- 1. The floor must be installed properly in accordance with Pergo installation instructions. Proper installation includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - A moisture test is strongly recommended to determine if excessive moisture exists in the subfloor. Failure to demonstrate an
 - acceptable moisture test was completed prior to installation may result in future warranty claim denial.
 - When using a calcium chloride moisture test for concrete subfloors (ASTM F1869), values must be less than or equal to 5 pounds / 1,000 square feet / 24 hours or less than 80%. RH (relative humidity) with an in-situ probe (ASTM F2170).
 - A 6 mil polyethylene film vapor barrier must be used over concrete subfloors.
