

Power on the Device

5V/2A Adapter

- 1. Connect the USB cable to a power outlet or USB portable charger.
- 2. The blue LED light will illuminate when the device is powered on.




4. After powering on, it will take 25 seconds to start its calibration cycle.

Set up Camera in the App

- 1. Make sure that your smart phone is connected to the same Wi-Fi SSID network as vour camera.
- 2. Select Hermes in the app. then follow the instructions shown in the app.

Use QR Code to Set up Device

Hold your phone so that it is parallel to the camera lens.

- 1. Switch on your phone's Wi-Fi. Connect your phone to the same router as the camera. Note: 2.4 GHz 802.11 b/g/n is required.
- 2. Enter the password of your Wi-Fi router.
- 3. Your device will automatically generate a QR code.
- 4. Place the camera 4" ~ 12" (10 ~ 30cm) in front of the QR code or 8" ~ 12" (20 ~ 30cm) if using a tablet.
- 5. You will hear a beep when the QR code is read.


Blinking Green LED: Camera is attempting to connect to the Wi-Fi network.

Factory Reset

- 1. First, make sure the device is powered on and the calibration is completed.
- 2. There is a small RESET hole. Press and hold for about 3-5 seconds until you hear a beep. All settings previously stored in the device will be erased, and it will be restored to the factory default.
- 3. After 25 seconds, the device will enter its calibration mode and start rotating.

Mount Your Camera



- 1. Make sure that a power outlet is within 2 meters. Over 30 degrees Choose a location that will offer you the best viewing angle.
- 2. Use a pencil to mark the hole locations. Make sure the holes are slightly smaller than anchors.
- 3. Insert the anchors into the wall and secure the holder to the wall with screws.
- 4. Insert the USB power plug through the holder opening in the rear.
- 5. Plug the device into the USB adapter and adjust until the proper angle is achieved.
- ★ Tighten the holder screw if you adjust the holder angle.

Biometric Setup Sheet - Activity Map



Understand human behavior with our Heat Map and Path Tracking data analytics.

- Open Amaryllo App
- Tap on Activity Map





Heat Map technology analyzes an area over a period of time to calculate which spots are most commonly occupied by people.



The data is displayed with a color gradient, red indicating most visited and blue indicating less visited.

The Heat Map image is updated every hour and data is refreshed by the end of the day.



Path Tracking technology uses picture frame analytics to record recent human activity and compile path data.



The app is then able to display the last ten spots where a human has been detected around your home.

If a thief breaks into your house, you can use these features to see where they lingered the most, as well as their entry and exit points.





Once enabled, you will receive push notifications whenever a Human, Vehicle or Pet is recognized by your Amaryllo camera.


