- **Do not completely tighten screws until all screws are started.**Tighten each bolt firmly and properly.
- Some parts may contain sharp edges. Wear protective gloves as necessary.

Seek assistance to assemble bulky or heavy items.

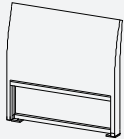
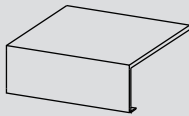
