LIGHT

I tolerate low light, but grows faster and becomes more dramatic in a bright spot from a west or east window.



WATER

Water me when the top couple inches into the soil are dry, I prefer above average humidity levels. Allow water to drain thoroughly; remove any excess water.





FOOD

Feed me once or twice a year during Spring and Summer with a fertilizer formulated for houseplants.



FEATURES

I have large, dramatic leaves that can purify the air and I am super easy to grow.
