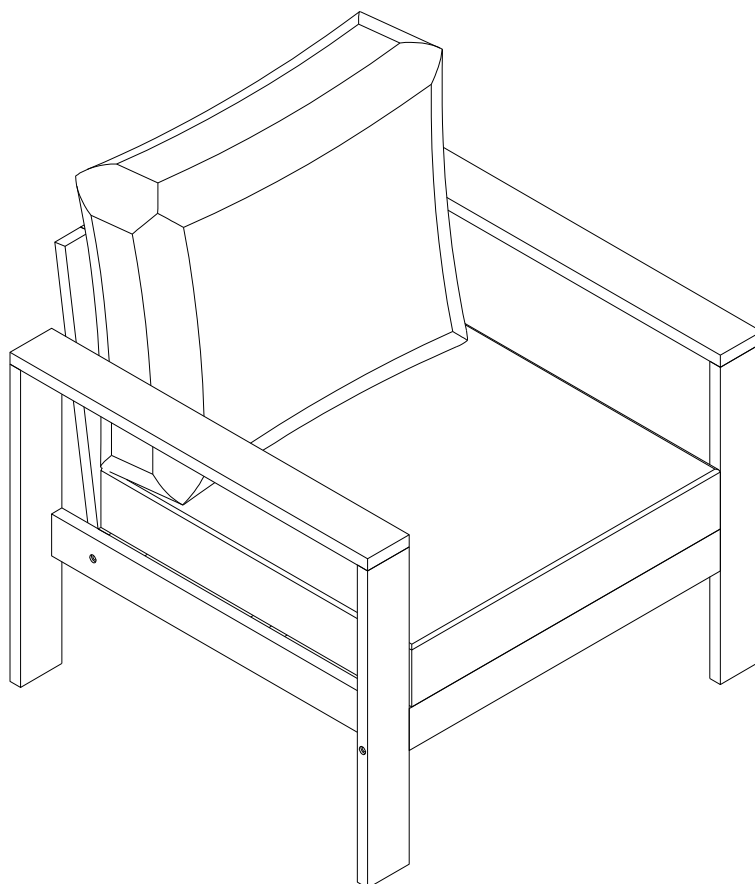

Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

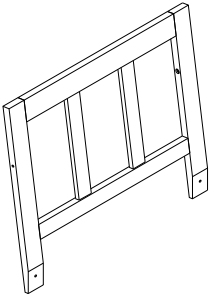
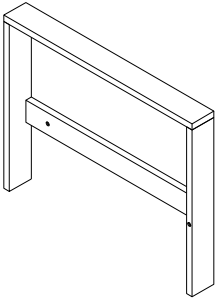
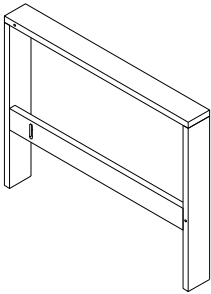
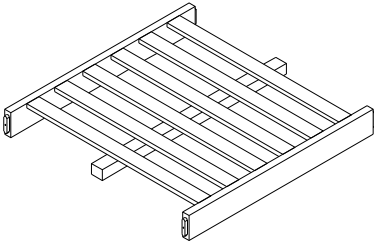
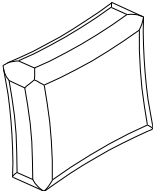
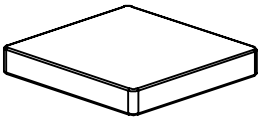


Caution: This Chair is NOT a TOY.

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet.



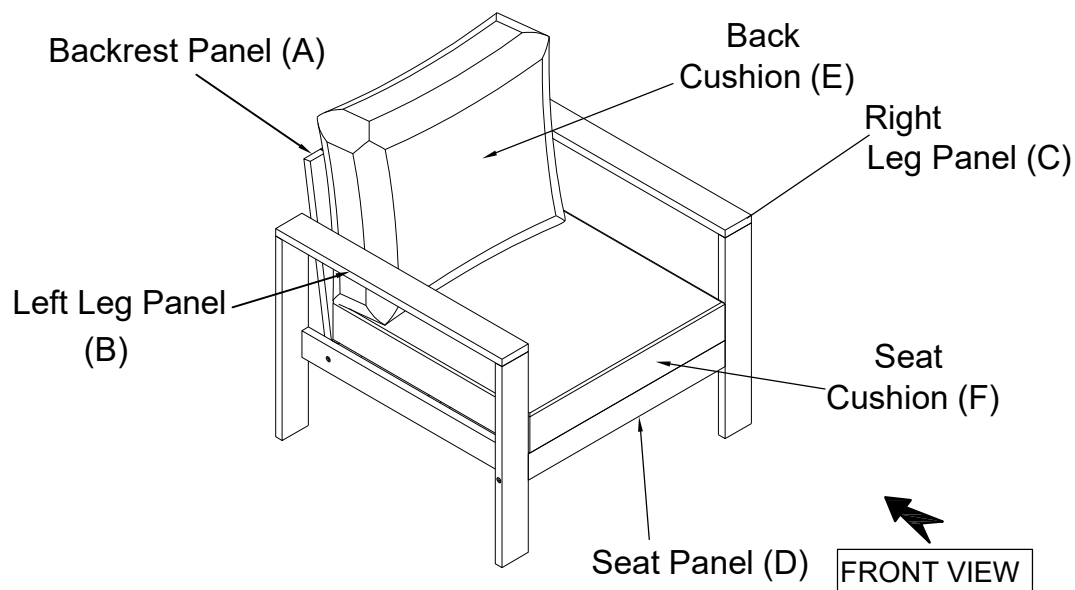
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam).



- Save all packaging until finished.

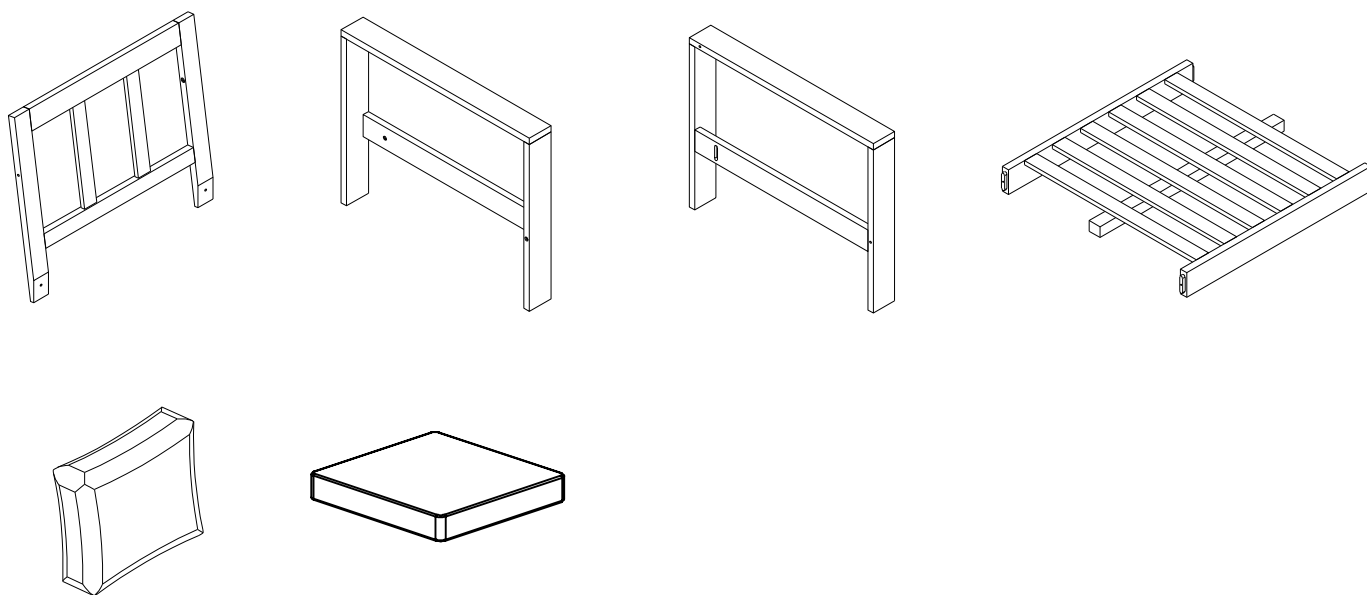
Assembly Preparation

Overview

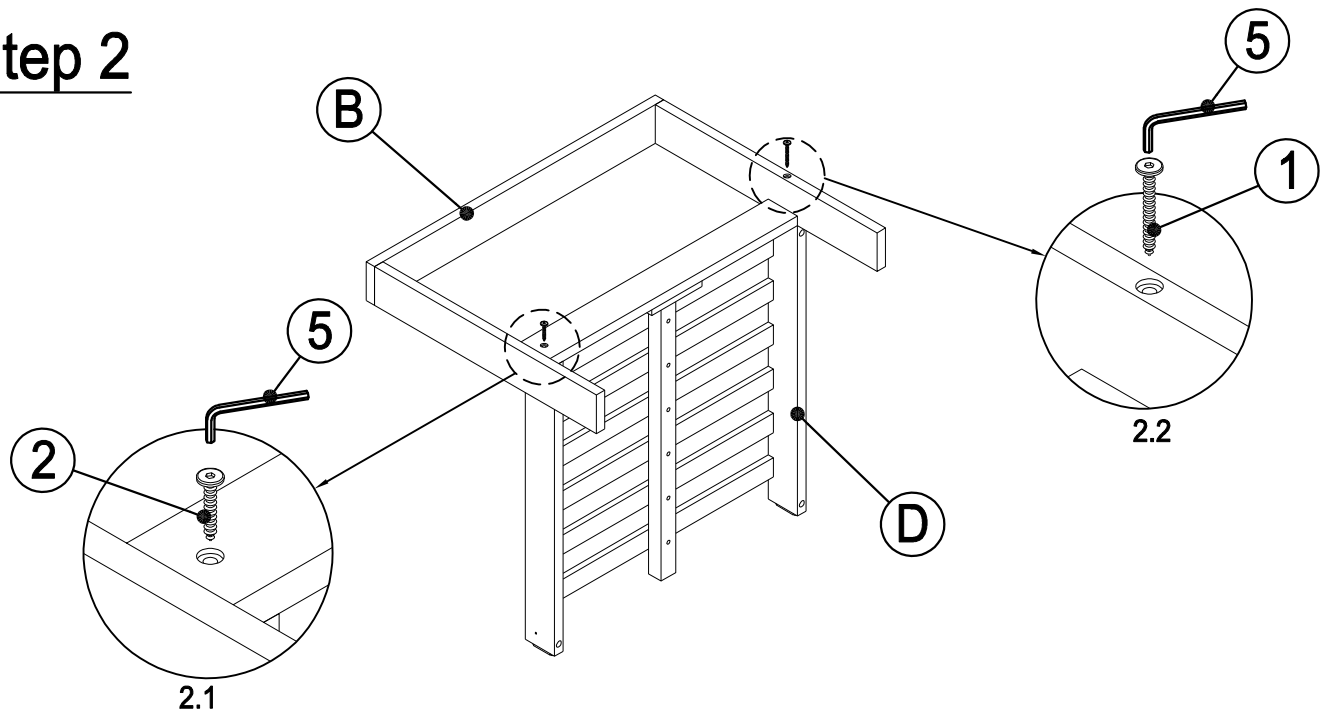


This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1

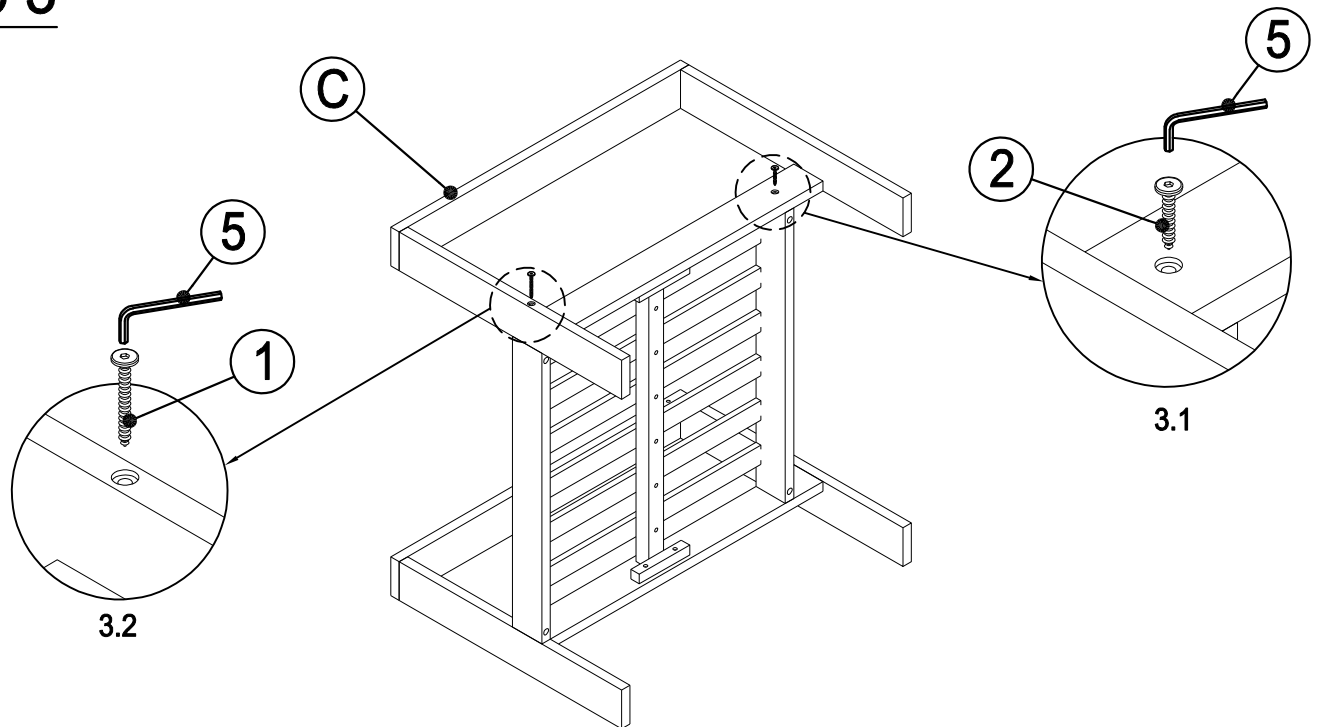
With assistance from your adult partner, place the seat Panel (D) onto a clean, non marring surface. Panels then

2.1 : secure Left Leg Panel (B) by using Screws (2) and Allen Wrench (5).

2.2 : secure Left Leg Panel (B) by using Screws (1), and Allen Wrench (5).

DO NOT fully tighten the Screws.

Step 3



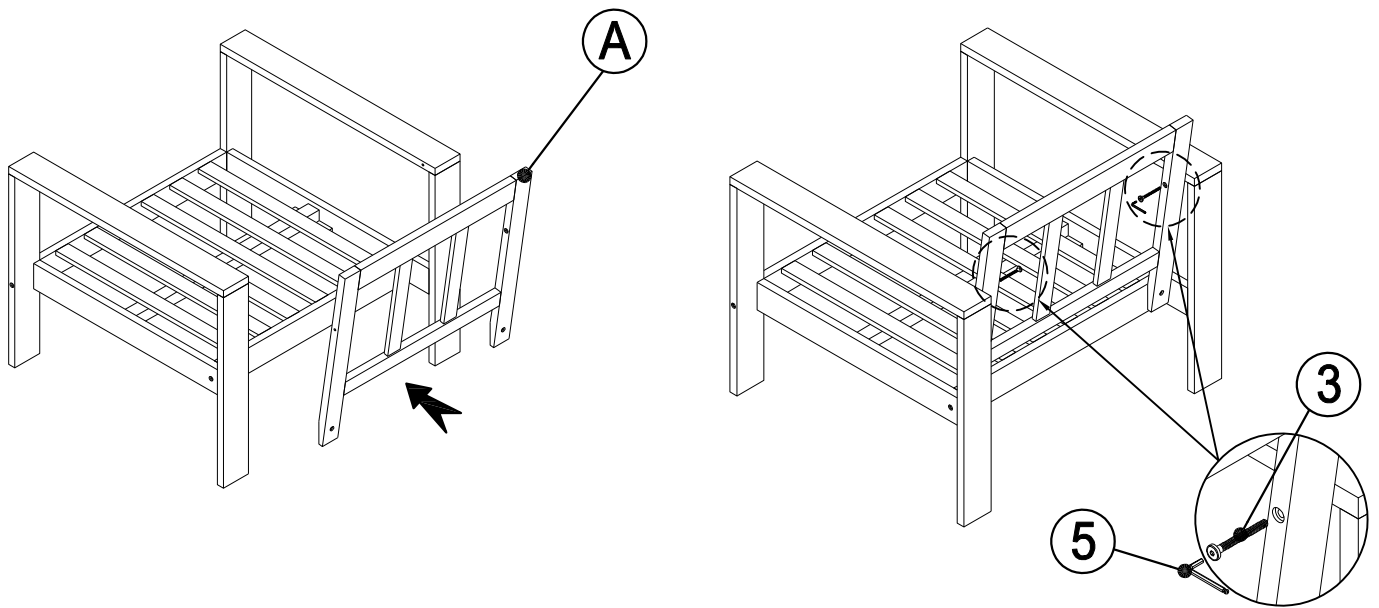
Attach the seat Panel (D) to Right Leg Panel (C) then

3.1 : secure Right Leg Panel (C) by using Screws (2) and Allen Wrench (5).

3.2 : secure Right Leg Panel (C) by using Screws (1), and Allen Wrench (5).

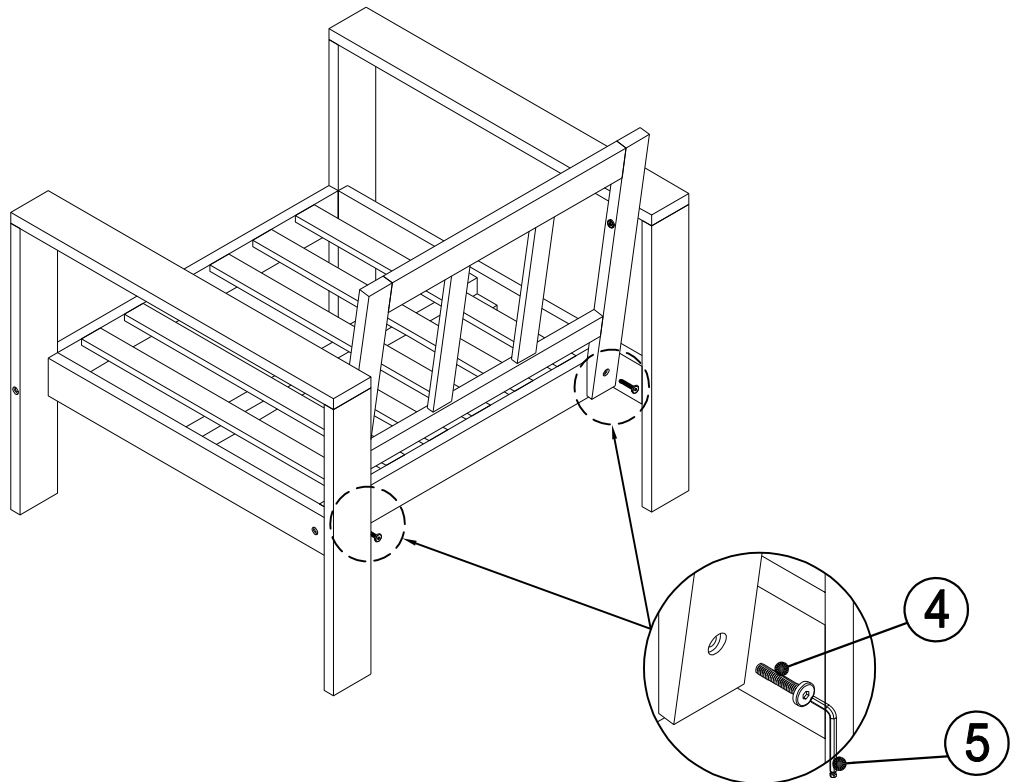
DO NOT fully tighten the Screws.

Step 4



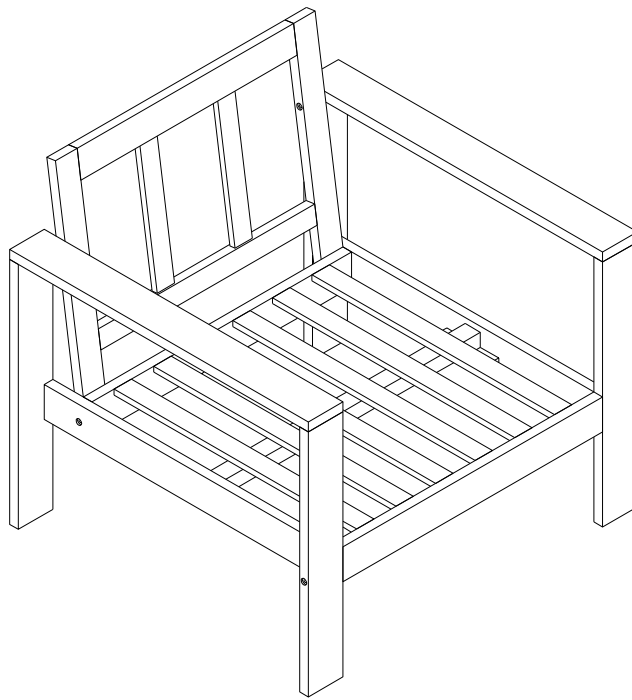
Attach Backrest Panel (A) to Left Leg Panel (B) and Right Leg Panel (C) by using Bolts (3) with Allen Wrench (5).
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 5



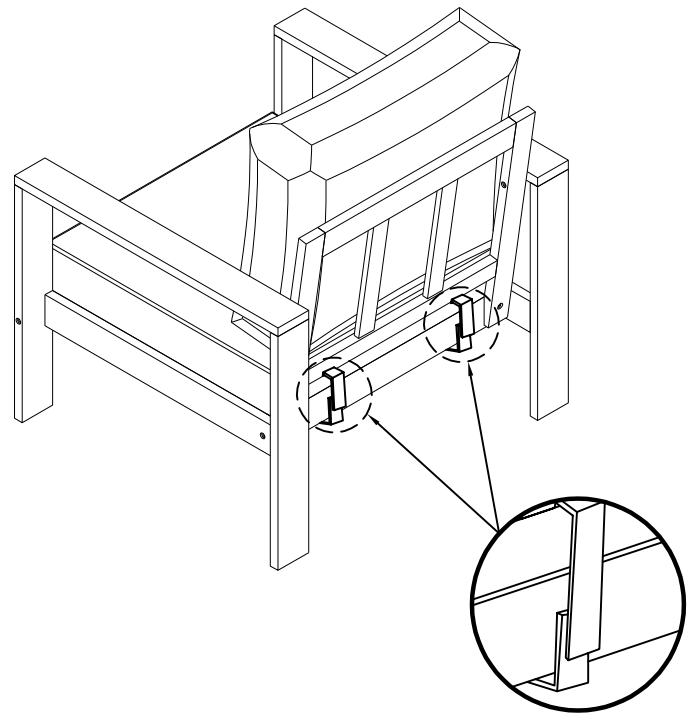
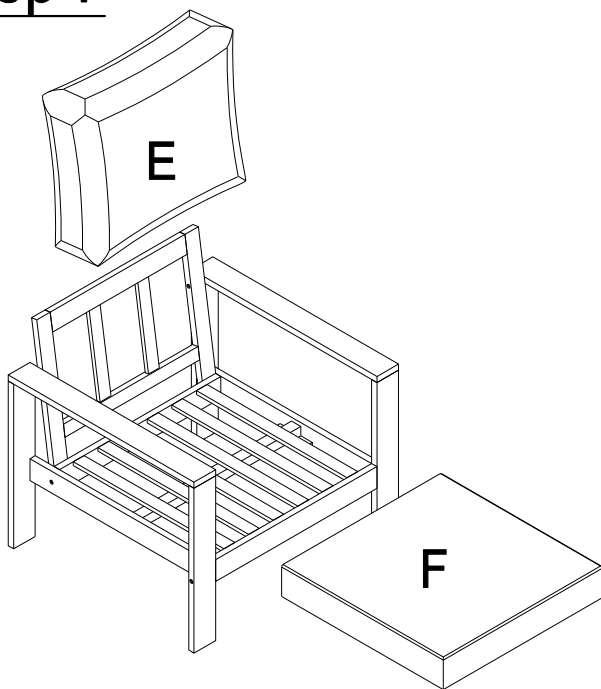
Attach Backrest Panel (A) to Seat Panel (D) by using Bolts (4) with Allen Wrench (5).
Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 6



Turn the Chair right side up.
Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.
Ensure all bolts and screws are fully locked into position and secured.

Step 7



Next, install the Seat Cushion (F) & Back Cushion (E) into the Chair.
Tie the magic tape straps of Seat Cushion (F) and Back Cushions (E) to Seat Panel (D) and Backrest Panel (A) as pictured.
Your Chair is ready for use.
This chair can only be used on flat, level surface.
