About This Variety: Commonly only sold in mixtures, this maroon - almost blackish - variety is unique and one of the darkest anemones available.

*Growing Instructions:* Inexpensive and easy to grow, they are the perfect companion for late daffodils and later blooming tulips. For best effect plant in mass sweeps with a heavy hand, planting about 16 per square foot. Purchase several packs to produce that colorful curb appeal effect.

*Care Tip:* Soak the corms in luke warm water overnight before planting to jump start development. Plant after danger of frost.

*Exposure:* Full sun to partial shade *Height:* Grows 12-18" *Spacing:* Plant 3-6" apart, 2-3" deep *Hardy in:* USDA zones 7-10
