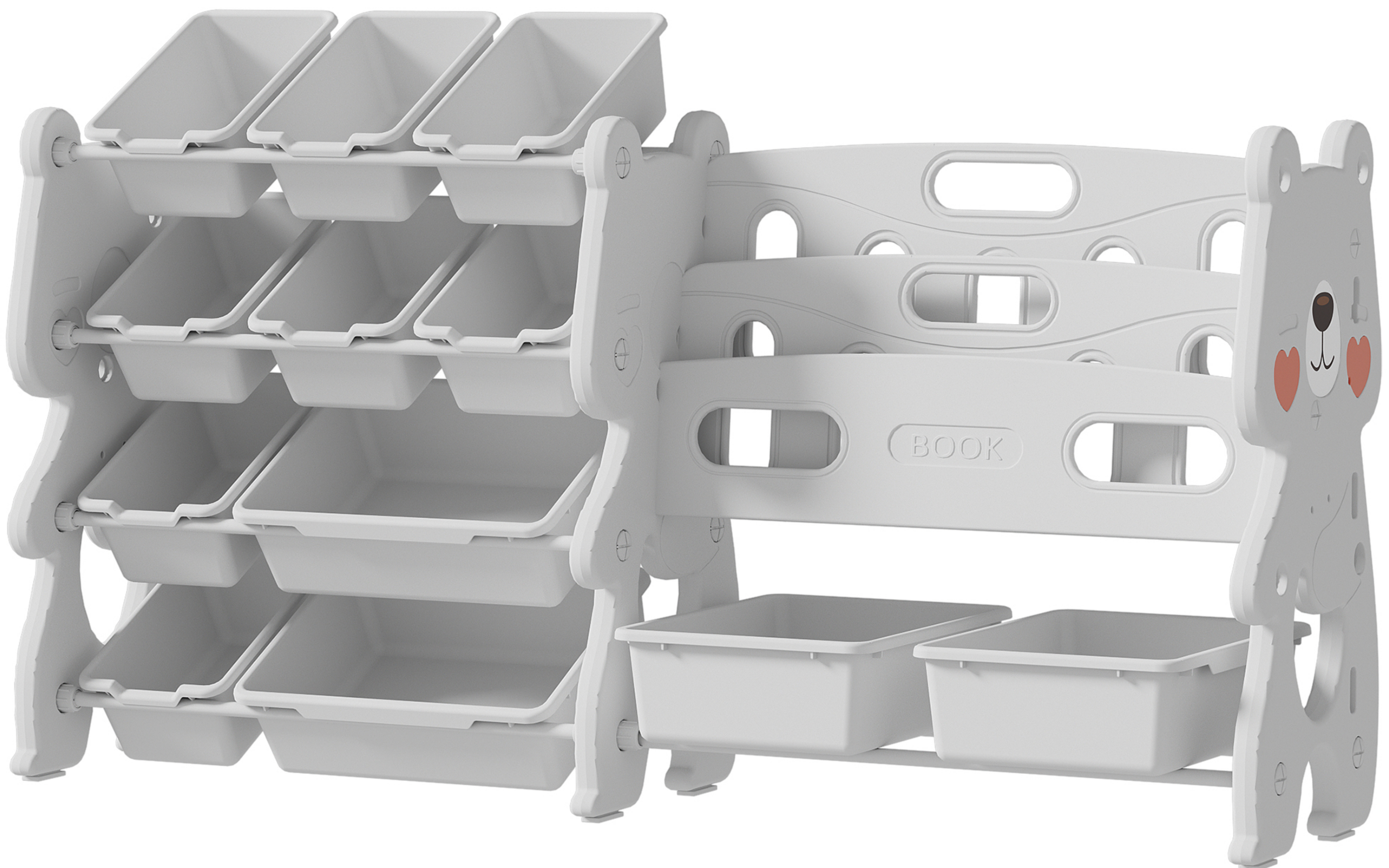

# SAFETY & WARNINGS

## ADULT ASSEMBLY REQUIRED.

- Keep these instructions for future reference.
- This product is intended for indoor, outdoor, family, domestic use only.
- Place this product on level ground and at least 6.6' away from a fence, building, overhead branches, laundry lines or electrical wires. This product should be placed away from furniture that could cause injury if a fall occurs.
- Ensure the installation area is ventilated.
- Do not use the product if it is damaged or defective. If it is damaged or defective, please contact a qualified technician.
- Check that all parts are assembled well and are stable before use. Defective parts must be changed immediately as they can impair the function and the safety of the product.
- When temperatures fall below freezing (0°C/32°F), outdoor use of this product is not recommended. In extreme cold, plastic materials lose resilience and may become brittle and crack with impact. Store product in a warmer, protected place.
- Keep away from fire or any source of ignition.
- Packing materials are not toys, keep them away from children.
- Instruct children on proper use of this product: only after properly assembled and installed, and not in a manner other than intended.
- Dress children appropriately: do not allow children to wear loose-fitting clothing including ponchos, scarves and garments with drawstrings. Well-fitting shoes must be worn at all times.
- Avoid placing equipment in direct sunlight as hot surfaces could cause serious burns.
- Provide adult supervision at all times.

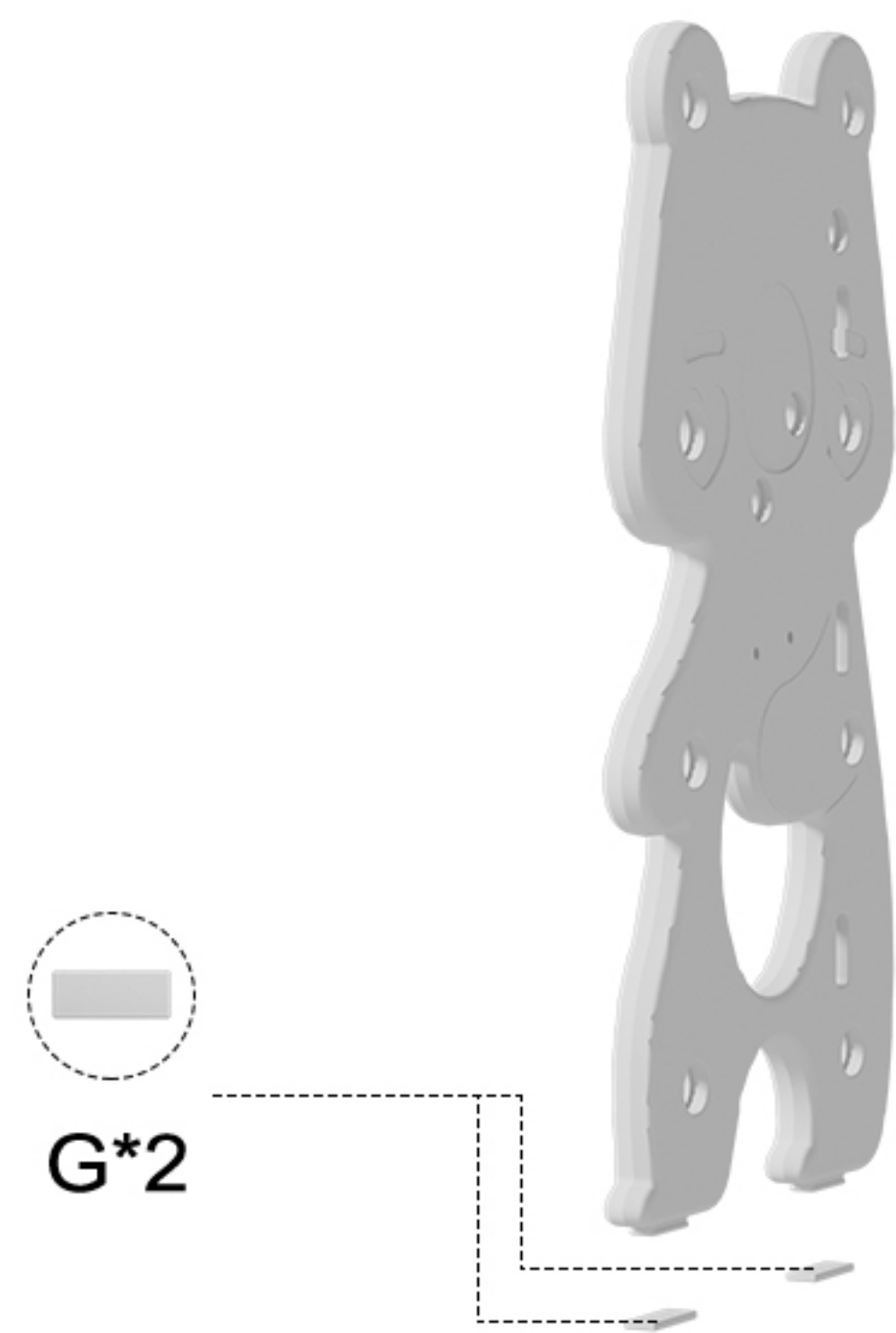

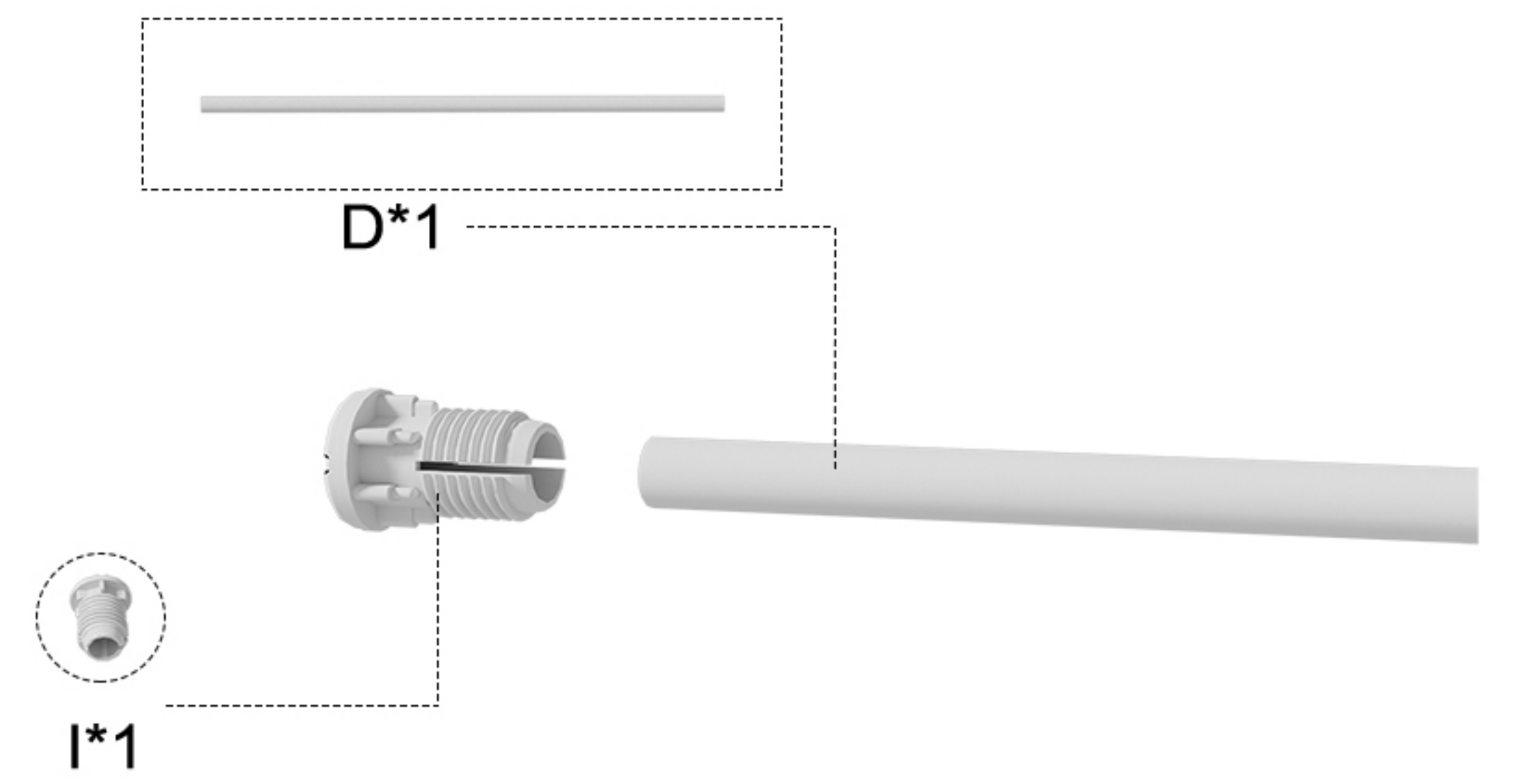

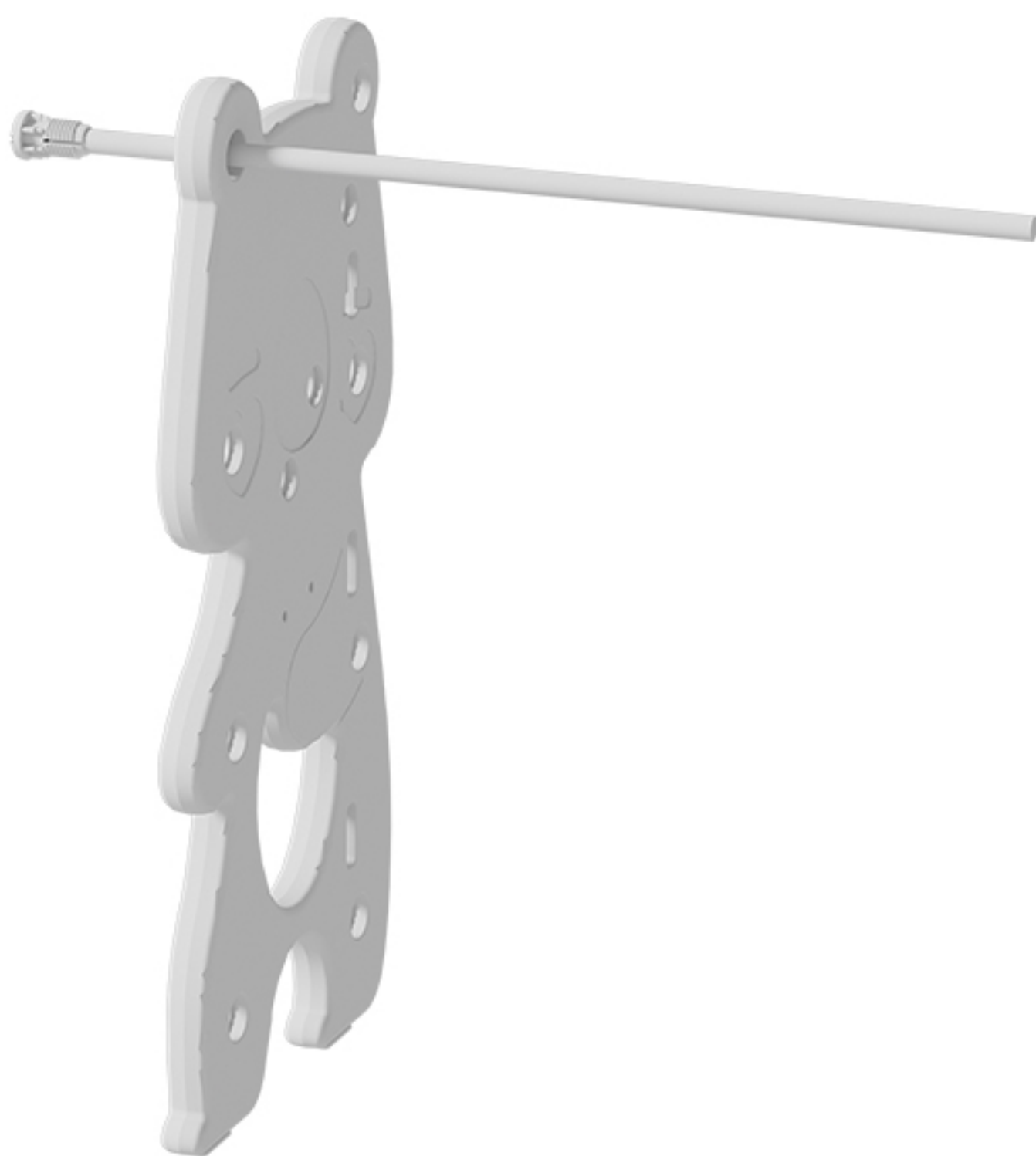
# Installation



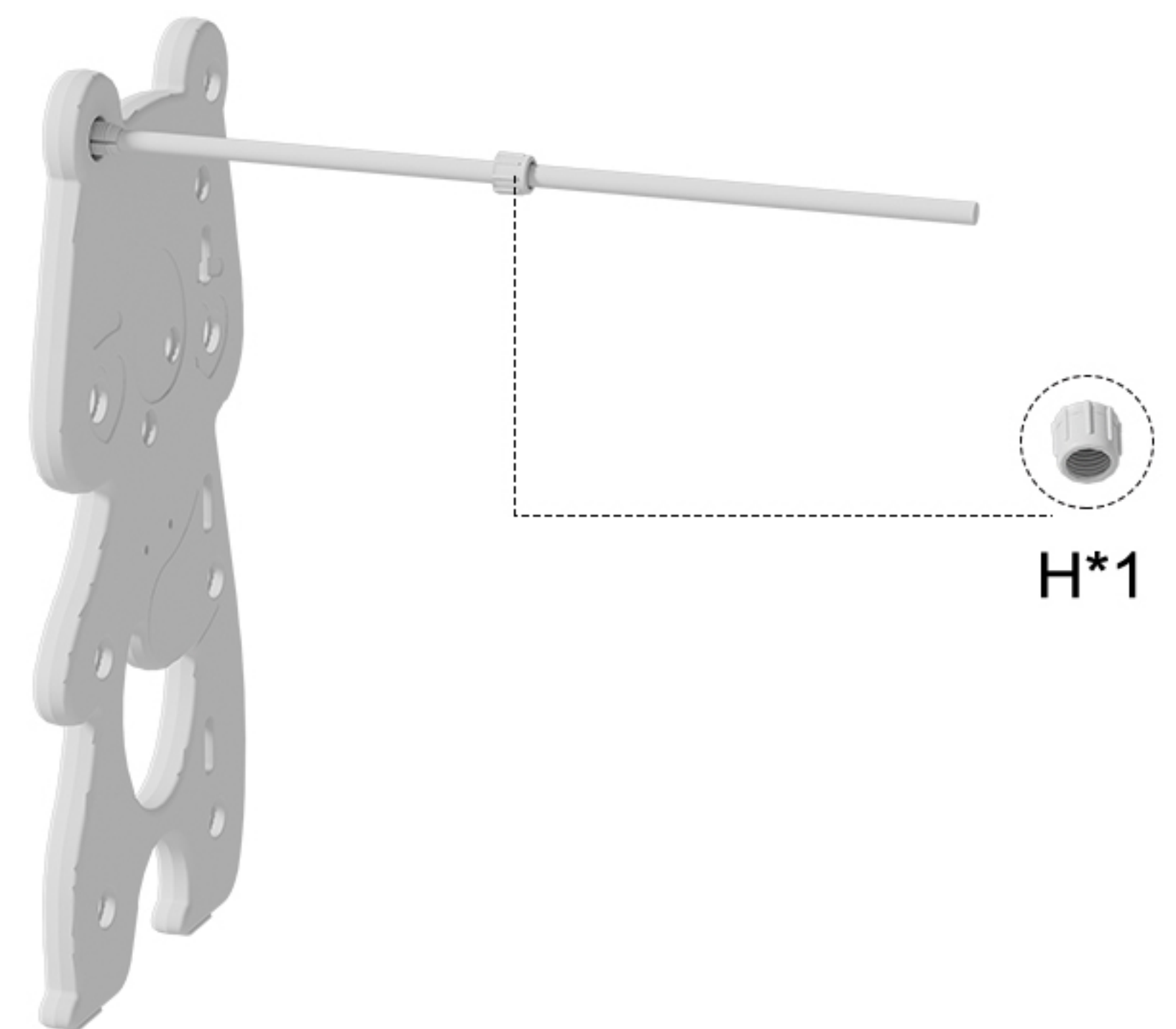
Step 1: Install accessory G into the bottom of the side panel as shown in the picture



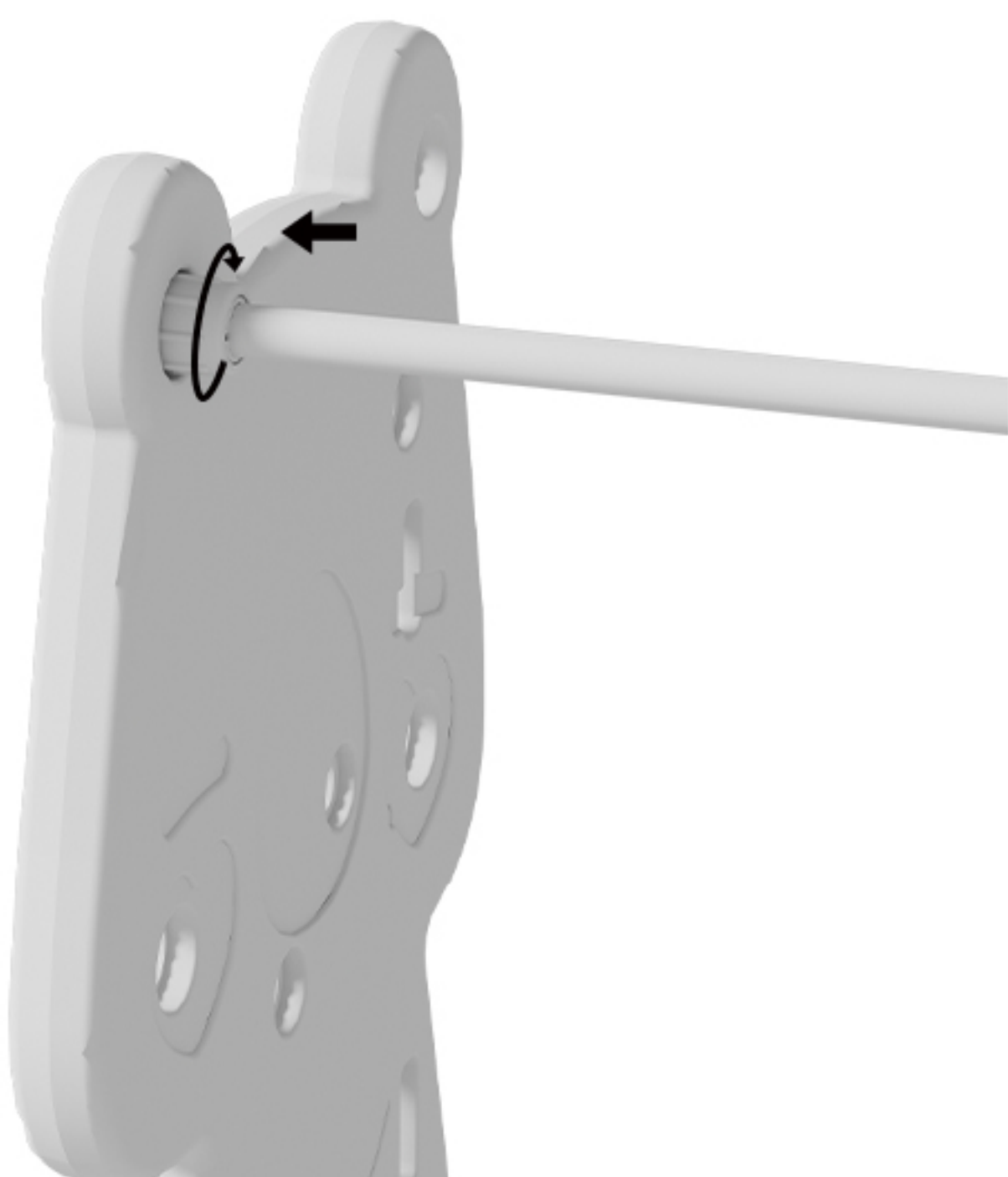
Step 2: Assemble accessory D and accessory I as shown in the picture



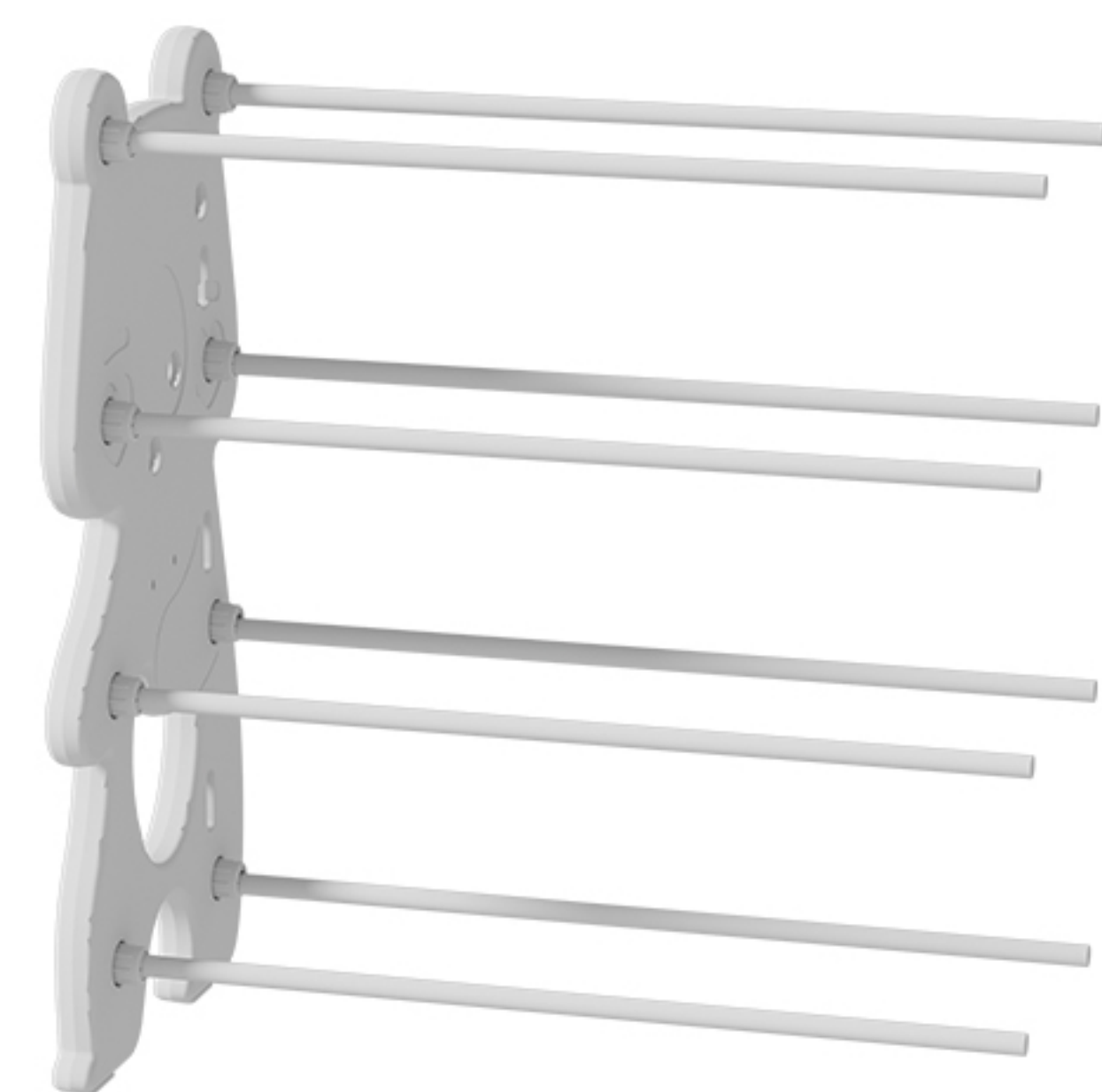
Step 3: As shown in the figure, insert the assembled accessories from Step 1 and Step 2 into the side panel



Step 4: Insert accessory H into the pipeline as shown in the picture



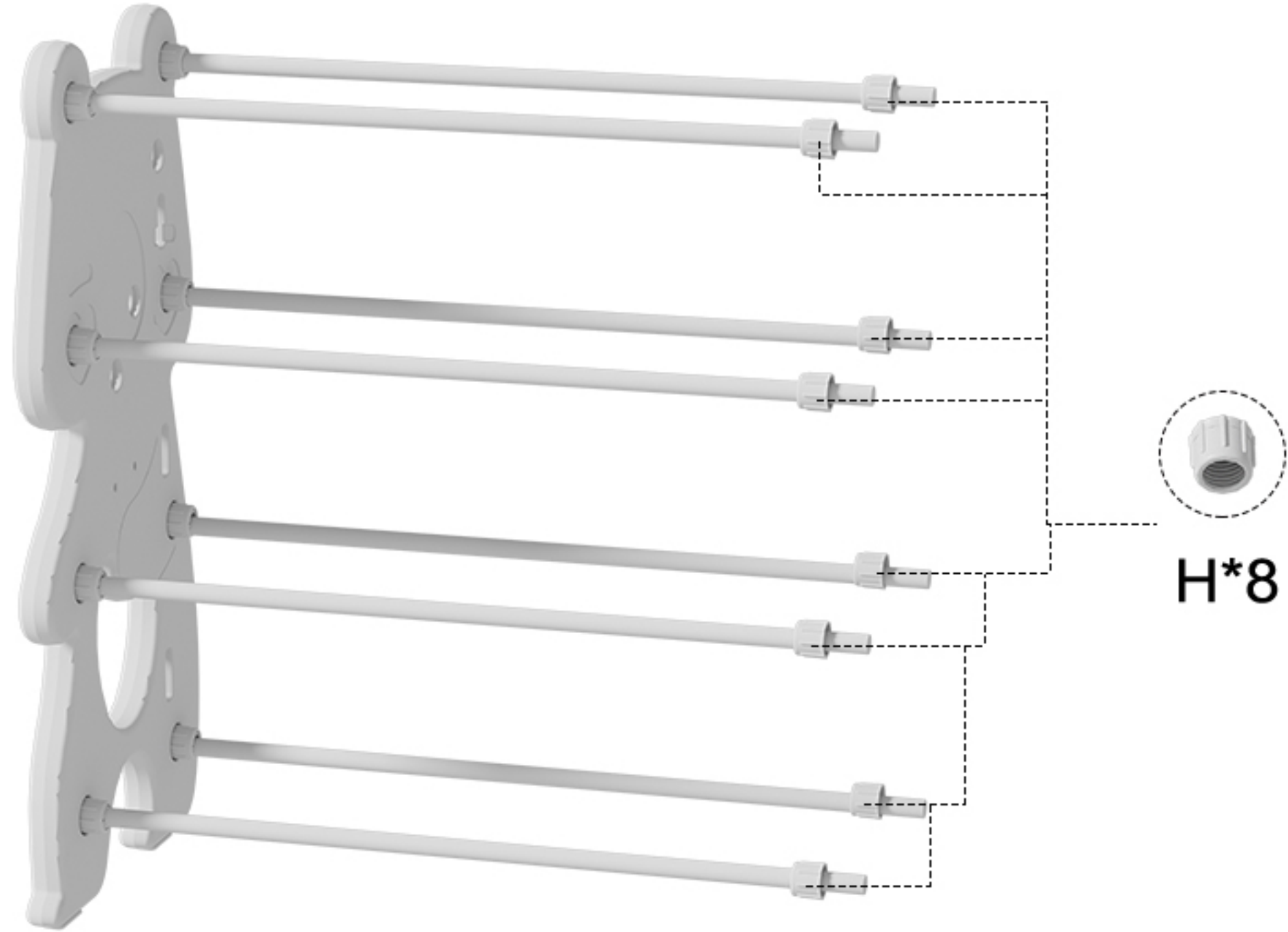
Step 5: Use installation tools to tighten accessory E (note that a nut needs to be used to clamp the nut on the other side). Other accessories should be assembled on the side panel in sequence according to steps 1, 2, and 3



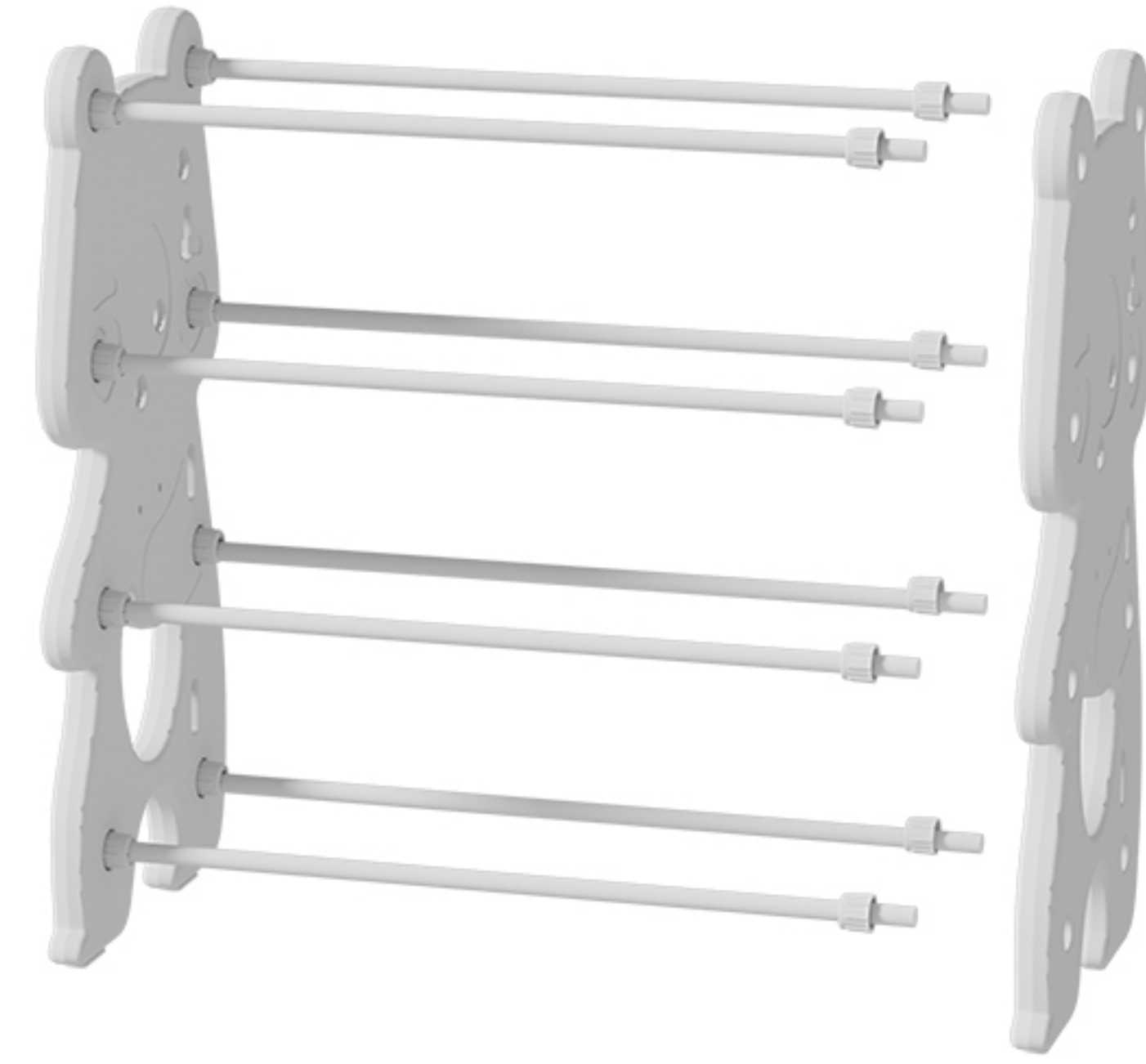
Step 6: Assemble other pipelines according to the previous steps as shown in the figure



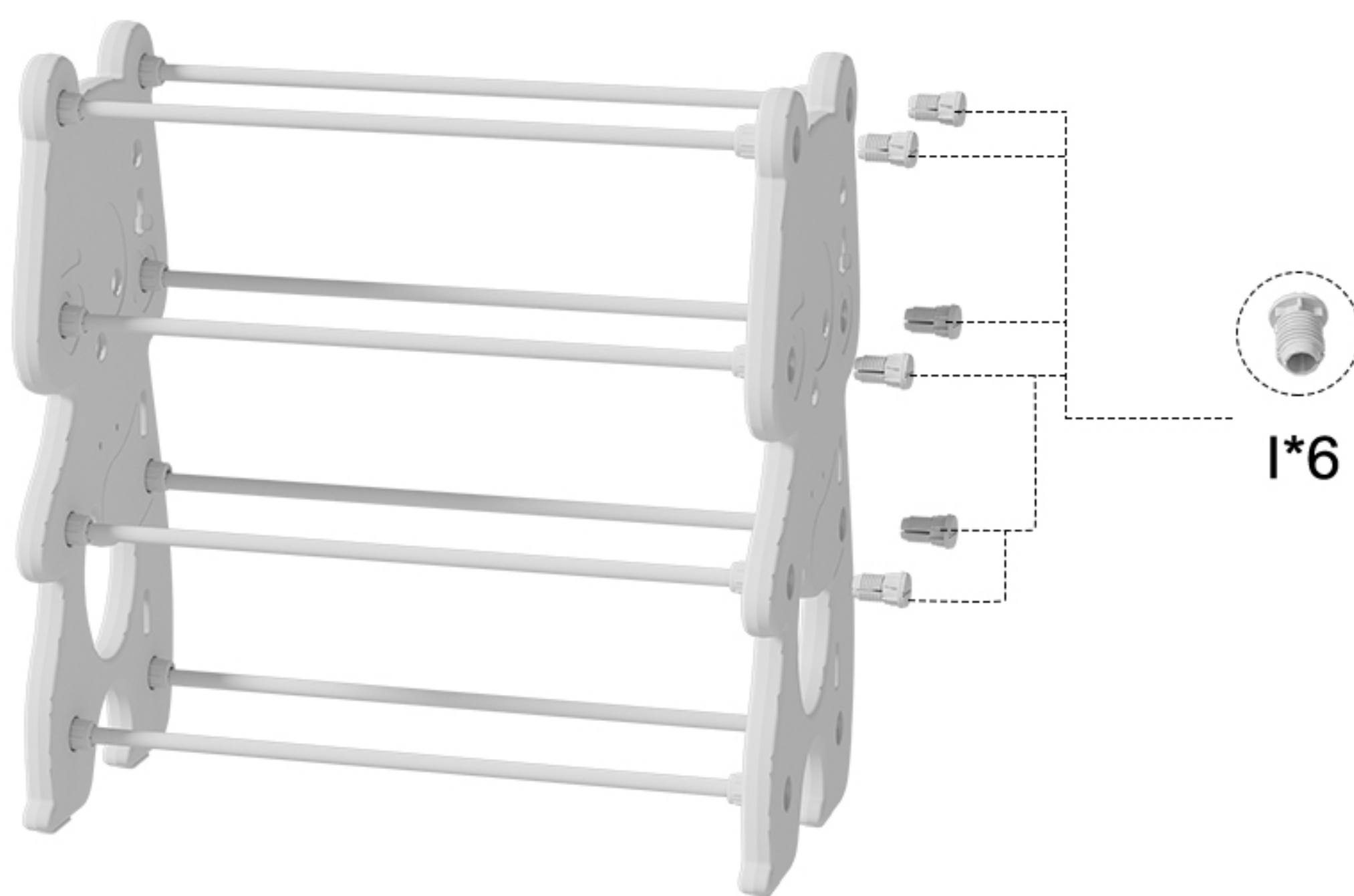

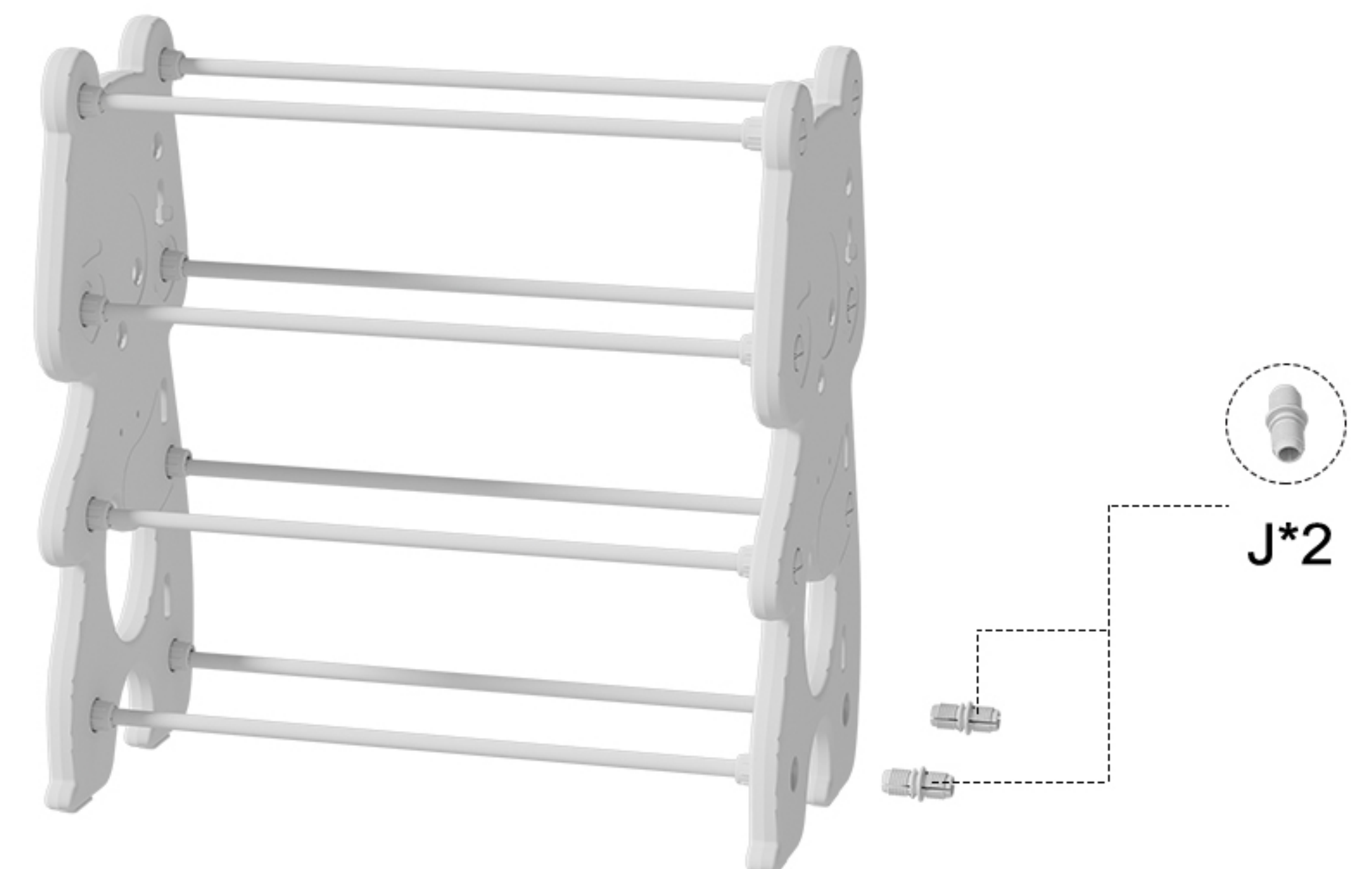
Step 7: Assemble accessory H as shown in the picture



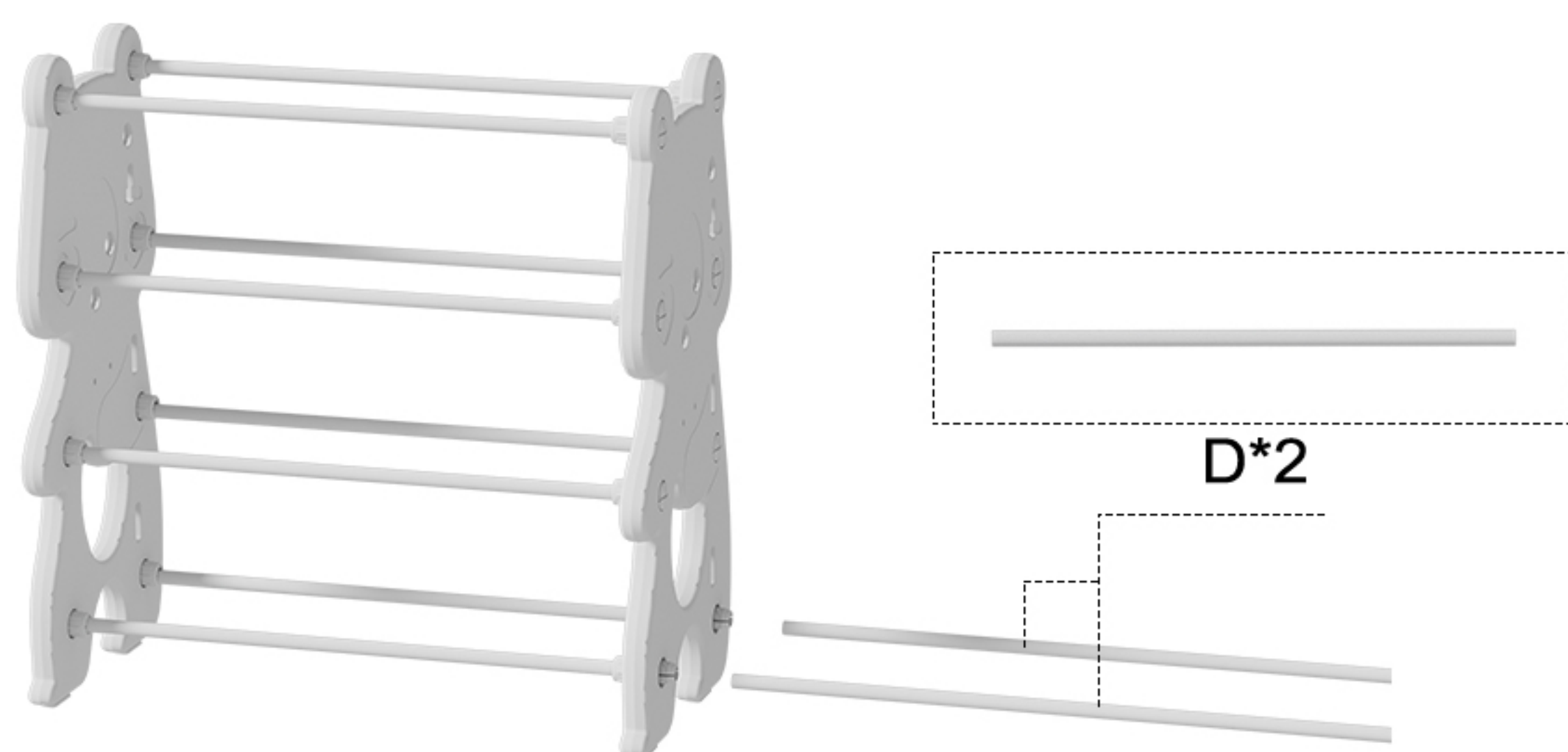
Step 8: Insert the side panel as shown in the picture



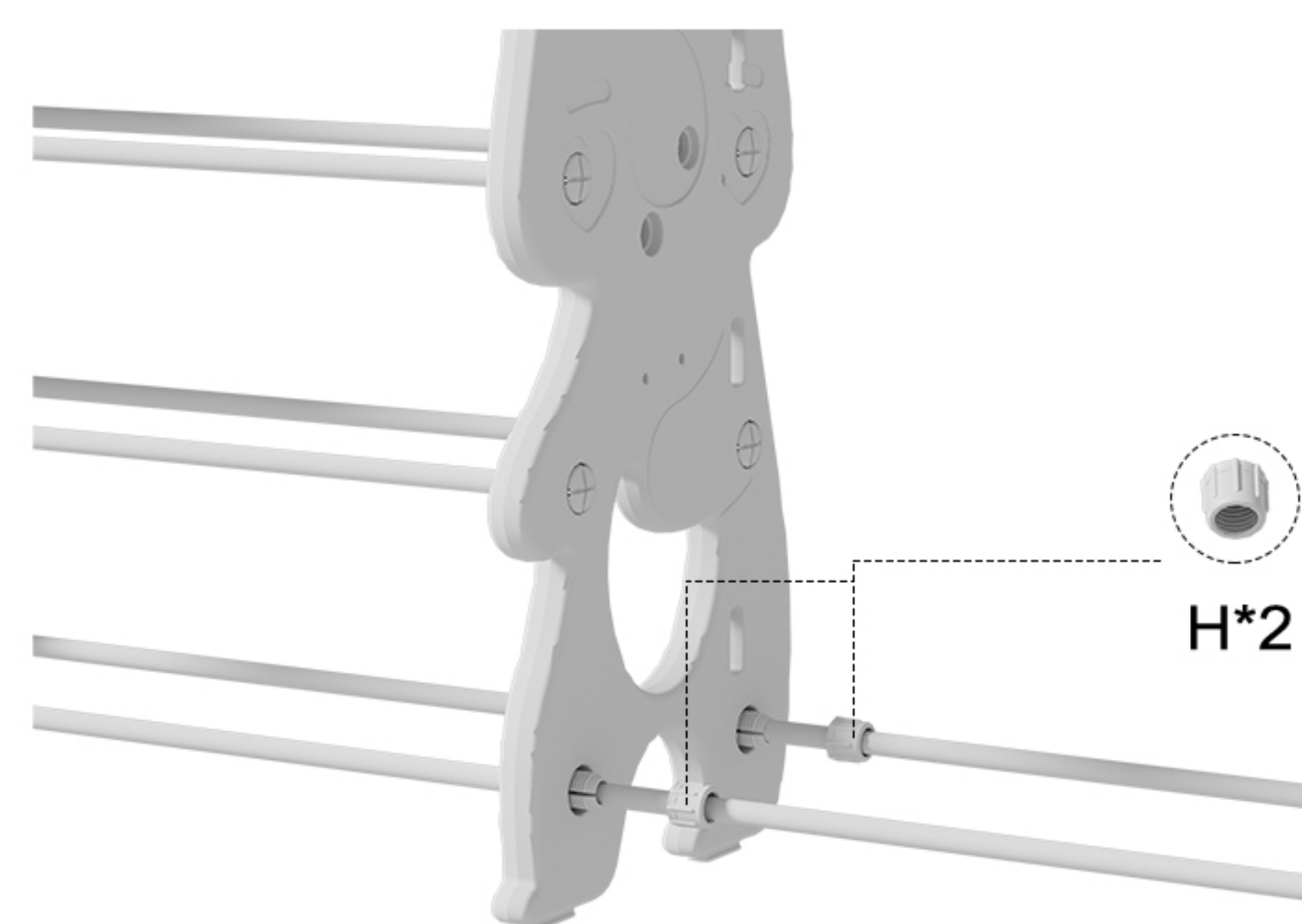
Step 9: Insert accessory I into the designated position as shown in the picture



Step 10: Insert accessory J into the top position as shown in the picture



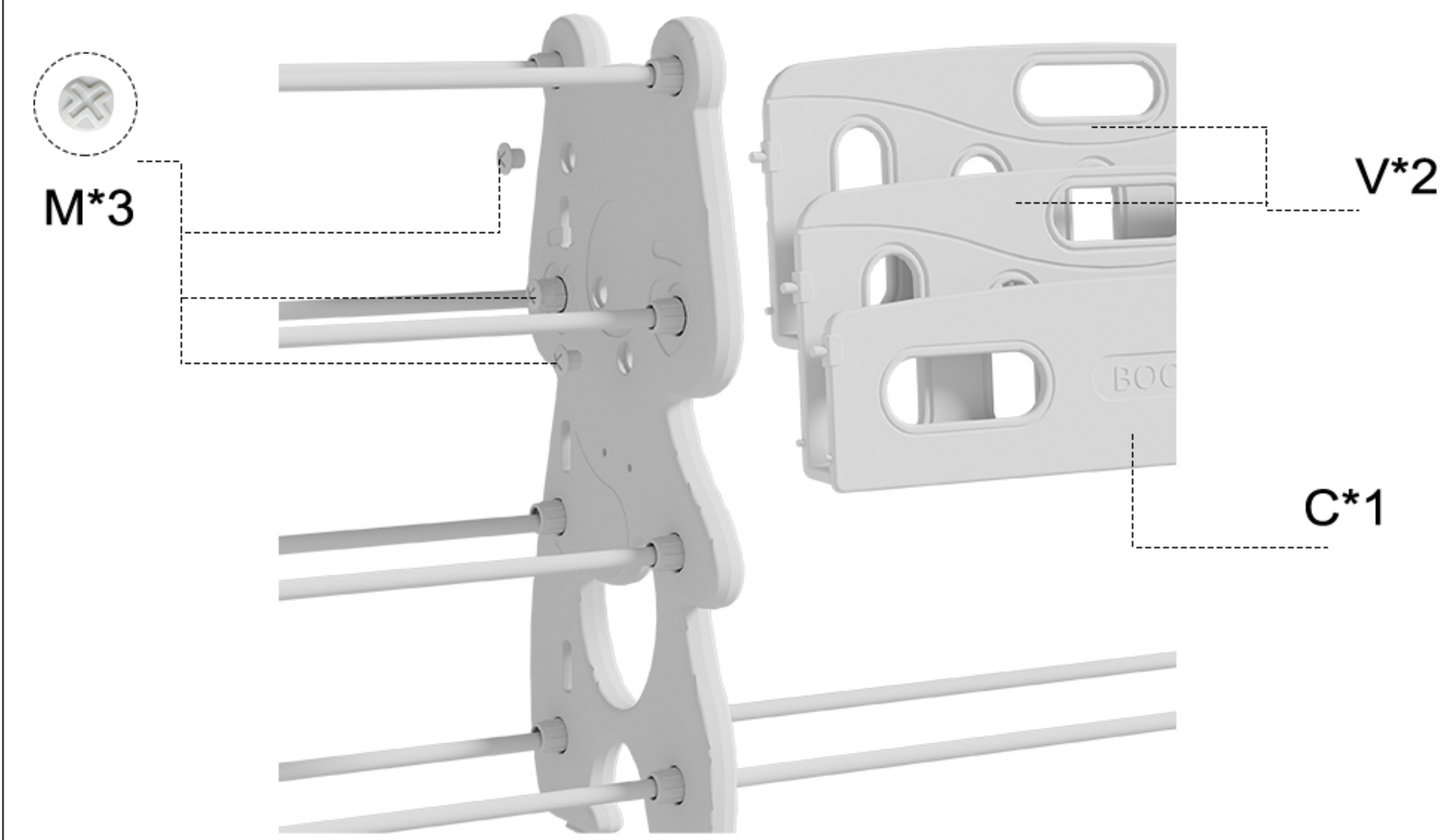
Step 11: Insert accessory D as shown in the picture



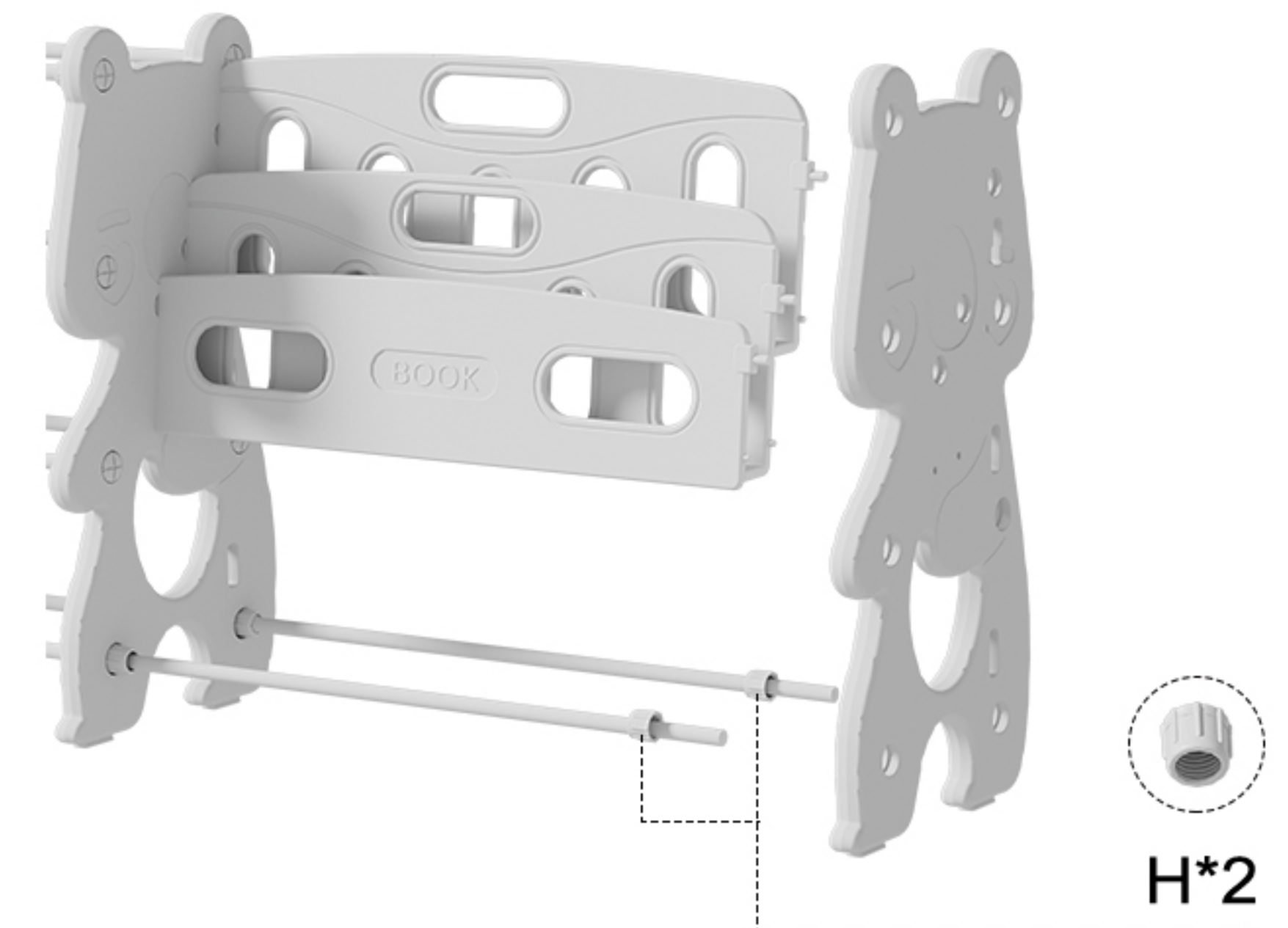
Step 12: Insert the accessory into the pipeline as shown in the picture



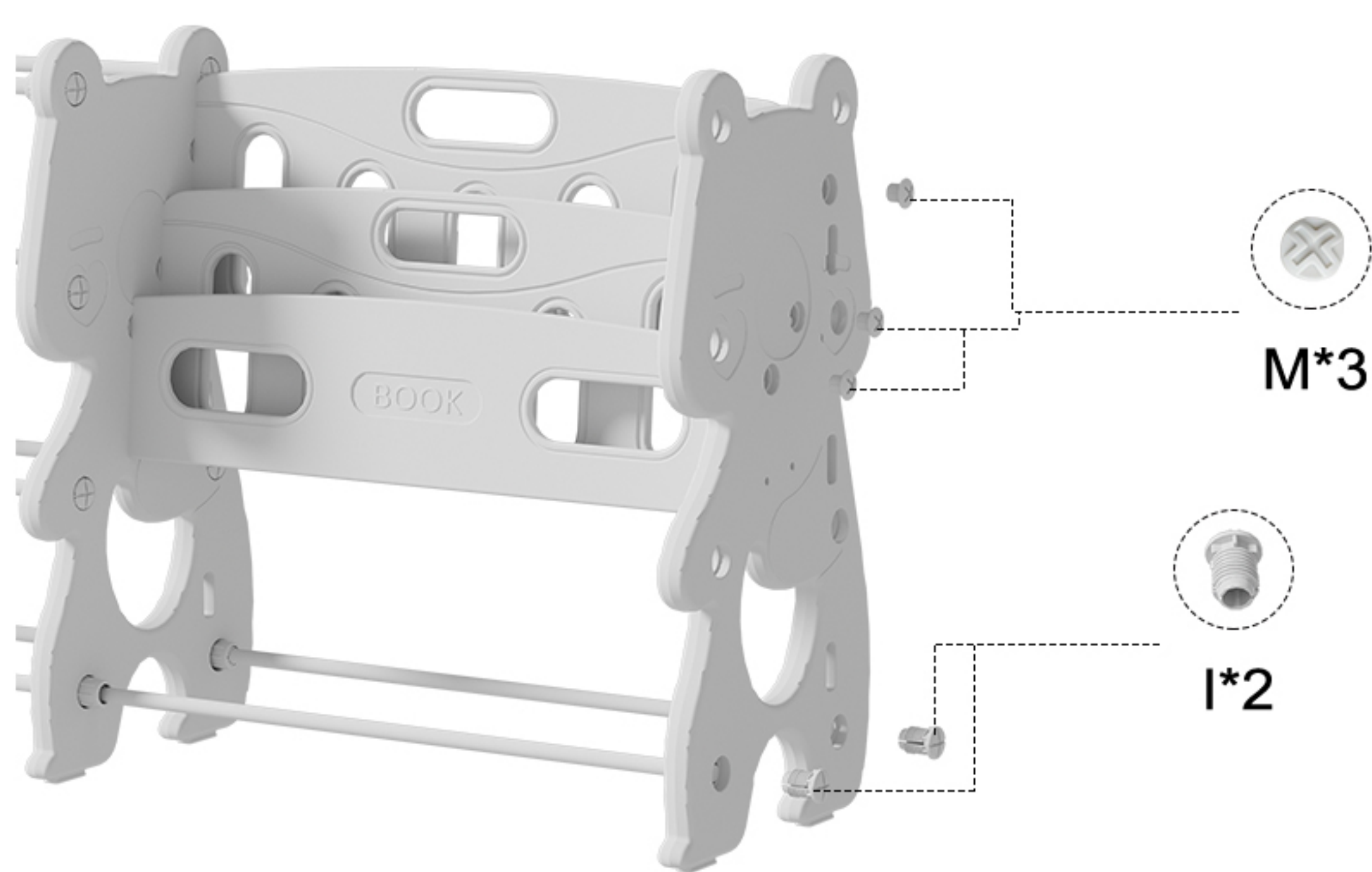

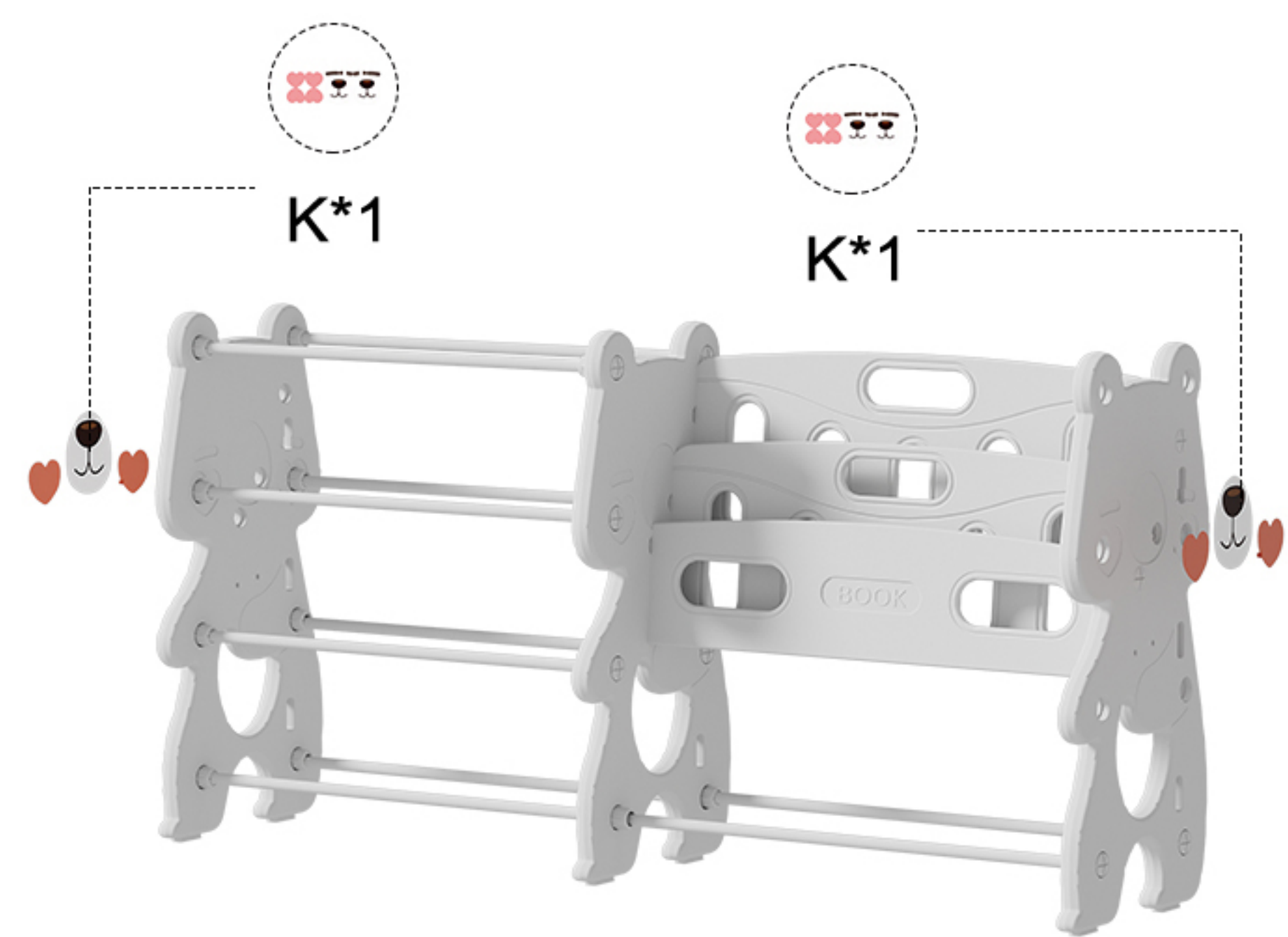
Step 13: Assemble component M with component B and component C as shown in the picture (component C is before component B)



Step 14: Insert accessory H as shown in the picture and assemble the side panel



Step 15: As shown in the picture, use accessory M to fix the bookshelf to the side panel, and then use accessory I to fix the pipeline



Step 16: Attach accessory K as shown in the picture



Step 17: Place the large and small storage boxes and complete the installation





## GENERAL SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This product is intended for indoor, outdoor, home, domestic use only. It is not suitable for commercial or medical use.

The assembly of the product must be done carefully and by an able-bodied adult. If in any doubt, ask a technically qualified person.

Do not use the product if it is damaged or defective. If it is damaged or defective, please contact a qualified technician.

Check the product before each use. Defective parts must be changed immediately as they can impair the function and the safety of the product.

Use the product only on even and non-slip surfaces. Keep sufficient space around for safety.

Beware that when using tools or doing technical work, there is always a risk of injuries. Assemble the product with care.

After installing the product according to the instruction manual, ensure all screws, bolts and nuts are correctly installed and tightened and that all joints are secure.

Do not make alterations to the product. Only use original spare parts. Only qualified technicians should carry out repairs - improper repairs can lead to danger for the user. Use this product only as described in this manual.

## IMPORTANT

The owner's manual contains safety, assembly, use and maintenance instructions. The product must be assembled by an adult who has read and understood these instructions. Keep the packaging away from children and dispose of all packaging before use.

## OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

Provide adult supervision at all times.

The disassembled product contains small parts which pose a choking hazard to children under 3.

Dress children appropriately, including wearing well-fitting shoes that fully protect feet.

Instruct children:

- to sit in the center of the swings with their full weight on the seats,
- to avoid swinging empty seats,
- to slide feet first; one child down slide at a time,
- to remove articles, before playing on equipment, that create hazards when they get tangled and caught.
- not to walk close to, in front of, behind, or between moving items,
- not to get off equipment while it is in motion.

Never allow children to use the equipment in a manner other than intended. Do not swing while standing or slide down head first.

### WARNING:

Product must be assembled by an adult. Keep small parts necessary for assembly out of children's reach.
