Care & Maintenance



Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.

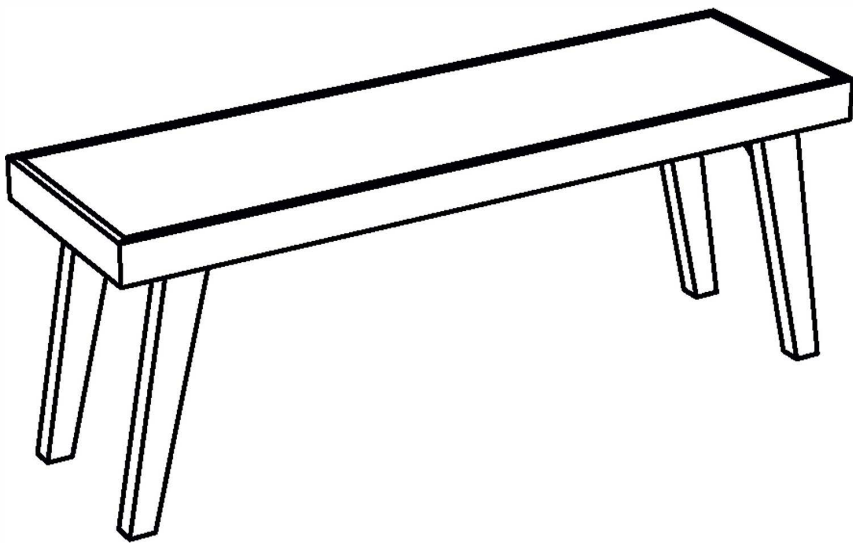


Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.

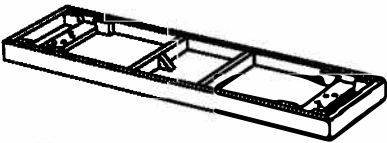
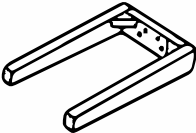
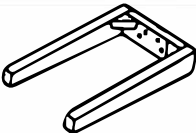


Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

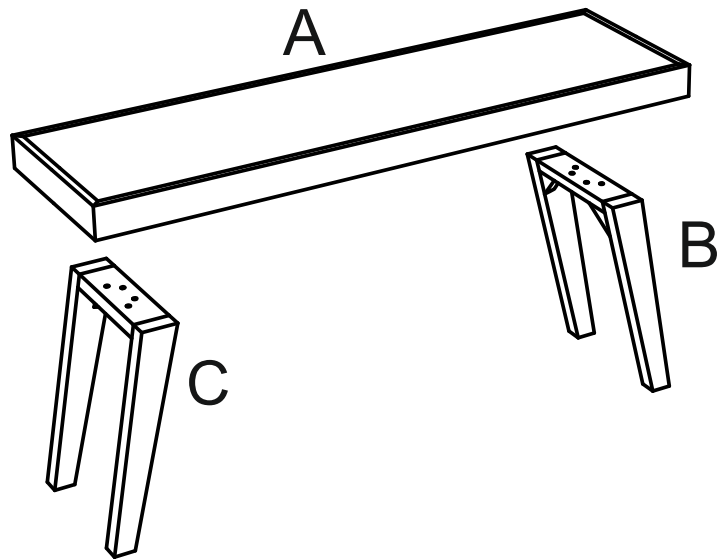

Before Beginning Assembly

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



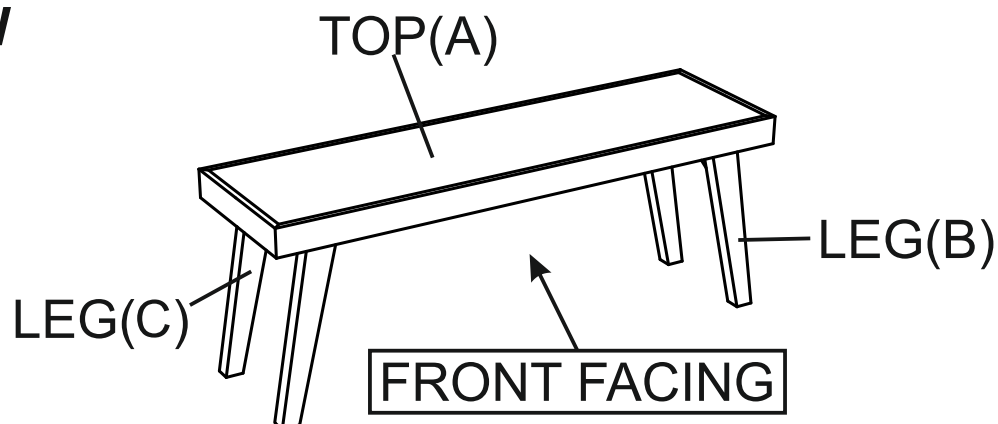
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

Assembly Steps

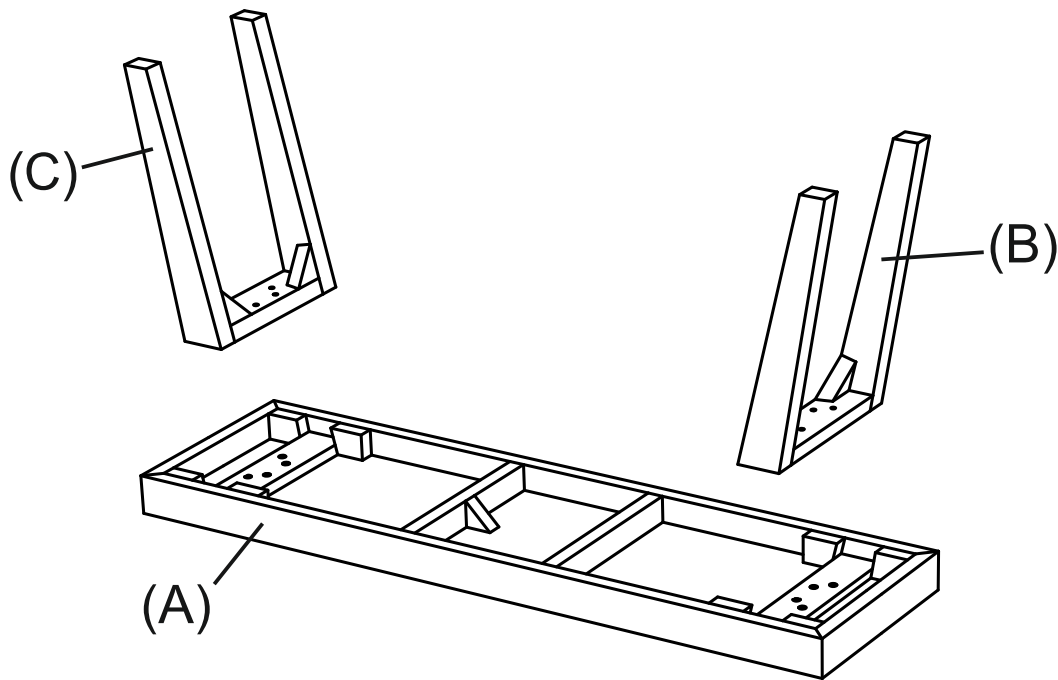
OVERVIEW



This Bench has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bench parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

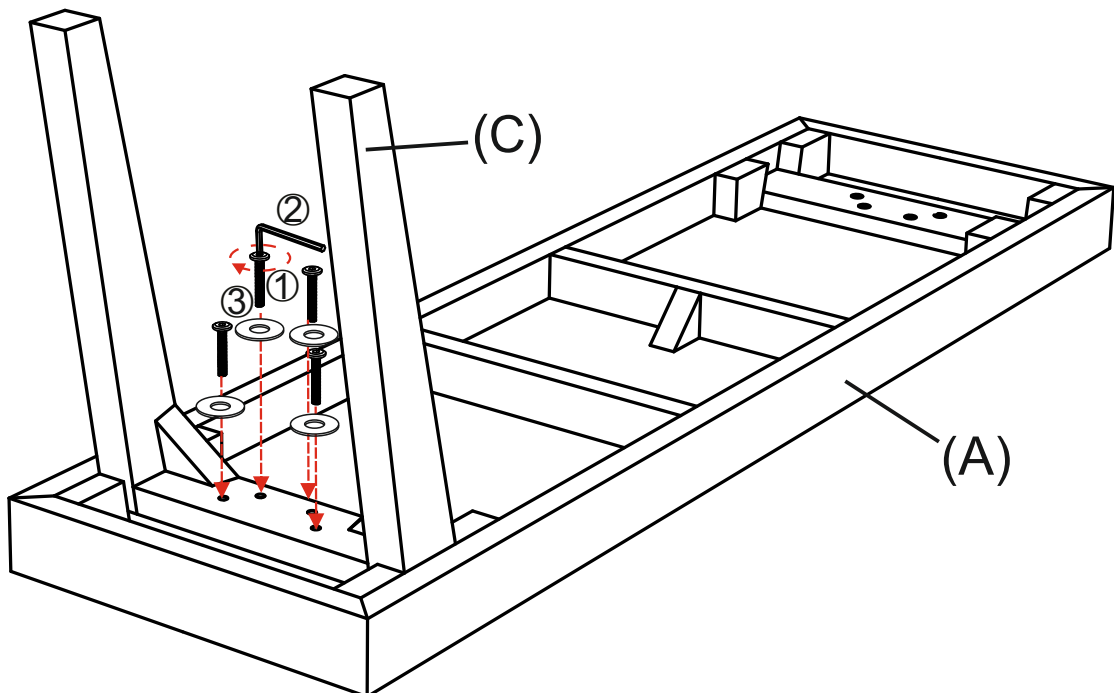
Step-1

Unpack and all parts on a clean, non marring surface.

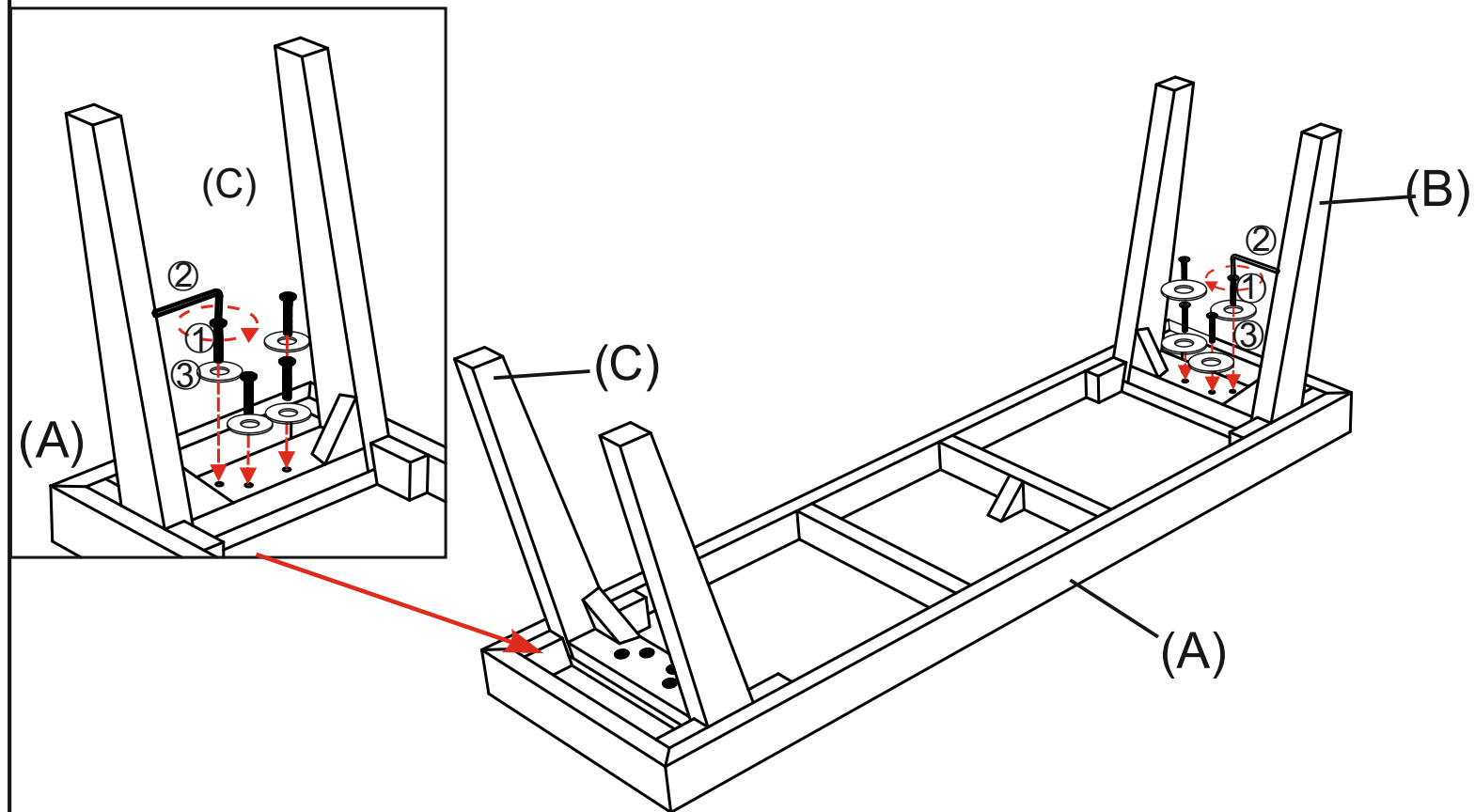


Step-2

Place the Top (A) facing upside down on clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damages to the product. Align the Leg(C) with connector screw holes in Top (A) as show in above picture.

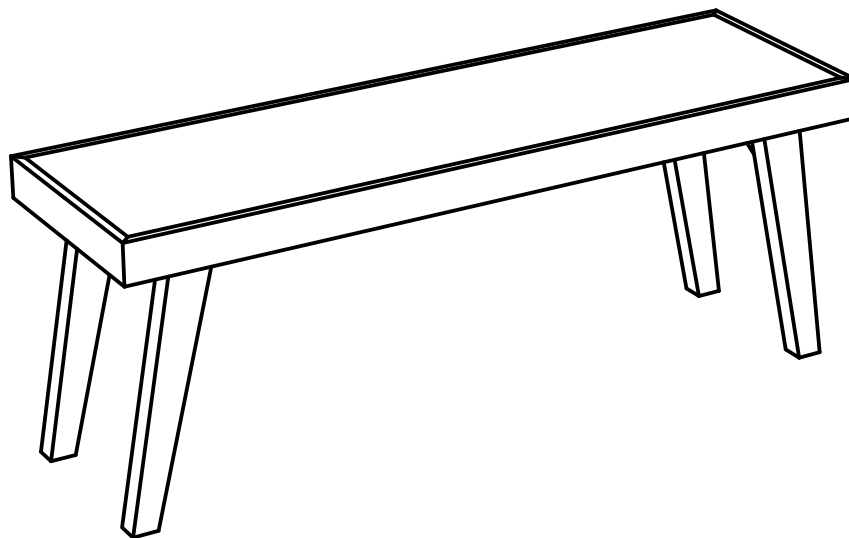


Step-3 Affix the Leg(C) with the Top(A) by using the Allen Bolt(①) and the Allen wrench(②). See Diagram for reference.
DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS.



Repeat the above process to attach the other Leg (B).
DO NOT FULLY TIGHTEN BOLTS.

Step-4



Turn the Bench right side up

Place the Bench on a LEVEL SURFACE.

Inspect the Bench and make sure all the parts are adequately connected.

Once inspected, tighten all the Bolts in a sequential manner.

CAUTION 1: When tightening these bolts, tighten sequentially. DO NOT tighten any bolt fully and then towards the next one. This would cause the frame to warp. If there is still wobbles, loosen the bolts and execute this same process.

WARNING!! IF THE BENCH IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Ensure all bolts are fully locked into position.

The Bench is ready to be used.

Caution 2: This bench can only be used on a flat, level surface.
