The daylily (*Hemerocallis*) is considered a “sure bet” perennial, as they thrive throughout most of the country. They tolerate less than ideal conditions and will bloom faithfully for years with virtually no attention. As the name implies, daylily flowers open in the morning and die by nightfall. Each flower stem typically has at least a dozen flower buds, and the plant stays in bloom for many weeks. They should be planted in every garden.

About This Variety: Hemerocallis Dan Mahony is a daylily lover's favorite. While its not new at all it is known for it's outstanding bloom coloring and ruffling of the edges. Dormant winter foliage. It was awarded the American Daylily Society Honorable Mention Award. Vigorous variety and robust bloomer. A solid choice for any garden.

Growing Instructions: Best planted in groups for dramatic effect in full sun, on moist, yet well drained soil. Excellent ground cover, as a single specimen, or in mass plantings to create a focal point in the garden.

Care Tip: They are tough robust plants, so not much can grow wrong. They do like an abundance of water.

Exposure: full sun to partial shade

Height: grows 25" tall

Spacing: plant 18-24" apart, just below soil line deep

USDA Zones: hardy in USDA zones 3-9
