

WOOD FENCING

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What are the dimensions of our fence panels?

A: 6' tall x 8' wide, 42" tall x 8' wide, 48" tall x 8' wide.

Q: What is the width of our fence gates?

A: Varies depending on the style of the fence panel.

Q: How many backer rails are recommended per 6' tall fence section?

A: Three.

Q: What dimension lumber is recommended to be used as fence posts?

A: 4x4, 6x6 or a combination of both.

Q: How far in the ground should you place your 4x4 posts?

A: 18" to 24" (check with building codes in your local areas).

Q: Where should the backer rails be placed on the posts when building a fence?

A: 6" down from the top, 6" up from the ground, with the intermediate one centered between the two.

Q: How do you calculate the number of you will need to complete a job?

A: Determine the number of linear feet for the entire job and divide that number by 8 for the number of panels.

Q: How do you determine the number of posts needed to complete a job?

A: Take the number of panels needed and add 1.

Q: When should I paint or stain my fence?

A: When the wood is dry to the touch.

Q: Is it okay to use landscape timbers as fence posts?

A: No.

Q: Do you need a permit to erect a fence?

A: Sometimes. Check with local authorities.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Always ask about an homeowner association or code restrictions, before making a purchase decision. This will ensure that the product purchased meets any specific requirements their community may have.
