- 1) Frame opening 1/4" larger than vent body size and drill pilot holes in corners from inside of wall.
- 2) Mark straight lines between pilot holes and cut rough opening from exterior wall
- 3) Apply sealant around inside of flange
- 4) Insert vent into opening and secure with screws (2 ea. side). For a cleaner finish, fasten screw through sides between blades.

Note: Flange Front Gable Louvers have 1/8 inch mesh
