The boards can be installed horizontally or vertically. The system minimizes the need for visible fasteners, giving your space a clean finish. For best results, our experts recommend using a level to ensure even placement and following our installation guidelines for secure attachment. What are the shiplap and trim specifications?

The width of the 1x6 shiplap board is 5.375 in. with a thickness of .5625 in. and an exposed face of 4.625 in. The width of the 1x8 shiplap board is 6.4375 in. with a thickness of .5625 in. and an exposed face of 4.625 in. The width of the trim board is 3.5 in. with a thickness of .5625 in.

What is the touch-up paint color match?

No. Timeless boards are painted on one side and have relief grooves on the other side to prevent cupping. The smooth, refined side is intended for visible installation.

Can I use Timeless boards on my bathroom walls or as a backsplash?

Yes! Timeless is ideal for bathroom walls, backsplashes, and other high-wear areas with the right care. The elegant surface adds a touch of sophistication and tranquility to your bathrooms and kitchens. Our experts recommend you finish the boards with a wood protector sealant to safeguard them from moisture.

Can I install Timeless boards outside?

No, Timeless is not recommended for exterior use.

Can I use Timeless boards around my fireplace?

Yes, with some careful planning. Shiplap should be installed directly onto vertically mounted wood furring strips. It is important to make sure all furring strips are properly secured and even with each other, so the finished surface is even – without waves. Make sure that you follow National Fire Code when installing around a fireplace.
