

PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.

Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.

Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.

Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches and damages.

Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes.




Use the appropriate hand tools or power tools for assembly. Select steps, such as tightening screws and/or bolts, may require hand tools to avoid causing damage during assembly.



Turn clockwise to tighten and only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



Save the instruction and store any supplied tools for later maintenance.





After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.






Take the Pillow (14), Back Cushion (13), Blister Hardware out from the Armrest Right (7). Velcro the bottom of the Armrests.




2 Take the Pillow (14), Back Cushion (13) out from the Armrest Left (6). Velcro the bottom of the Armrests.




Open the Seat Cushions (10, 11, 12), Back Cushions (13) and Pillows (14) by suitable tools. Note: Cushions need 48 hours to bounce back.




Close the Velcro. Attach the sofa Legs (8) to the Armrests (6 / 7).




Attach the Support Rails (1) to the Armrests (6 / 7) by the Bolt 5/16" x 50mm (B) and Allen Key (C).




- Align and insert the Threaded Rod 5/16" x 80mm (D) into the hole on the Armrests and turn clockwise to tighten by manually.
 - Insert Bolts 5/16" x 25mm (A) with Allen Key (C) on the Armrests by manually. NOTE: Do not fully tighten the bolts, leave at least 10mm visible so that you can hanger hook on the bolts.




Overturn back cover, open zipper
Raise the Backrest Frame (5) up and place the rod (D) to align with the bore holes on the end
of the Backrest Frame (5). Put the Backrest Frame (5) up against the Armrests (6 / 7) so the
threaded rods (D) go through the bore holes. Insert flat washer (F), spring lock washers (G)
and place hex nuts (E) on threaded rod (D) then tighten the hex nuts (E) with wrench (H)
provided. Do not fully tighten the hex nuts, equally distance divided on both sides.




Raise the Front/Back Panels (2 / 3) up , bring the Front/Back Panels (2 / 3) and align the hook on the side rail to the bolts. Once the Front/Back Panels (2 / 3) is set, tighten all bolts by using a Allen key (D). After assembly, re-tighten all bolts for a snug fit. DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN.





Close Velcro the cover of Backrest Frame (5) and Armrest (6 / 7).








