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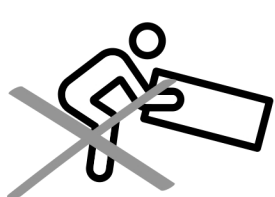
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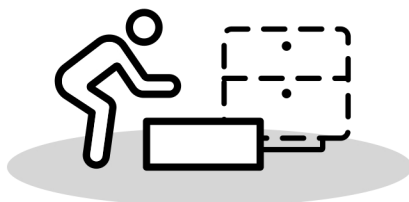
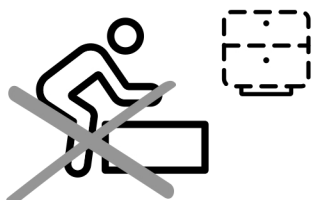
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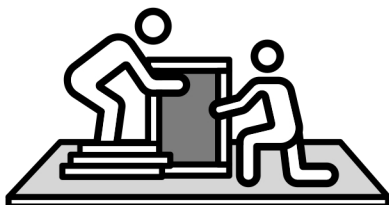
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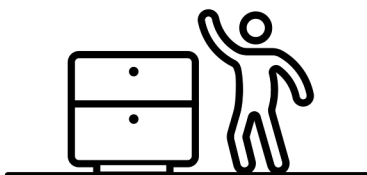
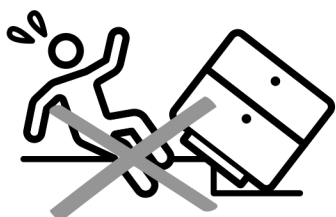
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Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

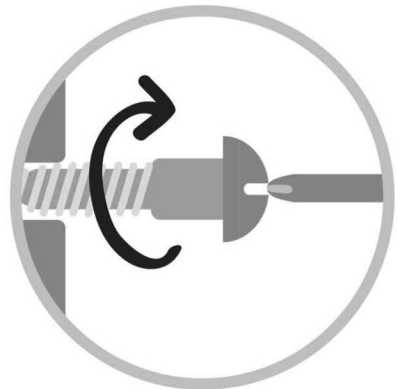

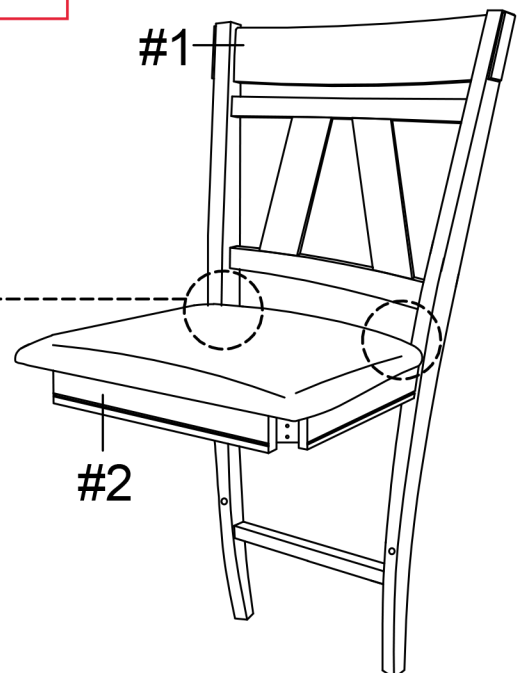
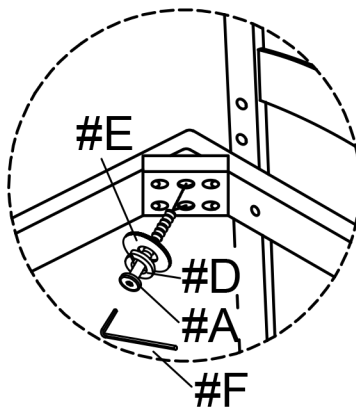
Insert dowel (#H) to the chair back (#1), then align seat (#2) to chair back (#1). Secure by using bolts (#C) with washers (#D,E).
