Please read and understand this entire manual before attempting to assemble, operate or install the product.

WARNING

- Maximum load for the roof hook: 26 lbs.
- If high winds, heavy rains or any snow occurs, remove roof, and check for damage before continued use.

CAUTION

SET UP YOUR GAZEBO PROPERLY

- 2 people are recommended for safe assembly.
- Keep all children, pets and other obstructions away from assembly area.
- If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product.
- In order to avoid damage to the gazebo and its components please use appropriate tools.
- Do not use the structure as support.
- Check all bolts on a regular basis to maintain the solidity of the structure.
- Keep instructions for future use.
- Do not climb on top of the gazebo. Falling off the gazebo can result in serious injury, possibly even death.

EXAMINE YOUR GAZEBO

- Examine occasionally to ensure there are no loose parts.
If loose parts are found, they should be retightened immediately.

PREPARATION

Before beginning assembly of product, make sure all parts are present. Compare parts with package contents list and hardware contents list. If any part is missing or damaged, do not attempt to assemble the product.

- 1.1. Unfold two corner panels (A).
- 1.2. Connect the connector (D1) onto the crossbeam (B1) by bolt (AA) and flat washers (DD), then connect the crossbeam (B1) onto the corner panel (A) by bolt (BB), flat washers (DD), nut (EE). Place cap (GG) on the nut (EE).



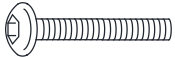
2.1. Insert short corner bar (I) into long corner bar (H). Repeat for remaining long corner bars (H) and short corner bars (I).

2.2. Insert the bottom part of long corner bar (H) into top connector (G).

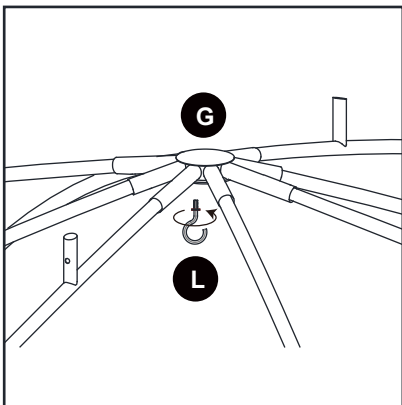
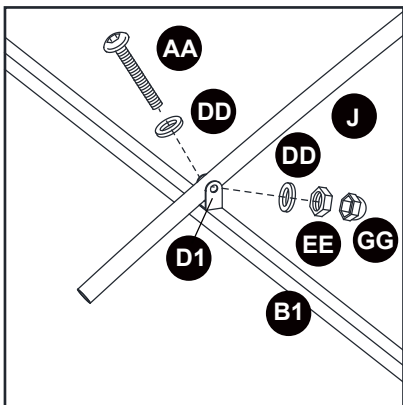
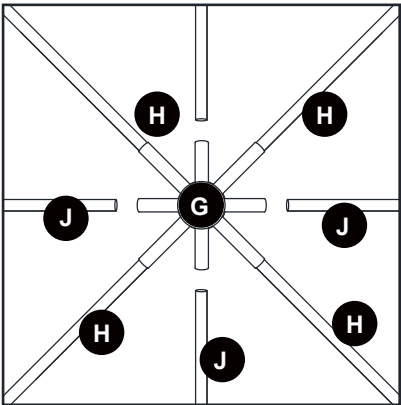
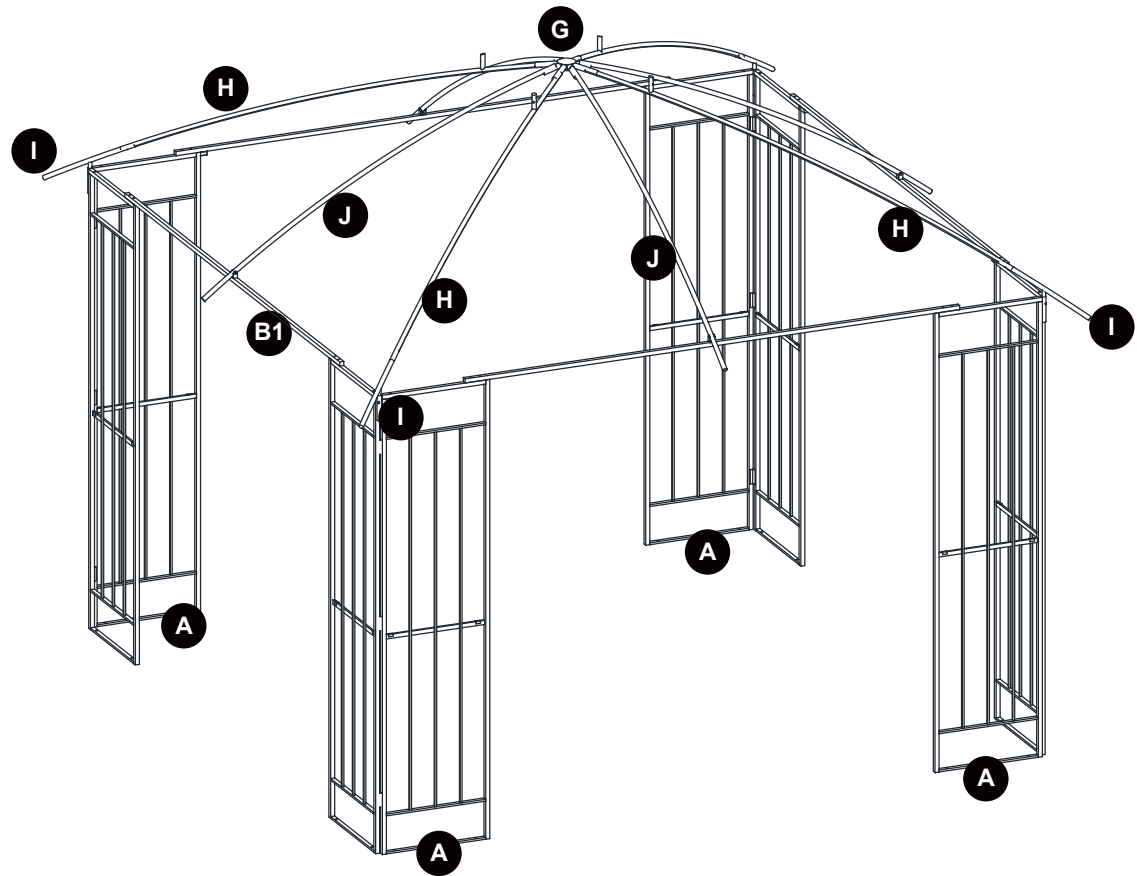
Repeat for remaining long corner bars (H). Insert short corner (I) bar into corner panel (A).

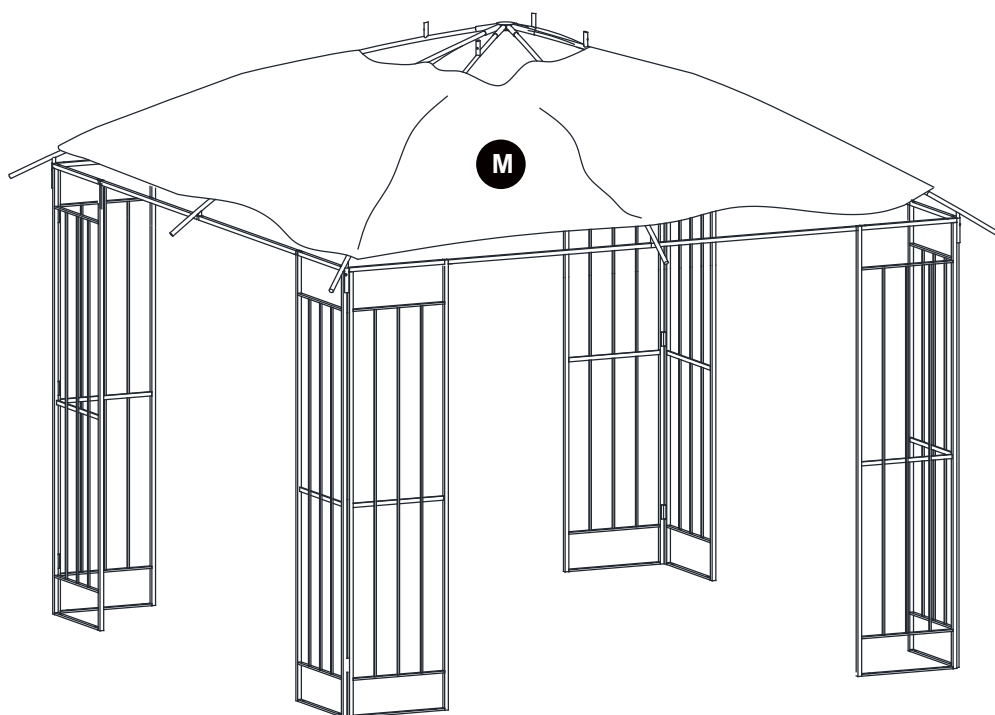

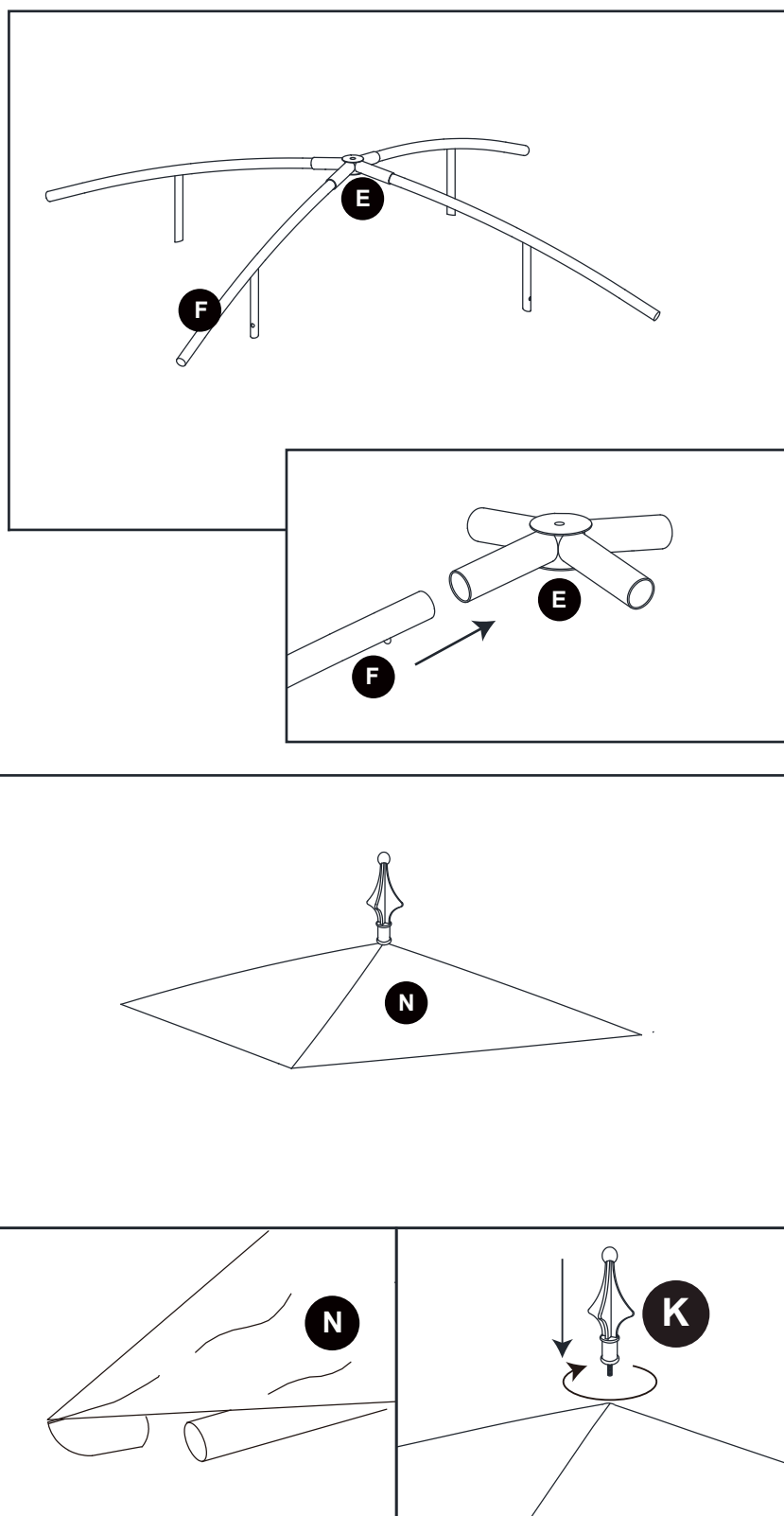

- 3.1. Insert the top part of middle bar (J) into top connector (G). Repeat for all middle bars (J).
- 3.2. Connect the middle bar (J) onto the connector (D1) by bolt (AA), Flat washers (DD), Nut (EE). Place cap (GG) on the nut (EE).
- 3.3. Attach hook (L) to top connector (G).

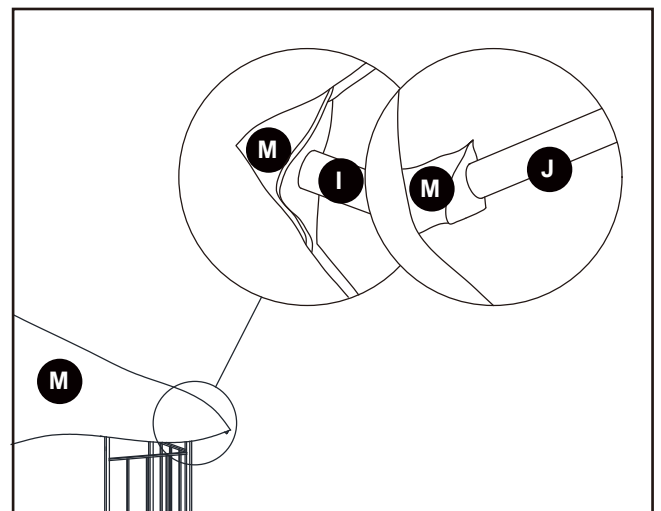
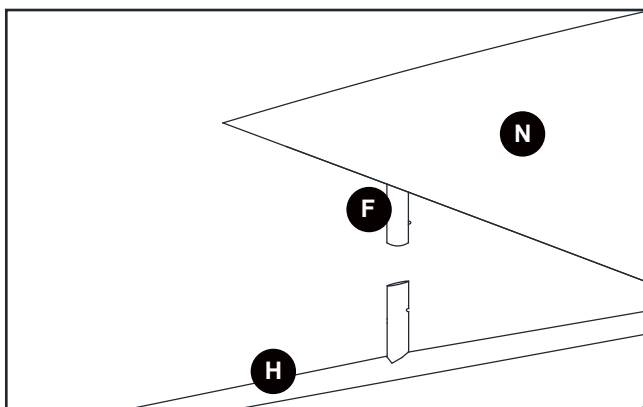
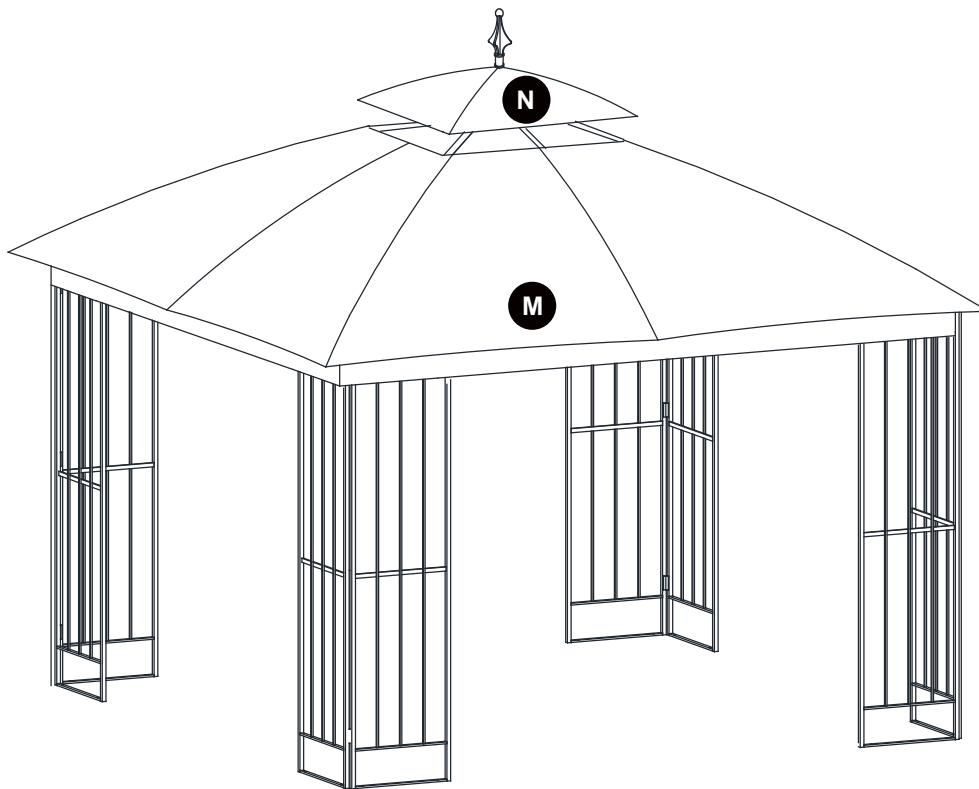


4. Place large canopy (M) on top of gazebo assembly. Do not spread canopy yet.



5.1. Insert small top beam (F) into small top connector (E).

5.2. Attach small canopy (N) to small top beam (F), aligning the corners and stretching it to fit. Attach finial (K) to small top connector (E).



6.1. Insert small top beam (F) into long corner bar (H),
Repeat for all small top beams.

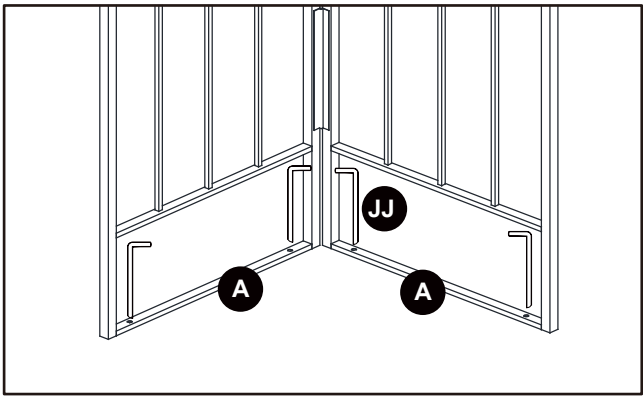
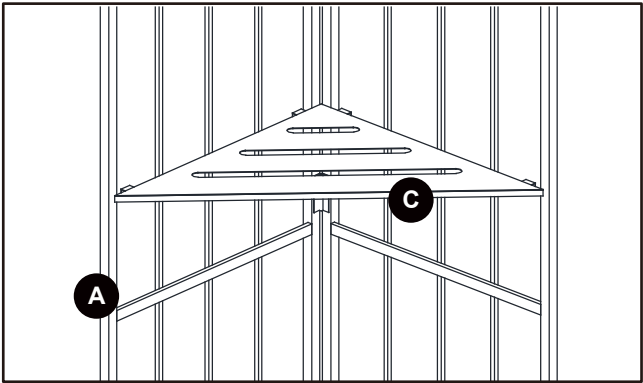
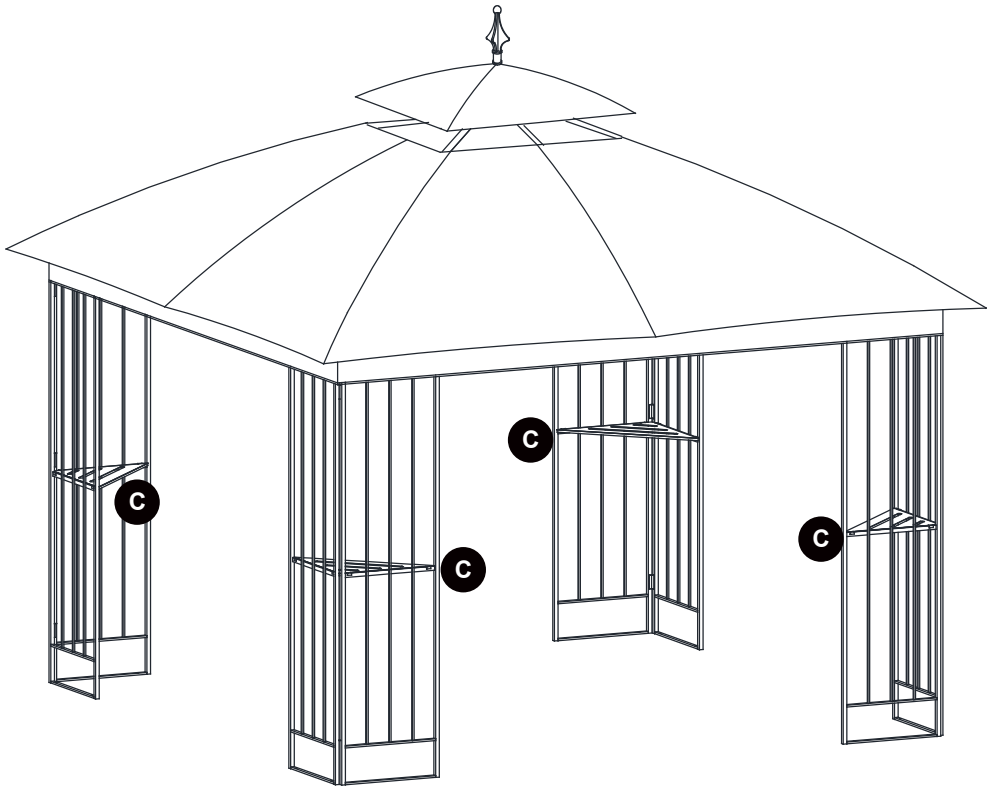
Note: Put each small top beam (F) loosely on each long top connector bar (H) first, then insert together, otherwise the last one won't insert correctly.

6.2. Attach large canopy (M) to the roof along the short corner bars (I) and middle bar (J), aligning the corners and stretching it to fit.

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- 7.1. Place shelves (C) onto corner panels (A) as desired.
- 7.2. Secure gazebo assembly to the ground with stakes (JJ) through the bottom of corner panels (A).

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- For cleaning, use a mild detergent solution, rinse with water, and allow to air dry.
Do not use acetone, abrasive, or other special detergents as they would be harmful to the product's finish.
- Due to the nature of steel, surface oxidation (rusting) will occur if this protective coating is scratched.
This is a natural process. To minimize this condition, it is recommended that care be taken when assembling and handling the product in order to prevent the paint from being scratched.

WARRANTY

1 YEAR WARRANTY FOR FRAME AND FABRIC.

We provide warranty to the original purchase for 1 year for frame and fabric from the date of purchase, and the fabric and frame will be replaced at no charge due to manufacturing defects.

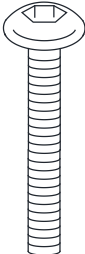
• WHAT IS NOT COVERED

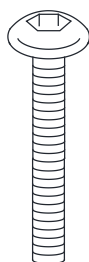

PRECAUCIÓN

ENSAMBLE EL GAZEBO ADECUADAMENTE

- Se recomienda que haya 2 personas para un ensamblaje seguro.
- Mantenga a niños, mascotas y otras obstrucciones alejados del área de ensamblaje.
- No intente ensamblar el producto si falta alguna pieza o si estas están dañadas.
- Para evitar que se produzcan daños en el gazebo y sus componentes, use las herramientas correspondientes.
- No utilice la estructura como soporte.
- Revise todos los pernos regularmente para mantener la solidez de la estructura.
- Conserve las instrucciones para usarlas en el futuro.
- No trepe a la parte superior del gazebo. Las caídas desde el gazebo podrían provocar lesiones graves o incluso la muerte.

EXAMINE EL GAZEBO

- De vez en cuando, examínelo para asegurarse de que no haya piezas sueltas.
Si encuentra piezas sueltas, ajústelas de inmediato.

PREPARACIÓN

Antes de comenzar a ensamblar el producto, asegúrese de tener todas las piezas. Compare las piezas con la lista del contenido del paquete y la lista de aditamentos. No intente ensamblar el producto si falta alguna pieza o si estas están dañadas.

- 1.2. Una el conector (D1) al travesaño (B1) con un perno (AA) y arandelas planas (DD), luego conecte el travesaño (B1) con el panel de esquina (A) con un perno (BB), arandelas planas (DD) y una tuerca (EE). Coloque la tapa (GG) en la tuerca (EE).

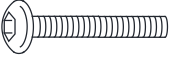


2.1. Inserte la barra de esquina corta (I) en la barra de esquina larga (H). Repita el procedimiento con las barras de esquina largas (H) y cortas (I) restantes.

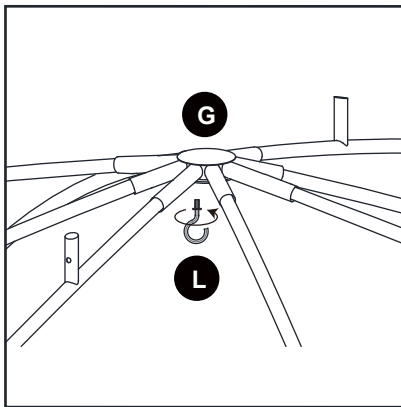
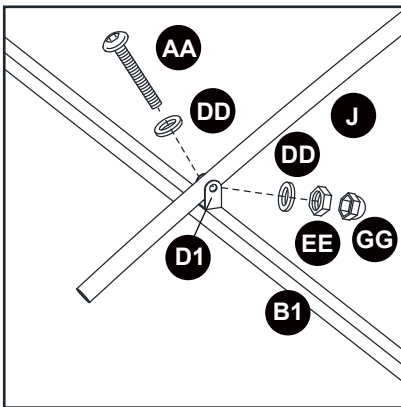
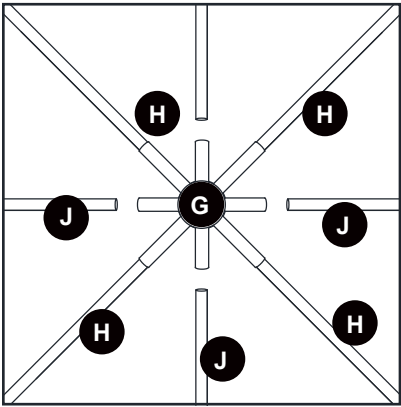
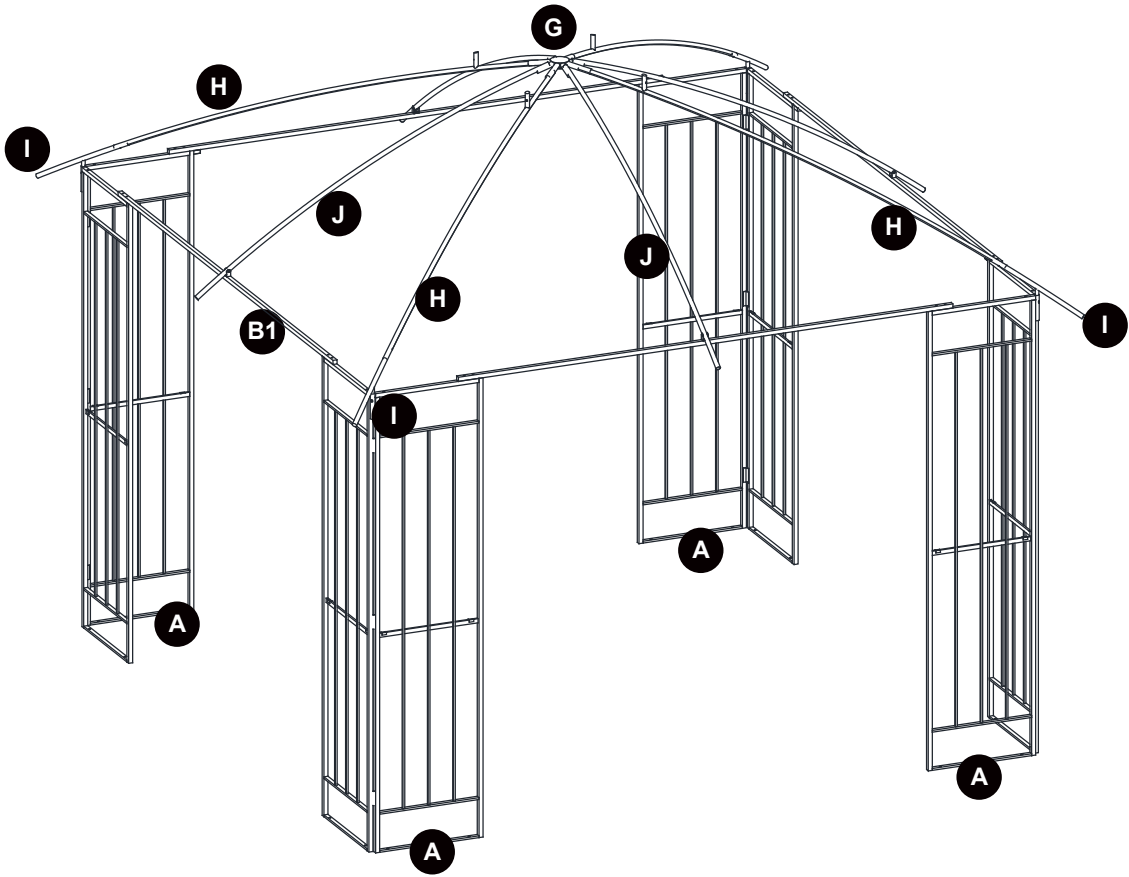

- 3.2. Conecte la barra central (J) al conector (D1) con un perno (AA), arandelas planas (DD) y una tuerca (EE). Coloque la tapa (GG) en la tuerca (EE).
- 3.3. Fije el gancho (L) al conector superior (G).

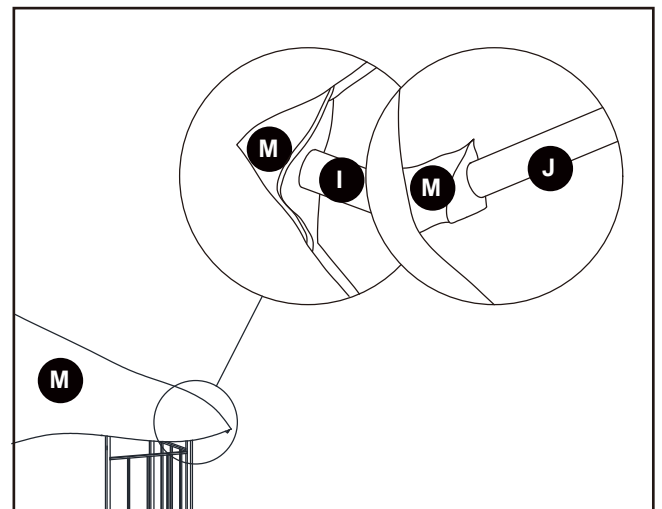
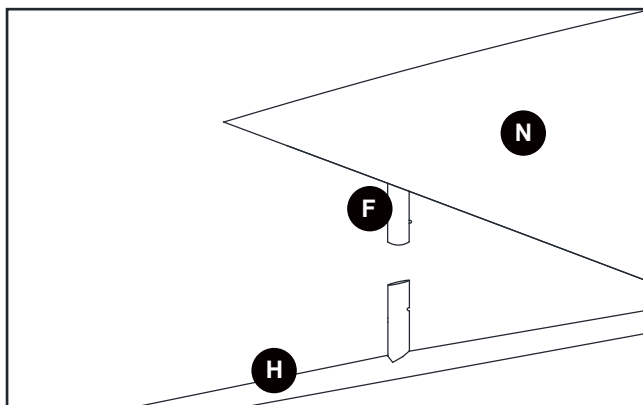
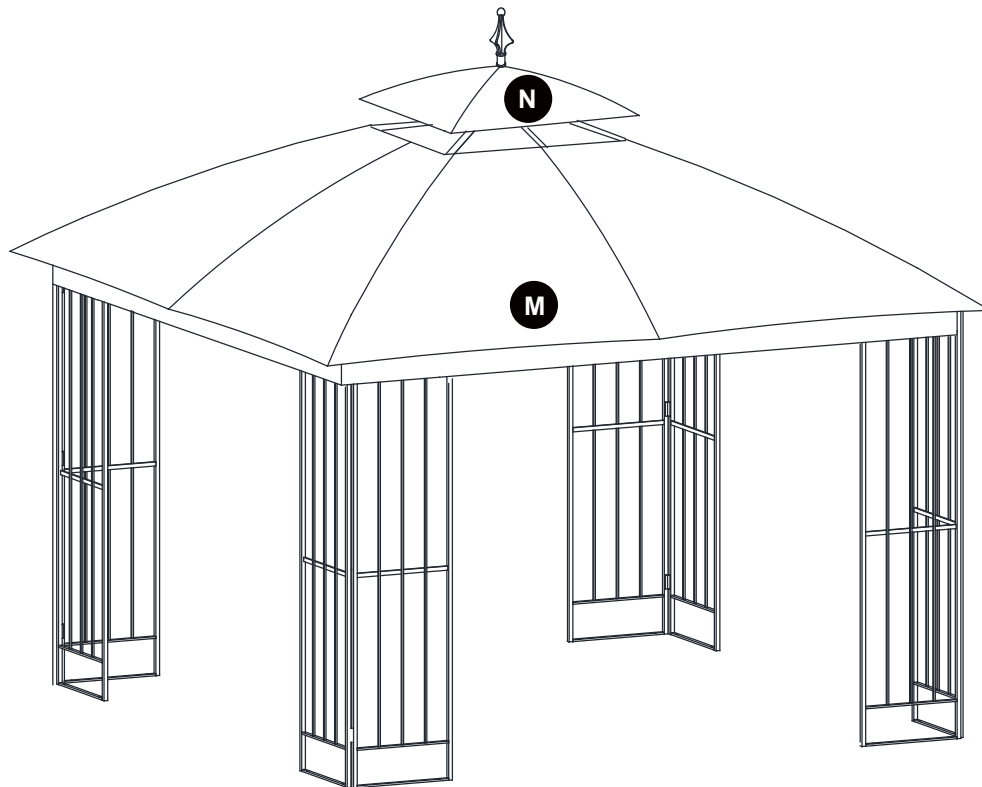


4. Coloque el toldo grande (M) en la parte superior del ensamble del gazebo. No extienda el toldo aún.



5.1. Inserte la viga superior pequeña (F) en el conector superior pequeño (E).

5.2. Coloque el toldo pequeño (N) en la viga superior pequeña (F), alineando las esquinas y estirándolo para que encaje. Fije el remate (K) al conector superior pequeño (E).

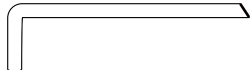


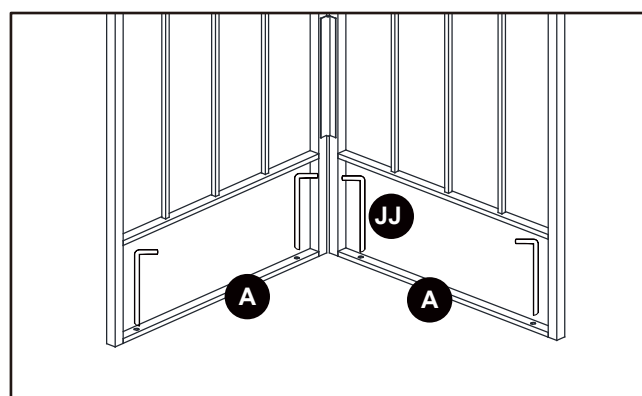
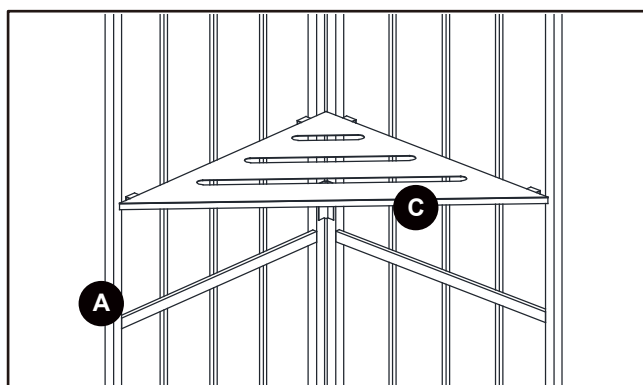
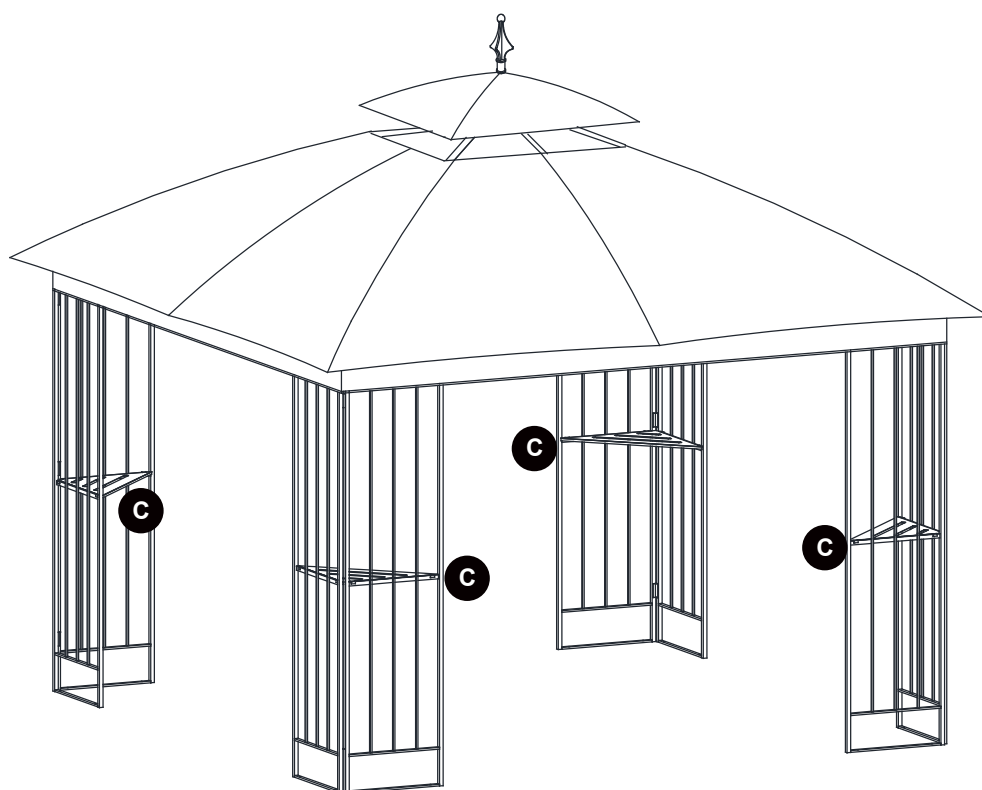
6.1. Inserte la viga superior pequeña (F) en la barra de esquina larga (H). Repita el procedimiento para todas las vigas superiores pequeñas.

Nota: coloque primero cada viga superior pequeña (F) sin apretar en cada barra conectora superior larga (H), luego insértelas juntas; de lo contrario, la última no se insertará correctamente.

6.2. Fije el toldo grande (M) al techo a lo largo de las barras de esquina cortas (I) y la barra central (J), alinee las esquinas y estírelas hasta lograr el ajuste correcto.

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7.1. Coloque los estantes (C) en los paneles de esquina (A) según lo desee.

7.2. Fije el ensamble del gazebo al suelo con estacas (JJ) en la parte inferior de los paneles de esquina (A).

CUIDADO Y MANTENIMIENTO

- Para limpiar, use una solución de detergente suave, enjuáguelo con agua y deje que se seque al aire. No use acetona, productos abrasivos u otros detergentes especiales porque dañarían el acabado del producto.
- Debido a la naturaleza del acero, puede oxidarse la superficie si este recubrimiento protector se raya. Este es un proceso natural. Para minimizar este problema, se recomienda que tenga cuidado cuando ensamble y manipule el producto, para evitar que la pintura se raye.

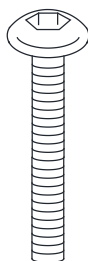

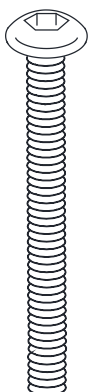

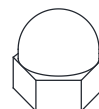
