






AVOID SCRATCHES!

In order to avoid scratching this furnuture should be assembled on a soft layer-could be a rug.






IMPROVE EFFICIENCY!

ANTI-TOPPLE WARNING!

Overturned furniture can cause serious or fatal crush injuries. To prevent tipping over, be sure to use the wall attachment, if not included with this product. Please purchase the wall attachment that fit your wall. If unsure, seek professional advice. Please read and follow each step of the instructions carefully.

IMPORTANT!

It is important that any product which is assembled using any kind of screw is re-tightened 2 weeks after assembly,and once every 3 months - in order to assure stability through-out the lifespan of the product.

For regular maintenance and cleaning of the product, for the frame, please use a rag dipped in neutral detergent to fully wipe it, and then dry it with a clean rag. For glass materials, wipe with a rag dampened with water glass cleaner, and then dry with a dry rag.

Do not use an electric screwdriver, and do not use too much force when installing, because the board is easy to break.

NOTE: Supplied wall plugs are only suitable for use in masonry walls.

If you have any doubts about using the correct plug for your wall, please seek professional advice. Failure of the product due to using incorrect fixings is the responsibility of the installer.

When drilling into walls, always check for hidden wires or pipes, etc.




Tips & Tricks

Make sure that the hardware used is suitable for suppor grown untit. Please consult a qualified tradesperson if unsure.

- ☑ If you are unsure, please select a larger screw and wall plug.
- ☑ Ensure that you use the recommended drill bit to match the wall plug and hole size.
- Take extra care when drilling high walls, ceiling and ceramic \boxtimes les. Ensure wall plugs are inserted beyond the thickness of the ceramic \boxtimes les to avoid spli \boxtimes ng or cracking.
- \square Ensure that wall plugs are well fi \square ed and are a \square ght fit in the drilled hole.


Types Of Walls

Use one of the following types of wall plug (not included) if your walls are made of brick, breeze block, concrete, stone or wood. Screws may be able to be fixed directly to solid wood walls as they will provide a secure anchor point.




1. General Purpose Wall Plug

Generally, aerated blocks should not be used to support heavy loads, use a specialist fi⊠ng in this case. For light loads, general purpose wall plugs can be used.




2. Plasterboard Wall Plug

For use when a \boxtimes aching light loads onto plasterboard par \boxtimes \boxtimes ons.




3. Cavity Fixing Wall Plug

For use with plasterboard par \square ons or hollow wooden doors.




4. Cavity Fixing Heavy Duty Wall Plug

For use when fi \boxtimes ng or suppor \boxtimes ng heavy loads such as shelving and wall cabinets.



5. Hammer Fixing Wall Plug


For use with concrete block or brick walls, or walls stuck with plasterboard. The hammer fixing allows it to be fixed to the wall rather than the plasterboard. Always check the fixing is secure to the retaining wall.



6. Shield Anchor Wall Plug Heavy Loads


For use with concrete or brick walls, or for use with heavier loads such as TV & HiFi speakers and satellite dishes, etc.


SAFETY PRECAUTIONS



Tighten quickfit until shoulder is flush with panel. Do not overtighten or undertighten.


CAM LOCK






When fitting cam lock, ensure starting position is correct before you insert connecting quickfit.

Quickfit head should be in the centre of the cam lock when the two panels are joined. Cam lock should be inserted before quickfit.





Turn cam lock clockwise to tighten.

After the warranty period expires, replacement components will be provided to customers at cost price for continued service.





