Note that H is the last part.</p>
<p>Step 3</p> 	<p>Step 4</p>  <p>To support the internal steel pipe, we have to install the tent</p>	<p>Step 5</p>  <p>The position with the reflective strip</p>
<p>Step 6</p>  <p>The tail needs to be fixed to the ground with expansion screws</p>	<p>Secure the frame</p> <p>Weights can be placed on the flat bar connected to the D plate. Bolts can be used to fasten the swivel plates of A&B to concrete or other firm surface</p> <p>Fold Down and Storage</p> <p>The Motor tent Is designed to fold down for storage as needed. While the Motor tent is still fully assembled, remove the bolts for the A frame and take out the H tubes. The motor tent can then collapse closed pivoting on the A and B base assemblies.
