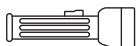

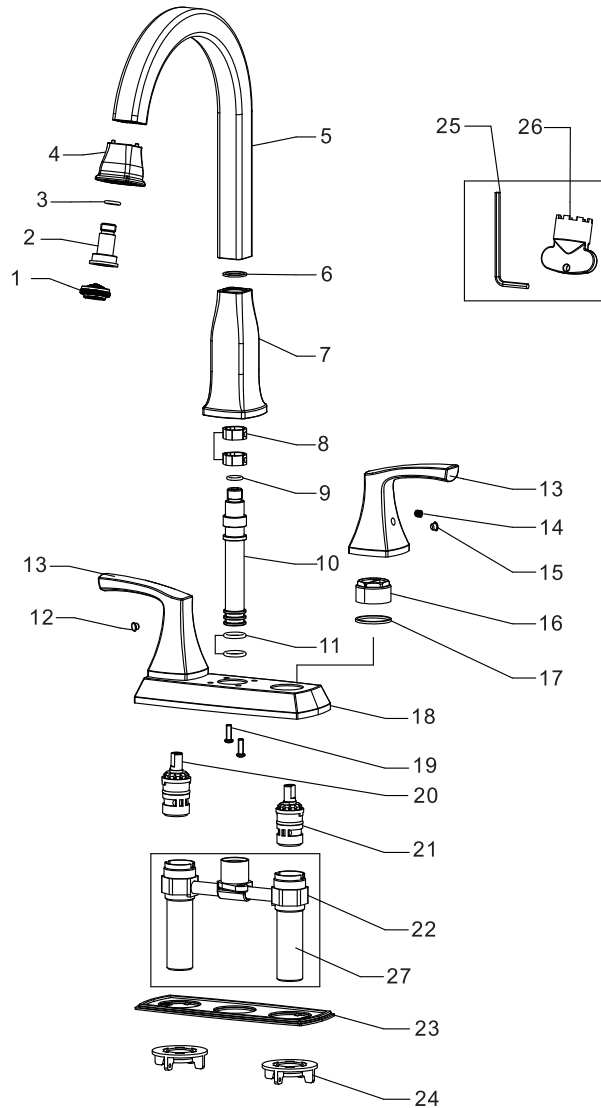

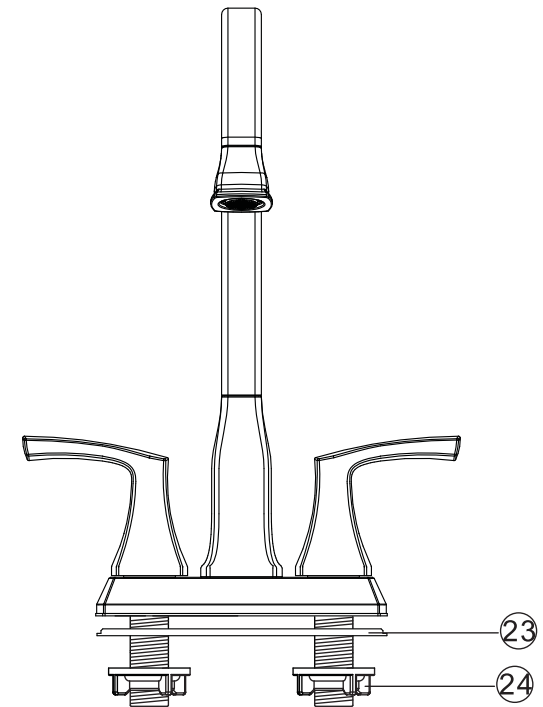
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Parts Diagram

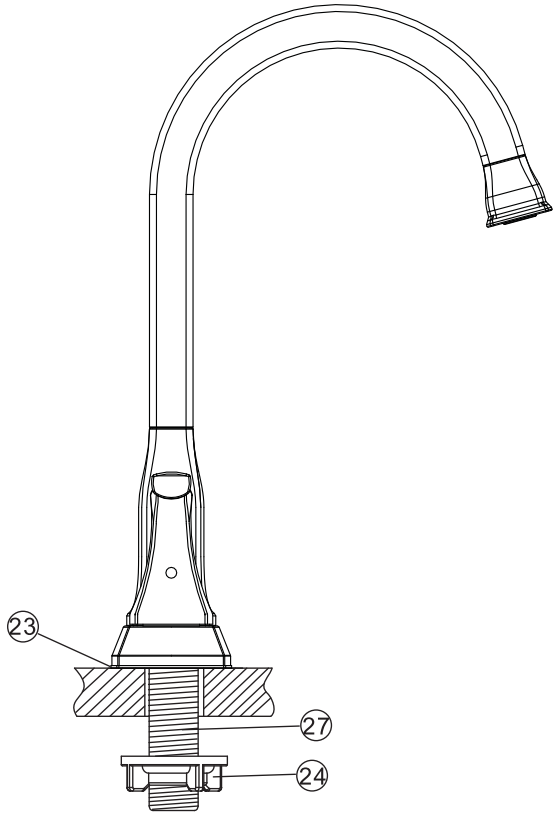
Preparation / Mounting



1. Shut off water supply and drain lines. Clean sink surface thoroughly. Make sure mounting area is clean and dry.
2. Remove the plastic locknut (24) from faucet. Don't remove the putty plate (23) from faucet.

Faucet Installation

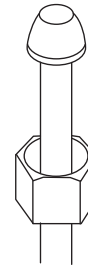


3. Position the faucet on the countertop with putty plate (23). Replace the plastic locknuts (24) on the faucet tailpiece (27) and tighten the plastic locknuts (24) by hand.

Configuration

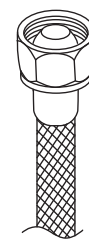
A. Faucet tailpiece

C. Faucet tailpiece



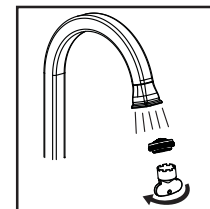
Connect to water supply lines with either:

- (A) 3/8" O.D. Copper tubing (ball nose risers with the coupling nuts or;
- (B) 3/8" Copper tubing (no ball) with supplied tube head interior connector or;
- (C) IPS faucet connectors (1/2")



Warning:

The supply valve and supply lines are not included.



Important:

Let both hot and cold water run for one minute. This will help clean any debris that might clog the system.
