; increase the mowing height during hot & dry periods to reduce stress on lawn



**MOST IMPORTANTLY - Don't kill the grass before it starts by using weed control (pros call it preemergent) on your lawn until your grass has reached its full mowing height of 3"**
