
HOW TO INSTALL YOUR STAIR PARTS

BALUSTER WITH DECORATIVE SHOE

- Refer to your local building code for current regulations.





Recommended tools

1. Baluster installation




Mark the location of each baluster at an equal distance from one another in accordance with your local building code.




Drill 11/16" pilot holes at each mark, 1" deep.




At each baluster location, measure the length between the tread and the lower side of the handrail. Add 3/4" to the measurement for insertion.





Trim each baluster from the top using a metal saw.






Slide the decorative shoe.






Insert each baluster in the handrail hole. Make a half turn to make sure that adhesive is on all faces of baluster.



Using a level make sure the balusters are straight then secure using screws.
