

As shown in the figure Use ① to fix G and E, G and F.




Use 467 to fix C and E, D and F.



As shown in the figure Use ⑤⑥⑦ to fix A and C, A and D.




As shown in the figure Use 367 to fix J and B.



Check you have all the components and tools listed on the page 2.

Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts may cause choking if swallowed.

Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

Cleaning & Maintenance
