

# *Van Zyverden's* HOSTA CHERRY BERRY



Hostas are not grown for their flowers but for their foliage. They come in a spectrum of blues, golds, greens, yellows and whites as well as variegated, some speckled and others striped. They thrive in the shade, even though they can withstand some sun. They are long-lived and very low-maintenance. Many hosta varieties have seasonal color or can change color depending on growing conditions. While there are well over 3,000 cultivars to choose from, we offer a range of foliage shapes, colors and sizes. Hostas can take years to fully mature, each year exhibiting a change in color, texture and form.

*About This Variety:* Hosta Cherry Berry is unique and there is no other hosta quite like it. It produces rare, red flower stems with purple flowers in the summer and leaves variegated in green with white and golden yellow centers. Smaller in stature than the typical hosta. Use as a ground cover, for edging, an accent plant or in containers.

*Growing Instructions:* While drought tolerant, they do not like being kept dry for too long. They prefer rich, well-drained soil with a consistent supply of moisture

*Care Tip:* Basically maintenance free. Clip out dead flower stalks after blooming.

*Blooms:* Summer

*Exposure:* Partial Shade to Full Shade

*Height:* Grows 12-18" tall

*Spacing:* Plant 12" apart, 1.5-2" deep

*USDA Zones:* Hardy in USDA zones 4-8
