
Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly:

Tools required: Phillips screwdriver(medium & large)

- 1: Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- 2: Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- 3: Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- 4: Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.
- 5: During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- 6: ssemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- 7: Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- 8: Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.
- 9: To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.
- 10: Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.
- 11: Regularly check and ensure That all bolts and fittings are tightend properly.
- 12: Please do not place items that exceed the load capacity.


