

IMPORTANT:

- -Take your time, read all instructions first then follow each step as numbered and described
- -Power tools are not recomended for assembling your furniture
- -Give yourself plenty of room to work
- -Due to the size if this bed, it must be assembled within the space it will occupy
- -The assembly will require at least two people to complete
- -Make sure all fasteners are tight

BOX CONTENTS:

- Box 1 of 3 bed end structures, ladder, hardware
- Box 2 of 3 side rails, guardrails, posts
- Box 3 of 3 slats

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE ATTEMPTING TO ASSEMBLE THIS BED

Safety Warnings and General Notes:

-Follow the information on the warnings appearing on the upper bunk end structure and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from bed.

-Always use the recommended size mattress or mattress support, or both, to help prevent the likelihood of entrapment or falls. (See Mattress specifications bellow)

-The top Surface of mattress must be at least 5 in. (127 mm) below the upper edge of guardrails.

-Note: Bunkie boards or 13-slat kits are required on top & bottom of this bed.

- Do not allow children under 6 years of age to use the upper bunk.

-Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.

-Do not allow horseplay on or under the bed and prohibit jumping on the bed.

-Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the upper bunk.

-Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

-Use of a night light may provide added safety precaution for a child using the upper bunk.

-Always use guardrails on both long sides of the upper bunk. If the bunk bed will be placed next to the wall, the guardrail that runs the full length of the bed should be placed against the wall to prevent entrapment between the bed and wall.

-The use of water or sleep flotation mattresses is prohibited.

-STRANGULATION HAZARD – Never attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts and jump ropes.

-Keep these instructions for future reference.

Replacement parts, including additional guardrails, may be obtained from any of our dealers.

Upper Bed Mattress Specifications:

- Use only a mattress with 74-75" L x 37 1/2"-38 1/2" W x 8.5 "H on the upper bunk.

- Use only a mattress with 74-75" long and 52 1/2" 53 1/2" wide on lower bunk.
- A mattress with the same thickness is also recommended for the lower bunk.
