PATIO CALLA CAPTAIN FUEGO *with Yellow Metal Planter and Growers Pot*



Calla (*Zantedeschia*) lilies are extraordinary flowers. Their trumpet-shaped spathes and arrow-shaped leaves will transport you to the tropics, creating a luxurious, exotic atmosphere. You may have limited space or not have a home garden, so you may simply prefer pot culture, as this makes them easier to care for and does not require much space, as long as you have some space for a medium size pot on your porch, patio or balcony.

As callas do not like cold temperatures, start them indoors to give them a head start

About This Variety: Our patio lily kit comes with everything you need to grow this exotic plant. One large packaged Lemon Pixie Lily bulb, a 5" x 7" trendy yellow metal decorative outer pot, a 5" nursery pot, a block of compressed soil, and growing directions.

Growing Instructions: Plant early spring so the calla bulb can get established before the hot weather. They love the sun so consider that when choosing a location, however some afternoon shade will extend flowering time. Simply expand the soil, following the directions, fill the nursery pot with 2/3 of the medium, position the bulb, roots down, pointy end up and cover with the remaining soil. Then water well, not letting the pot dry out.

Care Tip: As bulbs are essentially storage mechanisms, they already contain everything needed to produce flowers. There is no need to fertilize them. After flowering, remove the root ball from the pot and plant in your garden prior to frost to enjoy blooms next spring if you live in the deep south. Otherwise try to over winter the pot indoors.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 18-24" tall
