




Alian bar mounting holes with MOUNTING PINS and TENSION SCREW and slide into place onto the chainsaw.

3 Turn TENSION SCREW clockwise to remove most, but not all, of the chain slack. Final working tension will be set before operation.


SCRENCH to loosen lock nuts.


• Hold bar tip up, turn **TENSION** SCREW clockwise to adjust chain tension until the chain tie straps just touch the side of the bar rails.

guide bar, leaving an open loop at mounting end of bar.



has about .25" slack away from bar and rotates smoothly around the har.





Turn TENSION SCREW until chain Be sure saw contains bar & chain oil before starting the saw. This oil is required for proper operation.
