



# **CAUTION**

- Before starting installation of this fixture or removal of a previous fixture, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box.



# **INSTALLATION**

#### STEP 1


Attach the iron rack and brackt onto fixture using decorative screws and screws.


#### STEP 2

Unscrew the ball nuts from the mounting unit. Use the mounting screws to attach the mounting unit to the junction box.



#### STEP 3

Install stems based on the desired length of the item, adding canopy once finished.

## STEP 4


Make the electrical connection from the junction box to the **fixture**. Connect the ground wire to the **mounting unit** using the preinstalled green ground screw. Then, connect the positive, negative and ground wires with the supplied **wire nuts**. Secure with electrical tape.


Connect Clear, Brown, Gold or Black Parallel Wire without tracer (round & smooth) or Black Fixture Wire to:

Black or Red Supply Wire or Insulated Wire (other than green) with copper conductor.

Connect Clear, Brown, Gold or Black \*Parallel Wire with tracer (square & ridged) or White Fixture


White Supply Wire or Insulated Wire (other than green) with silver conductor





#### STEP 5

Secure the **canopy** to the **mounting unit** with the **ball nuts**.



#### STEP 6

Install bulbs (not included)
