
This product is intended for household use only. This product is covered by a limited ten-years warranty. Coverage is subject to limits and exclusions. See warranty for details.

Parts List



Assembly

1. Lay the carton flat on the floor and carefully cut it open.



2. Flat the carton so that the open side faces down and take off the carton. Place the bed **Part A** on the floor.

3. Remove and discard the plastic bag. Put together the two pieces of the bed and align them flat on the floor.

4. Cut the zip ties, take out all the part boxes and the mattress rail, and check that you have all the necessary parts according to the parts list.





5. For leg **Part C** assembly push the screw through the triangular brace. Screw in the leg and tighten.

6. First **Part G** DC extension cable connect the control box "Power port" (on the bed),then connect **Part E** power supply box, then **Part E** connect **Part F** power cable,reconnect the **Part F** to your nearby power outlet.




7.Insert **Part H** batteries into the **Part D** remote control. Press the first button(any button). If the motor begins to run, unplug the power supply and turn the bed over to its right side-up position. If the motor does not run, it needs to re-match its code.

Matching code:


Method 1: Cut off the power and waiting for 10 seconds. Then plug the power again. You will see the blue light on the control box(like first picture). At the same time press and hold the buttons that the arrow points of the remote control simultaneously(like the second picture shows). Release them when the white backlight flashes. Finally, if the blue light in the controller turns to green, the code matches.


Method 2: Press twice the controller "PAIR" button that the arrow points to light up the blue light(like the circle shows in the first picture). Then press and hold the buttons that the arrow points of the remote control simultaneously(like the second picture shows). Release them when white backlight flashes. Finally, if the blue light in the controller turns to green, the code matches






8. Insert the mattress rail **Part B** at the foot of the bed. Then the bed is ready for use.





Remote Control and Functions:



Operation Operation Button Button Press and hold to raise the backrest. Press and hold to raise the footrest. Let go when the desired position is Let go when the desired position is reached. reached. Press and hold to lower the footrest. Let go when the desired position is **FLAT** Press FLAT button to flatten bed. reached. Press and hold to lower the backrest. Click to set a zero gravity position. Let go when the desired position is Position Angle: HEAD-16°, FOOTreached. ANTI Click to set a Anti Snore Position. Click to set a user-defined position. Position Angle: HEAD-10° SNORE Click to turn the LED flashlight on top of the remote on and off.

Memory Setting:

Setting a memory position if you're not satisfied with the factory setting.









- 2. Adjust the bed to your preferred position by pressing the head and foot up/down buttons.
- 3. Press and hold button M and let go after you hear the "didi" sound that indicates the setting has been successfully programmed.

Split King/Dual Twin XL Sync Instructions

Method 1:

- 1. Place two(2) Twin XL bases side by side.
- 2. With one remote, match the code for one bed. Follow the steps in matching code section. Press and hold the two buttons which show in following picture (1)
- 3.Use this remote to code another bed. Follow the steps in matching code section but press and hold the another two buttons which show in following picture (2)
- 4. You can use one remote to control two beds.





Method 2:

- 1. Place two(2) Twin XL bases side by side.
- 2. Using a sync cable connect one bed to another.
- 3.Make sure that you plug the crystal head of sync cable into the port which marked on "SYNC" on the control box.
- 4. With one remote, match the code for one bed. Follow the steps in matching code section. Just code for one bed.
- 5. You can use one remote to control two beds



* NOTE:(SYNC CABLE: Only for split King.)

Troubleshooting:

If you experience problems with your adjustable bed, please follow these steps:

- 1.Press any button on the remote control to see whether the blue backlight is bright. If it's dim or does not light, check the battery.
- 2. Check the green power indicator light on the power supply. If it's not lit, check the power outlet.
- 3. Check for loose wires or connectors.
- 4. Check if the adjustable beds assembled according to the above steps.
