

Installation Guide SEMI-RECESSED BATHROOM SINK

Prior to Installation

<u>A</u> Read the following instructions carefully before you begin this installation:

• Use the cut-out template provided by Eridanus.

• Due to the handmade production, actual size of the item received may vary with a tolerance of 2%. It's best to cut the countertop according to the actual product to ensure the best alignment.

• Observe all local plumbing and building codes.

• Unpack and inspect sink to make sure it has not chipped or cracked during transit.

• Confirm you have all necessary parts by checking the parts list.

• Make sure the plumbing where sink is to be installed is in good condition and that there are no leaks or other problems that could cause issues during installation.

• The following installation diagrams are for general display and do not represent a specific model.

• Failure to install the sink with a licensed plumber shall void the warranty.





Installation Procedures

Step I. Cut Countertop

- Compare the cut-out template with the actual sink. Make adjustments if necessary.
- Cut along the inside line of the template.
- Place the cut-out template in the desired location on the countertop and trace the outside of it.

REMINDER Make sure to leave enough clearance between the sink and wall for faucet installation (At least 4 inches from the wall to the outermost of the sink for deck-mounted faucets).

• Drill a pilot hole and cut along the traced line on the countertop.



• Confirm that the size of the opening will fit the sink. Cut, sand and clean the countertop accordingly.

Step II. Mount Sink

• Flip the sink over and apply a bead of silicone caulk to the underside of the sink where it will contact the countertop.





• Place the sink into the countertop opening, check for alignment and press down firmly. Wipe away excess silicone caulk.



Step III. Check Plumbing

- Install the faucet and drain assembly as per the manufacturer's instructions.
- Check for any potential leakage area to complete installation.

Do's

✓ Remove stains promptly: If you notice any stains on the sink, it's important to remove them promptly. Use a cleaning solution specifically designed to remove the type of stain you're dealing with. For example, use a rust remover for rust stains and a hard water stain remover for hard water stains.

✓ Keep the sink dry: After using the sink, make sure to wipe it dry with a clean towel or cloth. Standing water can cause water spots and mineral buildup, which can be difficult to remove.

✓ Use a drain strainer: Use a drain strainer to prevent hair, soap, and other debris from clogging the drain. A clogged drain can lead to water damage and other problems.

Don'ts

× Avoid using harsh chemicals: Harsh chemicals such as bleach, ammonia, or acid-based cleaners can damage the surface of the sink. Avoid using these chemicals and opt for a mild cleaning solution instead.

Avoid placing heavy objects on the sink: Vitreous china is a durable material, but it can still crack or chip if heavy objects are placed on it. Avoid placing heavy objects on the sink and use a separate surface for storing items such as hair dryers or curling irons.

X Avoid hitting it with hard objects or dropping heavy items on it.

X Avoid direct contact with sharp and metallic objects.
