Growing Instructions: In fall, plant the bulbs pointy end up, in deep, fertile, well draining soil in full sun to light shade. Bulbs do not like wet feet. Water during their growth period. Fertilization helps growth and increases naturally by offsets. Daffodils can be left undisturbed to naturalize for years. If you cannot plant them immediately, store in a cool, airy place.

Care Tip: When given ample sun light, water and proper nutrition, and removing the flowers as soon as they go but allowing the leaves to brown before removing, they will return for years to come with little other effort.

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Height: Grows 10-24" tall

Spacing: Plant 8" apart, 6" deep

USDA Zones: hardy in USDA zones 3-8
