



Prop65 Consumer Product Warning

Standard use on packaging

The new safe-harbor warning for exposure to a chemical that is listed as both a carcinogen and a reproductive toxicant must now state:

 **WARNING:** This product can expose you to chemicals including lead, which is known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm. For more information go to www.P65Warnings.ca.gov.

On-product or where space is limited (small labels)

The short-form, on-product or a product's immediate packaging warning "must be in a type size no smaller than the largest type size used for other consumer information on the product/packaging." It must appear in a minimum of 6-point type. For an on-product/packaging, shortened warning should appear as below:

The warning symbol is a required element of safe harbor warning content. The symbol consists of a black exclamation point in a yellow equilateral triangle with a bold, black outline. The symbol must be placed to the left of the text of the warning in a size no smaller than the height of the word "WARNING".

If the sign, label, or shelf tag for the product is not printed using the color yellow, the symbol may be provided in black and white.
