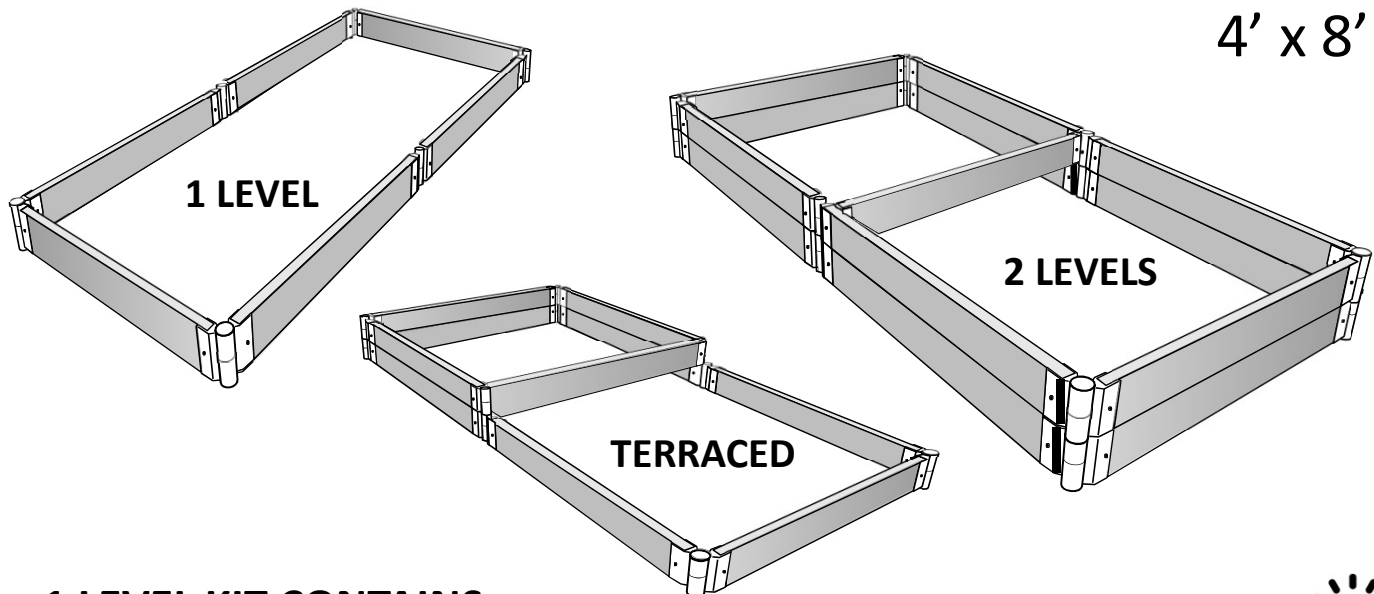



# RAISED GARDEN BED

4' x 8'



## 1 LEVEL KIT CONTAINS:



 Layout your timbers along the borderline and connect each timber together by inserting the top of the stake through the bracket loops with the stake pointing to the sky. This enables you to freely position your border to get your desired location.

## 2 LEVELS KIT CONTAINS:



**TERRACED: ADDITIONAL TIMBERS x 4, STACKING BRACKETS x 8, STAKE x 4, PLUGS x 16, CAPS x 4**

Tools needed: Hammer (to tap stake in place), Hackshaw (optional)

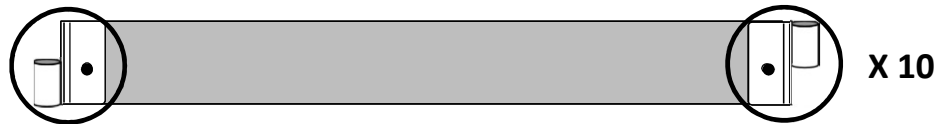
# ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

## STEP 1:

For one level, assemble 6 x Doubled-Bracket Timbers (A)



For two levels, assemble 10 x Doubled-Bracket Timbers (A)

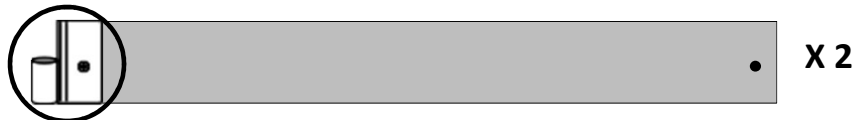


Attach one single stacking bracket to each end of timbers (one facing up, one facing down – shown on the left)

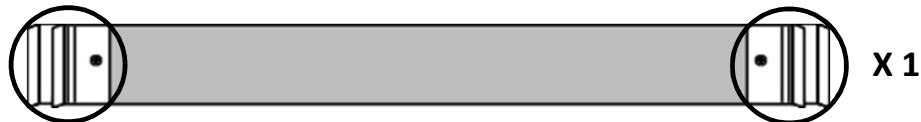
You will need 6 (A) Timbers for the 1<sup>st</sup> (base) level and 4 (A) Timbers for the 2<sup>nd</sup> level.

Terraced ONLY: Assemble additional 4 x Doubled-Bracket Timbers (A)

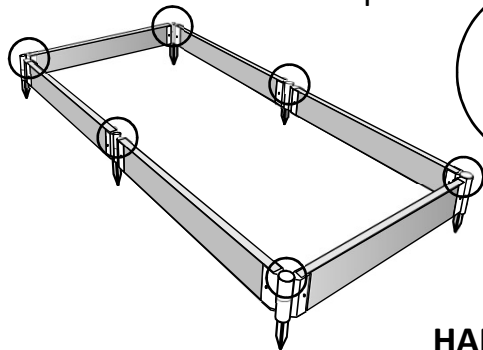
Two Levels ONLY: Assemble 2 x Singled-Bracket Timbers (B)



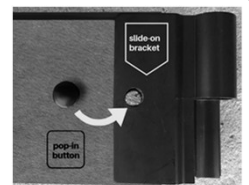
Assemble 1 x Cross-Bracket Timbers (C)



**STEP 2:** Layout the base level of your raised garden in a straight rectangular shape, using 6 (A) timbers. Insert Stake through the hole of the bracket and into each of the corners to lock all sides in place.

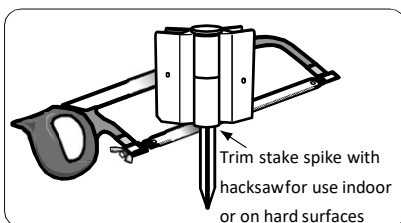


**STEP 2a:** For one level, add caps to each of the top corner joints to finish off the raised garden and plugs to cover the holes on both side of timbers.



Use plugs (included) to cover the holes on both side of timbers

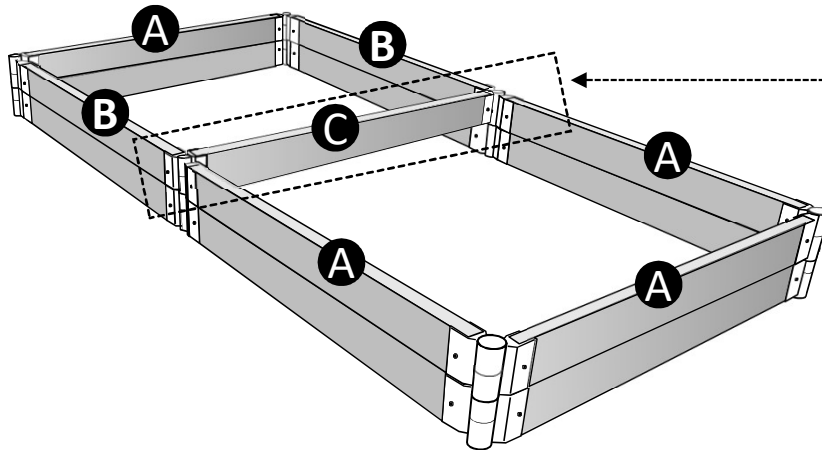


### **Note:**

If you plan to assemble raised bed on a hard surface, use hacksaw to remove the spike of each stake. Use these cut down stakes for the base level only of your raised garden.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS – *For Product with Second Level only*

**STEP 3:** To create 2nd level, use the 4 (A), 2 (B), 1 (C) and the stacking stakes – as shown below.

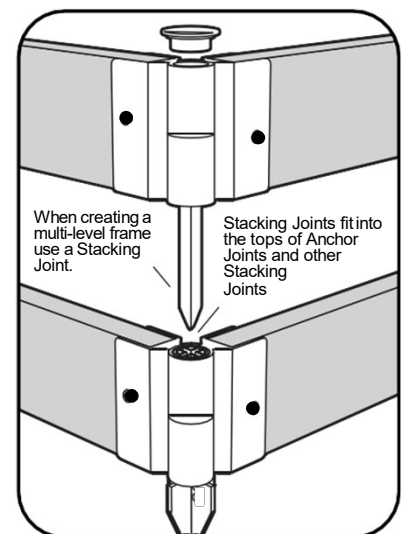
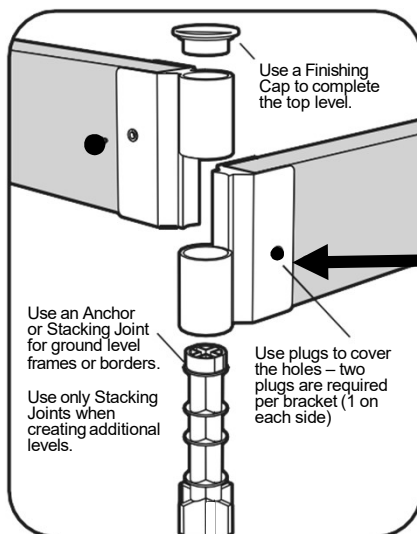


Insert one (C) timber in the middle of 2<sup>nd</sup> level to create 4 x 4 partition

**STEP 4:** Insert one stake through the brackets into the holes on the top of the stake beneath it to lock the 2<sup>nd</sup> level in place – similar to **STEP 2**.

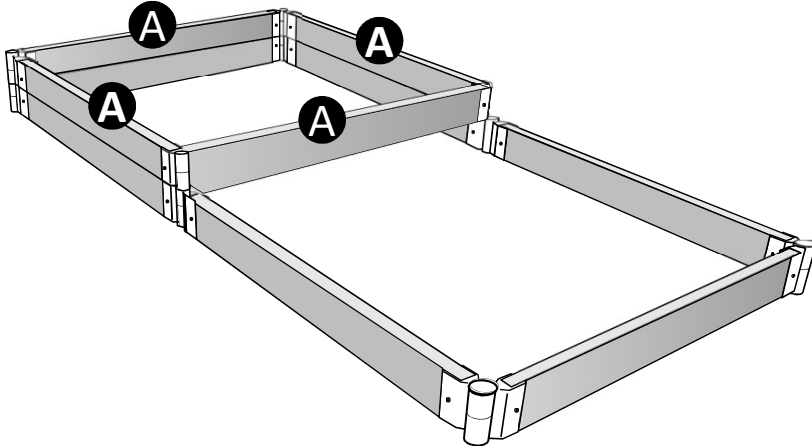
**STEP 5:** Add the caps to each of the top corner joints and plugs to cover the holes on both side of timbers.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS – *Terraced only*

**STEP 3:** To create 2nd level (Terraced), use the 4 (A) and the stacking stakes – as shown below.



**STEP 4:** Insert one stake through the brackets into the holes on the top of the stake beneath it to lock the 2<sup>nd</sup> level in place – similar to **STEP 2**.

**STEP 5:** Add the caps to each of the top corner joints and plugs to cover the holes on both side of timbers.
