Attach the Crossbar (A) to Outlet Box Box and secure by threading Outlet Box Screws (not supplied) into the А Mounting Holes on the Outlet Box. Tighten until snug. **Outlet Box** C Fixture Body Screw Crossbar Α x 1 x 1 STEP 3 - Make Wire Connections Mounting Screw A. Use standard wire connectors (not included) to make all wire В x 2 connections. Twist connectors until wires are tightly joined together. Wrap each connection with approved electrical tape and carefully stuff all the connected wires into the Outlet Box. Note: If the electrical wire is going to be cut shorter than provided. Please leave approximately 10" of wire extruding from the Ceiling STEP 1 - Adjust Fixture Height Canopy. You will need to identify the "L" line wire and the "N" wire before you cut the excess wire off. One is labeled N and the other A. Push the Pin on the bottom of the Ceiling Canopy, adjust the Cable labeled L. To do this strip back the clear wire covering the 2 fixture wires as far as you need to. This will expose each fixture wire in or out of the Ceiling Canopy to achieve your desired hanging individually. Separate the "L" wire from the other one and re-label height. Once your desired hanging height is achieved, release the the wire near where you want to make the cut. Be sure to mark the pin and move the Slider close to hex nut inside of the Ceiling wire on the side of the fixture and not on the excess wire being cut Canopy. and removed. Do the same labeling with the "N" wire.
