Freesias are visually stunning, blooming in abundant clusters with up to eight trumpet-shaped, upward-pointing blossoms on leafless stems. Despite popular belief, they are easy to grow.

About This Variety: These freesias produce double blooms and come in a mixture of bold colors.

*Growing Instructions:* Plant about 16 bulbs per square foot. They look best grouped together. Extend the blooming season in a cut garden by planting a few bi-weekly, as they bloom about 10-12 weeks after planting. They can also be grown in pots indoors.


Care Tip: In USDA zones cooler than 9, the corms will not survive the winter and should be dug up, should you want to over winter them.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 12-24"

Spacing: Plant 2-4" apart, 2" deep

USDA Zones: Hardy in USDA zones 9-10
