## Van Zyverden's BUTTERCUP/RANUNCULUS DOUBLE TANGERINE





Buttercups may also be known by their botanical name, "Ranunculus." The multi-petaled type flowering blooms are incredibly vibrant in color and very showy. Lovely cut as well as in bouquets, Ranunculus are easy to grow and are deer resistant. These are an excellent addition to your garden! About This Variety: Ranunculus bulbs are widely available at retail nurseries and mail-order catalogs in mixed colors. We have identified this color to be special, ranunculus in single colors are unique and caught our eye, as they make for striking color displays in the garden.

Growing Instructions: The plants are not very hardy and may be treated as an annual in colder zones but thrive best in USDA zones 8 to 10. Simply replant new bulbs in colder zones or try to over winter them.

Care Tip: Soak the corms in luke warm water overnight before planting to jump start development. Plant before danger of frost. Plant the corms with the "claws" pointing downward.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 16" tall

Spacing: Plant 4" apart, 3" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones
