

Steps for Cleaning Birdbath

Step 1: Empty the birdbath

The first step in cleaning your bird bath is to empty it completely. This can be done by simply by tipping the birdbath on its side. Once all of the water has been drained, you can move on to the next step.

Step 2: Clean Out Any Debris

Once the bird bath has been emptied, it's important to remove any debris or plant life that may have built up in the basin. This can be done with clean water at room temperature below 100 degrees Fahrenheit using a soft cloth. Caution: Do not use soapy water, detergent or any abrasive cleaner as they can damage the paint.

Step 3: Wipe Down All Surfaces

Wipe down all surfaces using a damp soft cloth Making sure all surfaces of the bird bath get a thorough cleaning. Once clean, remove any remaining moisture in the bowl with a soft dry cloth.

Step 4:

Refill the birdbath with water and enjoy.
