CAUTION: Do not turn handle before or while installing the saddle tapping valve. Be sure the piercing lance does not protrude beyond the rubber gasket.

## Installation Instructions:

- Install the saddle tapping valve on the cold water copper tubing so that the outline is positioned in a convenient direction.
- Tighten screw evenly. Brackets should be parallel. Tighten firmly, but do not overtighten.
- Connect copper tubing to saddle valve outlet. (fig. 1)
- Coil a minimum of 8 ft. tubing (3 turns 10 in. dia.) behind refrigerator. This will allow refrigerator to be moved away from wall for cleaning or service.
- Cut tubing length required to make connection at refrigerator. (fig. 2)
- If refrigerator connection has male plastic fitting, use adapter included to make connection.
- Turn the saddle tapping handle clockwise until you feel it is firmly seated. Note: You have now pierced the copper tube and the valve is closed.
- Turn the handle counterclockwise to open the valve.
- 9. Check for leaks.
