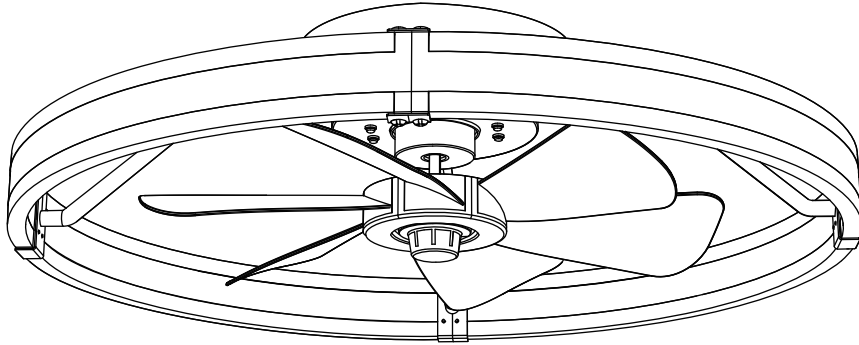

- The lighting kit is unreplaceable.

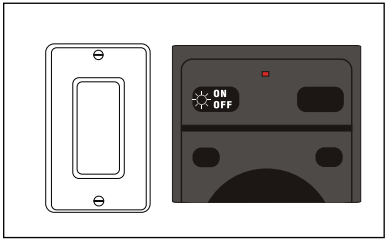
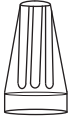
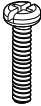
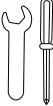


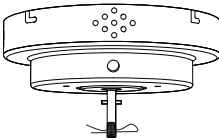
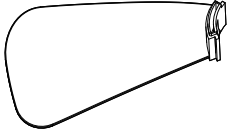
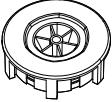
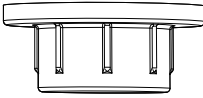
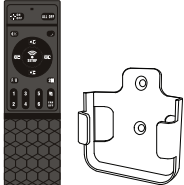

CEILING FAN

IMPORTANT WARNING

- To reduce the risk of electric shock, turn off all power sources.
- All wiring must comply with the National Electrical Code and local electrical codes. Electrical installation should be performed by a qualified licensed electrician.
- **WARNING:** To reduce the risk of personal injury, use only the two steel screws (and lock washers) provided with the outlet box for installation. Most outlet boxes are typically used to support lighting devices instead of fans and may need to be replaced. If in doubt, please consult a qualified electrician.
- Do not turn the fan blades until the fan installation is completed.
- To avoid personal injury or damage to the fan and other items, maintain and clean the fan with care.

HOW TO OPERATE YOUR CEILING FAN

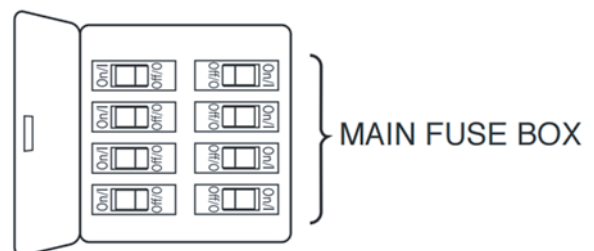
- **IMPORTANT:** Using a full range dimmer switch(not included) to control fan speed will damage the fan. To reduce the risk of fire or electrical shock, do not use a full range dimmer switch to control the fan speed(Figure 1).
- Restore electrical power to the outlet box by turning the electricity on at the main fuse box.(Figure 2).

WARNING

Check to see that all connections are tight, including ground, and that no bare wire is visible at the wire connectors, except for the ground wire.
Do not operate this fan with a variable(Rheostat) wall controller or dimmer switch. Doing so could result in damage to the ceiling fan's remote control unit.

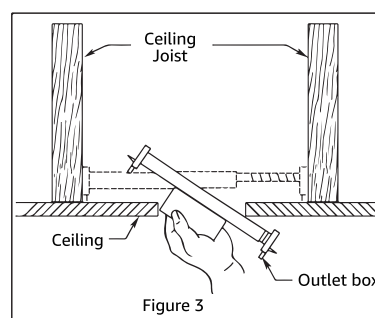
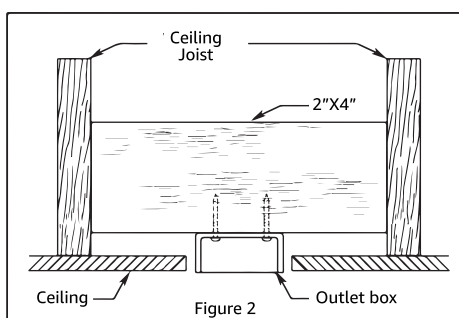
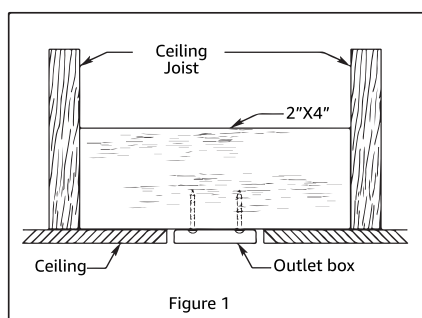

CEILING FAN

ELECTRICAL AND STRUCTURAL REQUIREMENTS

- Your new ceiling fan will require a grounded electrical supply line of AC110~130V/60Hz15 Amp Circuit. Electrical code requires use of a fan-rated outlet box to support the extra weight and motion associated with a ceiling fan. A fan-rated box will be labeled as such and typically supports up to a 70lbs ceiling fan. Fan-Rated Outlet Boxes vary in rating and design. Ensure the ratings of your ceiling fan outlet box meet the requirements for the ceiling fan being installed. Figure 1, Figure 2 and Figure 3 depicts different structural configurations that may be used for mounting the outlet box.
- Low-profile use (Figure 1):
A 1/2-deep pancake box is meant to be screwed to a joist or block. It is used if only one cable is coming into the box. It is also available in a saddle-mount configuration.
- Deep-profile use (Figure 2)
A 2-1/4" deep box can be attached to blocking between joists and is roomy enough to handle more than one cable.
- Brace use (Figure 3)
Paired with a deep box, this hanger is meant to span between two joists and takes the place of wooden blocking.



- If your fan is to replace an existing light fixture, turn power off at the main fuse box and remove the existing light fixture.

⚠ WARNING

Turning off wall switch is not sufficient, to avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse box before wiring. All wiring must be in accordance with National and Local codes and the ceiling fan must be properly grounded as a precaution against possible electrical shock.

⚠ WARNING

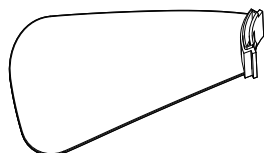
Do not operate this fan with a variable(Rheostat) wall controller or dimmer switch. Doing so could result in damage to the ceiling fan's remote control unit.

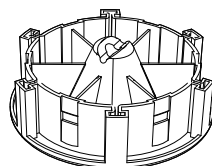

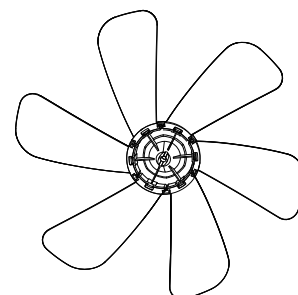

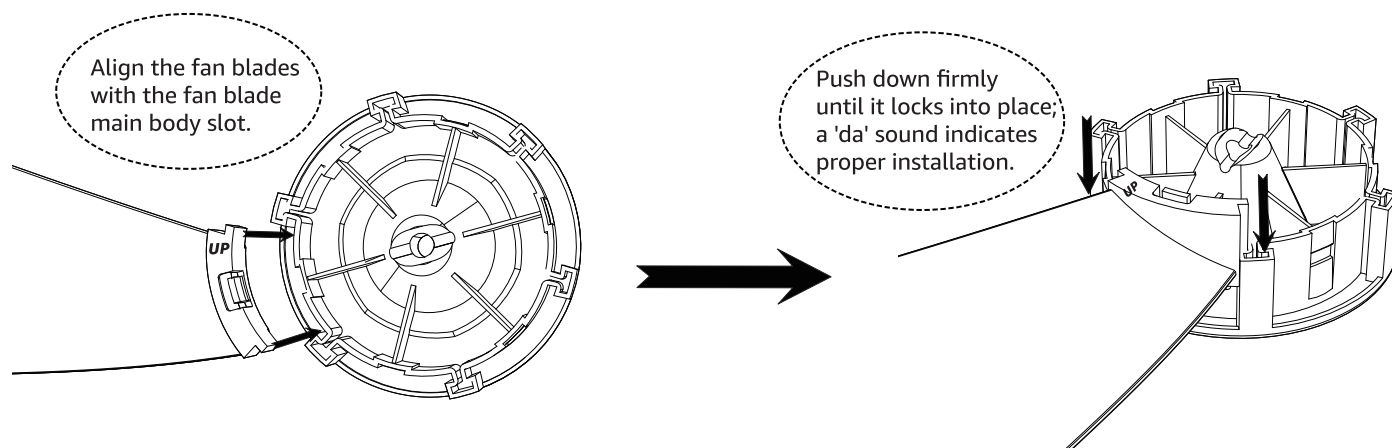


Fan blade body



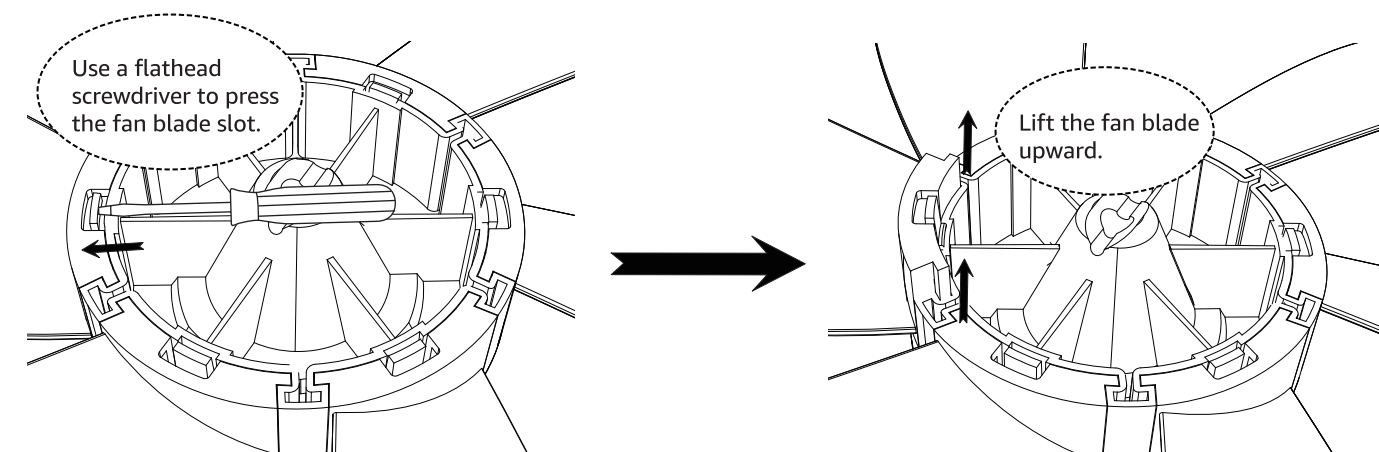
INSTALL

Note: Please push the screwdriver towards the tail of the blade.



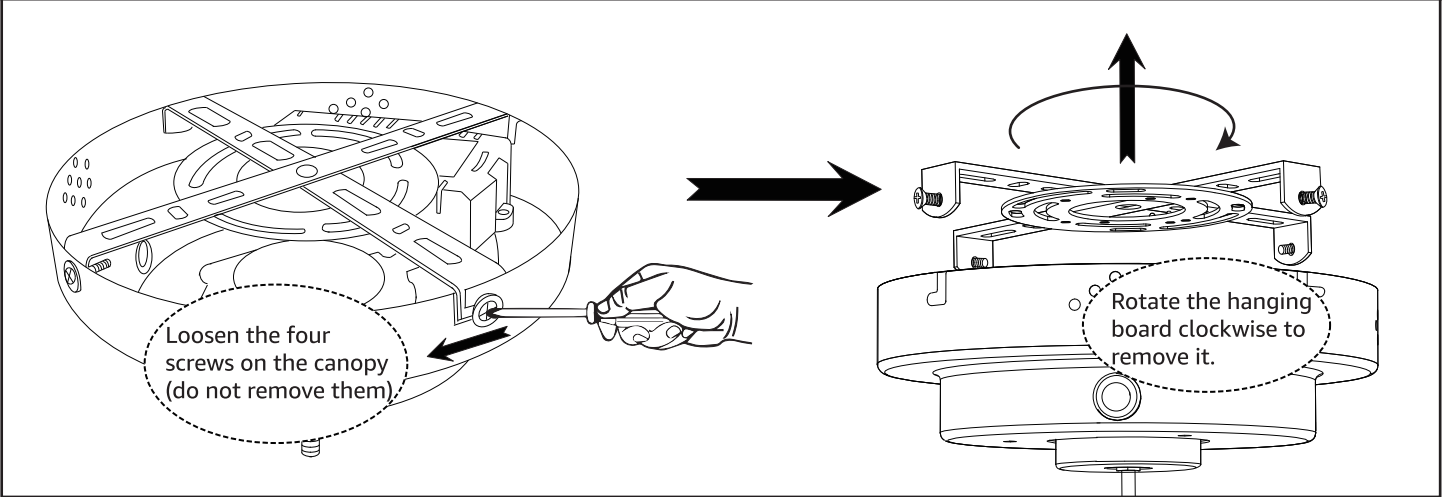

INSTALL CEILING HANGING BOARD

Note: Do not remove the four screws on the hanging board.

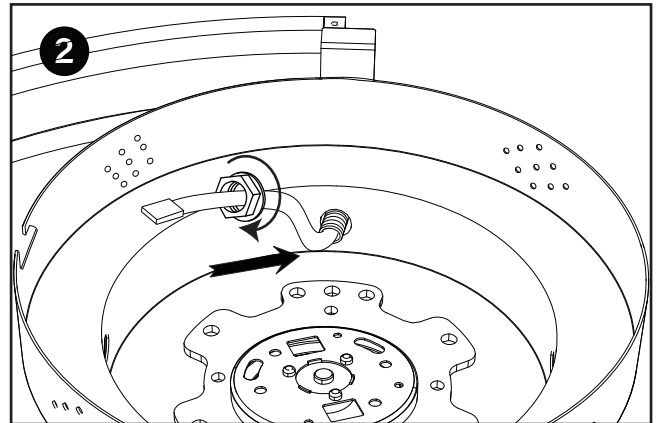
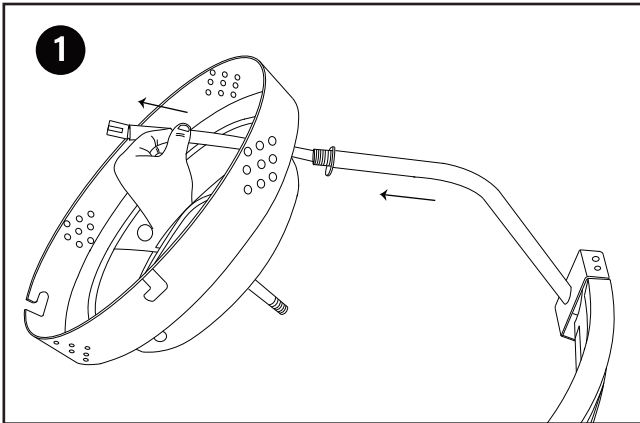

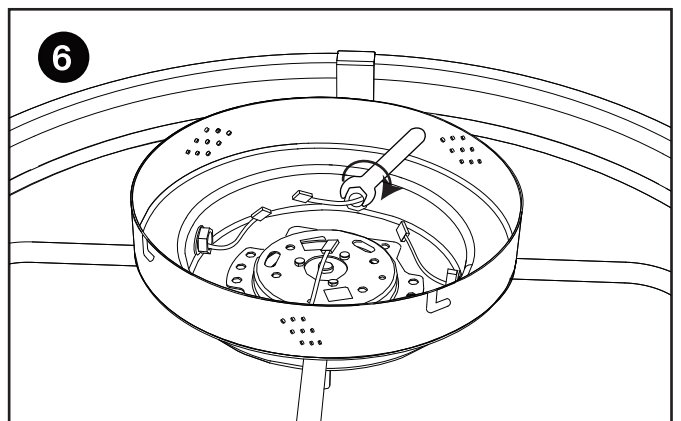
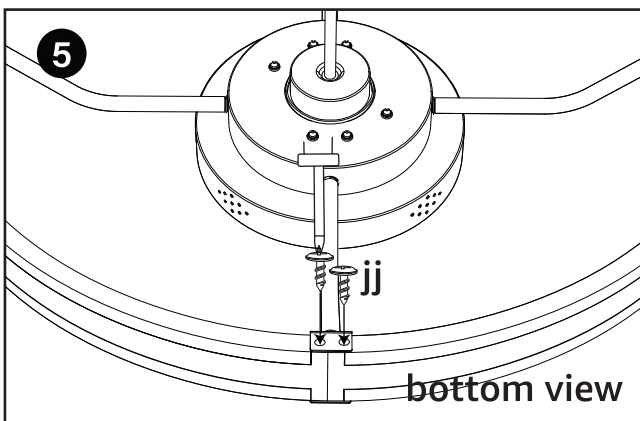
INSTALLATION



- 1** Pass the arm and the wires through the opening of the fan motor housing simultaneously.
- 2** Screw the nut onto the wire, then rotate clockwise to secure, without overtightening. (Repeat this procedure for all other lamp arms as per Steps 1-2.)

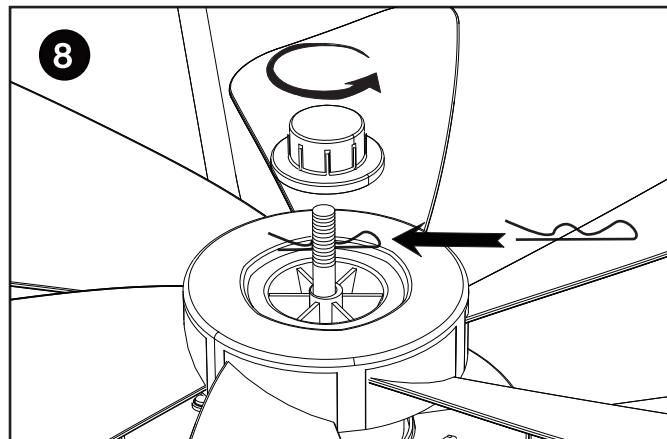
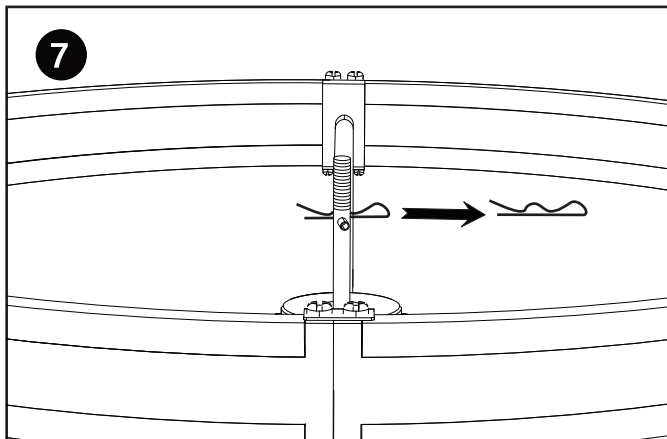


- 3** Insert the protrusion on the lamp body part into the locating hole of the screw arm connector.
- 4** Lightly pull the wires to the appropriate length, then use jj screws to secure the two lamp bodies together. (top view)



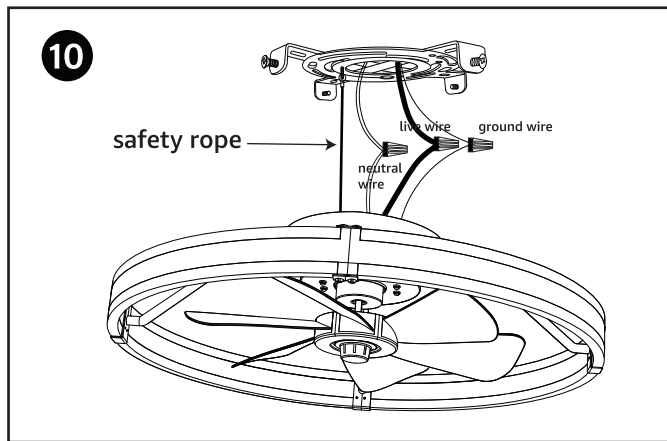
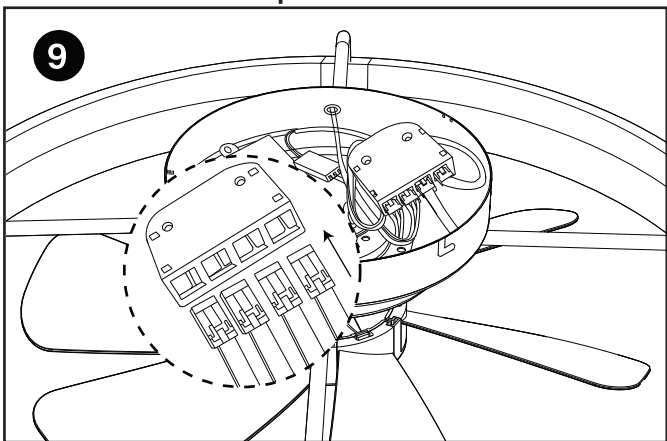
- 5** Secure the two lamp bodies together using jj screws. (bottom view)
- 6** Tighten the four nuts using a wrench.

7 Remove the pin from the motor core shaft.

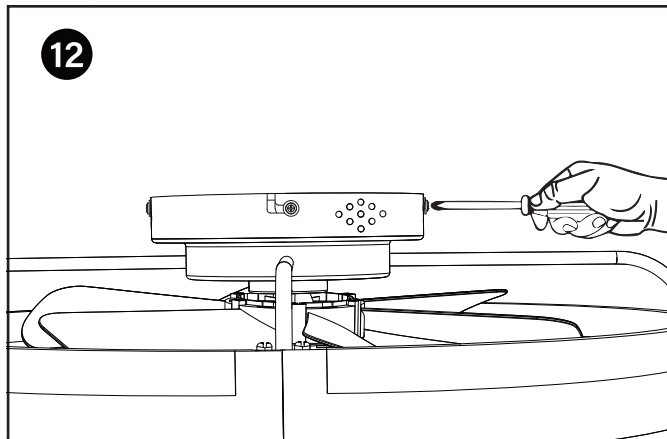
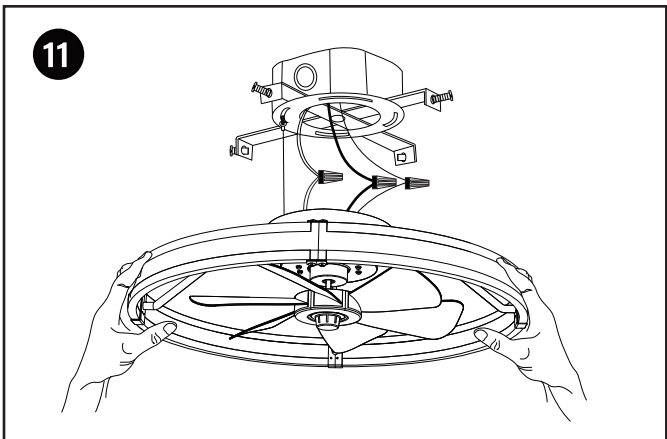
8 Align the fan blades with the motor core, insert the pin, and then screw in the fan blade cap counterclockwise to secure it.



9 Insert the three wires into the terminal ports, peel off the adhesive backing, and secure it inside the back cover.(No order limited, free connection)

10 Hang the lamp on the ceiling plate using the pre-installed safety rope for stability.

Wiring:
Connect the "Neutral wire" (white wire) from ceiling to the white wire.
Connect the "Live wire" (black wire) from ceiling to the black wire.
Connect the "Ground wire"
(green or yellow/green or bare) from ceiling to the yellow/green wire.

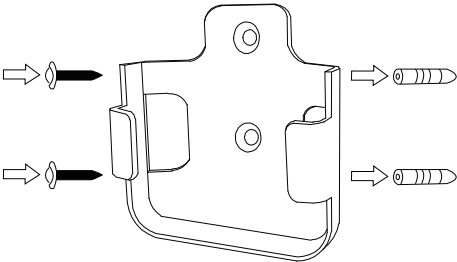


11 Align the grooves on the canopy with the screws on the bracket, then gently push the fixture upward to secure it in place.

12 Rotate the ceiling fan to align it with the grooves, then securely tighten all four screws to ensure stability.

Attach wall plate using the two screws provided. 		
To operate the fan, please install 2 AAA batteries (included) in the handheld remote transmitter. Ifnot used for extended periods of time, remove the batteries to prevent damage to the transmitter. Store the remote away from excessive temperatures and humidity. Pairing method: (single/multiple fans) The remote control transmitter can be used to control multiple receivers. 1. For the ceiling fan you want to pair, turn the main power switch off for at least 60 seconds. 2. Turn on the main power switch of the ceiling fan, then immediately click SETUP button. 3. The light will blink or beep to indicate a successful pairing. If the pairing process is unsuccessful, please repeat the above steps.

APP CONTROL

NOTE: For iPhone users, you can search for "FanLamp Pro" in the AppStore or scan the QR code to download. For Android users, please scan the QR code to download. (Please enable Bluetooth and pair the fan with app to control it!)



Turn on the fan's power wall switch, once the light is on, press the pairing button within 5s. When the fan light flashes twice, it indicates that the fan has been successfully paired with the phone and can now be controlled through the phone.

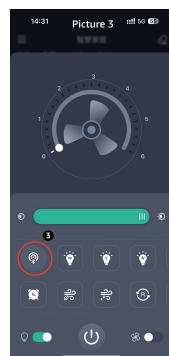
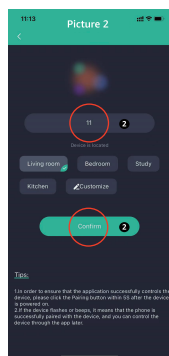
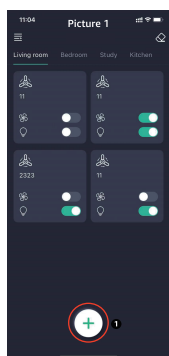

TROUBLESHOOTING

WARNING

For your own safety turn off power at fuse box or circuit breaker before trouble shooting.

Trouble	Probable Cause	Suggested Remedy
THE FAN WON'T START OR THE LIGHT WON'T COME ON	1. Fuse or circuit breaker blown. 2. Loose power line connections to the fan or loose switch wire connections in the switch housing. 3. The wiring between the receiving box and the fan is not properly connected. 4. The receiving box is damaged due to the wrong connection.	1. Check main and branch circuit fuses or circuit breakers. 2-3. Check line wire connections to the fan and switch wire connections in the switch housings CAUTION: Make sure the main power is turned off! 4. Contact us for support.
FAN WOBBLER EXCESSIVELY	1. Check for loose ceiling screws. 2. Check if the four screws on the canopy are loose.	1-2. Tighten the loose screws.
FAN SOUNDS NOISY	1. Check for loose ceiling screws. 2. Check if the four screws on the canopy are loose. 3. Check for wrong wire connection to the wall switch or light dimmer.	1-2. Tighten the loose screws. 3. Disconnect from the wall switch and use the remote controller only.
REMOTE DOES NOT WORK	1. Battery out of power 2. Battery not installed correctly 3. Not paired 4. Bluetooth function not on	1. Use new battery 2. Install again to ensure right 3. Pair with light 4. Make sure open BLE to pair

MAINTENANCE:

Periodic cleaning of your new ceiling fan is the only maintenance that is needed. When cleaning, use only a soft brush or lint-free cloth to avoid scratching the finish. Avoid using water as it can damage the motor, finish, and create the possibility of electrical shock. It is best to dry clean the fan to ensure its safe operation.
