For more stability, it's best to anchor the cabinet to the wall.

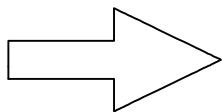
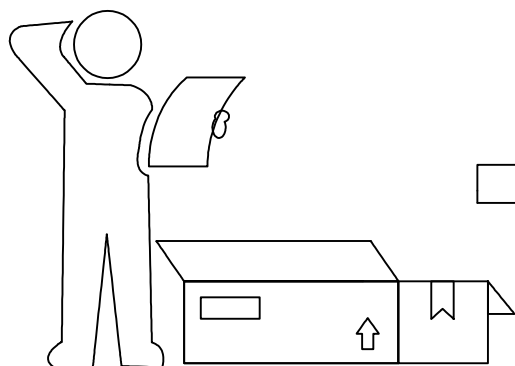
In this case, along with the items provided you will also need a Level, Percussion Drill and a Hammer

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Gun Locker Instruction Manual

I. Instructions:

1. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- (1) The yellow light will flash once every time the operation key is pressed.
- (2) The "#" key on the operation keyboard is used to indicate confirmation.
- (3) If there is no subsequent key input after pressing any key for 20 seconds, it will enter sleep mode.
- (4) Once in sleep mode, all operations terminate, and pressing any key wakes up to enter functional operations.
- (5) The management password and personal password can be changed freely without power outage, without affecting each other, and are independent of each other.

MANAGEMENT PASSWORD:123456

2. MANAGEMENT PASSWORD SETTINGS AND CHANGES

Press the "00" key and then press the settings button. The buzzer will beep twice and the yellow indicator light will turn on to indicate that the management password has started to be set. Enter any number from 3 to 8 digits and press the "#" or "*" key to confirm that the buzzer beeps twice. The yellow indicator light will turn off to indicate that the personal password has been successfully set or changed.

3. PERSONAL PASSWORD SETTINGS AND CHANGES

Press the settings button directly, the buzzer will sound twice, the yellow indicator light will light up, and the personal password will start to be set or changed. Then enter any number from 3 to 8 digits and press the "#" key to confirm.

The buzzer beeps twice and the yellow indicator light goes out, indicating that the personal password has been successfully set or changed.

4. OPENING AND LOCKING THE DOOR

(1) After entering the correct management password or personal password, press the "#" key to confirm. The buzzer will sound twice and the green indicator light will light up to indicate

The password is correct, and the electromagnet can be activated for 5 seconds to open and lock the door.

(2) After about 5 seconds, the green indicator light goes out and the electromagnet is released.

(3) If the password is entered incorrectly, press the "#" key to confirm and the buzzer will sound three times.

(4) If three inputs are incorrect, an automatic alarm will sound for one minute. Enter the correct password to clear the alert.

5. VIBRATION ALARM

(1) Set alert method: Press the "#" key, and the computer board will automatically enter the alert state. Immediately sound the alarm after the safe box vibrates.

(2) Release Alert Method: After the safe box alarms, enter the set password and press the "#" key to open the door, which will eliminate the alert.

6. UNDER VOLTAGE INDICATION

(1) When there is under voltage, the red indicator light will also light up when the green light is on. At this time, it can still continue to work for a period of time, but we hope to replace the battery as soon as possible.

(2) This model comes with a memory chip, which provides password protection that will never be lost after power failure.

7. TECHNICAL PARAMETERS

(1) Working power: four 5th "AA" alkaline batteries

(2) Working voltage range: 4.0V~6.8V

(3) Working under voltage point: 4.50V plus or minus 0.30V

(4) Working current: $\leq 380\text{mA}$

(5) Quiescent current is less than 5Ua

(6) Working temperature: -10°C ~ $+70^{\circ}\text{C}$

(7) Working humidity: 10%-90%RH
