

Recommended Maintenance Residential Gates & Hardware

KEEPING YOUR GATE IN GREAT SHAPE IS SIMPLE WITH JUST A FEW REGULAR CHECKS AND TOUCH-UPS:

VISUAL CHECK

Inspect the gate for any signs of rust, chipped paint, or physical damage.

CLEANING

Wash the gate using mild soap, water, and a soft brush to remove dirt, dust, and organic buildup. Avoid harsh chemical cleaners or abrasive materials, as they can damage the protective coating.

HINGES & LATCHES

Lubricate hinges, latches, and other moving parts with a silicone or graphite-based lubricant to ensure smooth, quiet operation.

RUST SPOT TOUCH-UP

If you find any rust spots, lightly sand the affected area, apply a rust-inhibiting primer, and follow up with matching exterior paint to help prevent corrosion.

ALIGNMENT CHECK

Open and close the gate to make sure it operates smoothly and stays properly aligned. Adjust hinges and latches if necessary.

TIGHTEN COMPONENTS

Check all screws, bolts, and fasteners. Tighten anything that may have come loose over time.

STRUCTURAL INSPECTION

Examine the gate frame, posts, and supports to confirm everything is solid and secure. Repair or replace any damaged components as needed.

HELPFUL TIPS

Ensure there is proper drainage around gate posts to avoid standing water, which can contribute to rust or decay. Trim nearby vegetation to prevent contact with the gate. This helps minimize moisture and organic buildup.

PREVENTATIVE CLEANUP AFTER METALWORK

After cutting, drilling, or screwing metal, thoroughly remove all metal shavings and debris to prevent premature rusting and protect both the product and surrounding surfaces such as decks, railings, and concrete.
