## Money Tree



### LIGHT

I grow best near a sunny window; at most 5 feet away. Direct sunlight will burn my leaves.



### WATER

Water me when the surface of my soil is no longer moist to the touch then gently tip me gently to lay on my side so I can drain away unwanted water.



### FOOD

Feed me once or twice a year during Spring and Summer with a fertilizer formulated for houseplants.



### FEATURES

I have upright growth that can purify the air and I am super easy to grow.
